ENTRY/SCRATCH DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday, February 13, 2016. Nine (9) races were filled today. Three (3) races are scheduled to be contested on the turf course. Eighty-one (81) horses are scheduled to start.

Scratches and changes for Thursday February 11, 2016 were taken this morning in the racing office. Four (4) jockey changes were submitted. There were no 'request to scratch' cards submitted. All changes were activated after the 10:00 A.M. deadline.

2/11/16¹

MEDICAL MARIJUANA

Safety Steward LUIS JAUREGUI and Sergeant MICHAEL VALADEZ (Santa Anita Stable Security) came to our office today in order to discuss procedures that Santa Anita utilizes with licensees here that use medical marijuana. Also present at today's meeting were CHRB Investigators PHIL MIYAZAKI and JIM HAMILTON.

Santa Anita has a policy that the holder of a 'Medical Marijuana Card' can work here at Santa Anita but not stay overnight (live) on the grounds. Today's meeting was to have the CHRB (Stewards/Investigators) and Santa Anita Stable Security understand each other's policies regarding this topic. The Stewards feel today's meeting was beneficial to all parties as far as communicating to each other about what is and what is not allowed regarding the use of medical marijuana here within the restricted areas of the enclosure.

MICHAEL SCOTT DUNCAN COMPLAINT (CASE #16SA0029)

Veterinarian AMY SEIM filed a complaint against trainer MICHAEL SCOTT DUNCAN for alleged violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) alleging that Mr. Duncan is indebted to her in the amount of \$630.00. Prior to today's 11:00 a.m. hearing commencement, Mr. Duncan delivered a check in the amount of \$630.00 made out to Veterinarian Seim. Case dismissed.

2/11/16³**MORNING TRAINING ENFORCEMENT**

Santa Anita lead morning outrider JOHN CORTEZ issued an “Association Violation Notice” against exercise rider PRISCILIANO MAIZ ORTIZ for “failing to yield” for the main track emergency buzzer during morning training hours. Mr. Ortiz apologized and understood the reasons for issuance of the following ruling:

LATS #046

Exercise rider PRISCILIANO MAIZ ORTIZ is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – Failure to yield to main track emergency siren).

2/11/16⁴**JOCKEY PADDOCK PROTOCOL**

Vice President, Racing/Racing Secretary RICK HAMMERLE requested a meeting with the Stewards today. Jockeys’ timely arrival in the paddock was the main focus of today’s meeting. Also present today were MIKE LAKOW (Racing Director), KEVIN COLOSI (Clerk of Scales), CHARLES McCaul (Assistant Clerk of Scales) and KAREN DENOVEL (Paddock Judge). Today’s discussion revolved around the Stewards informing the racing officials present to inform us when jockeys and/or valets are unnecessarily delaying race horses’ departure for the race track. The officials were reminded that they can suggest a penalty as outlined in CHRB rule #1549 (Recommendation of Discipline).

2/11/16⁵**GARY STEVENS FILM REVIEW**

Jockey GARY STEVENS appeared in the Stewards’ office in order to review his ride in the \$200,000 Palos Verdes Stakes which was contested Sunday, February 7, 2016. Also present today were DARREL HAIRE (Jockeys’ Guild) and NICK COUKOS (President - TOC). Jockey Stevens was aboard #1 KOBE’S BACK who finished first in this race. This informal hearing was held in order to see if Stevens violated CHRB rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop). The Stewards ruled that although it was close, Jockey Stevens complied with this rule. The vote was unanimous.

2/11/16⁶**RAFAEL BEJARANO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO appeared in our office this morning in order to review his ride in the first race on Sunday, February 7. Bejarano was aboard #11 ALL THAT HEAT who finished seventh in this one mile turf event. DARREL HAIRE (Jockeys’ Guild) also attended today’s hearing.

Entering the first turn of this race, #11 ALL THAT HEAT shifts down from his outside post bumping tenth place finisher #10 CLARA’S DREAM (David Lopez), forcing that rival to steady. Also steadying at this point was eleventh (last) place finisher #9 SPREAD THE JOY (Edwin Maldonado). The Stewards showed all angles of this event in slow motion and regular speed. The Stewards felt this ride was an aggressive attempt to save ground and obtain inside position as soon as possible. The Stewards had concerns as to the safety of rivals to the inside of ALL THAT HEAT. In a unanimous vote the Stewards issued the following ruling:

LATS #047

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO, who rode ALL THAT HEAT in the first race at Santa Anita Race Track on February 7, 2016, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (February 21, 25, and 26, 2016) for crossing over without sufficient clearance and causing interference in the first turn. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

2/11/16⁷**SUPER BOWL STARTER HANDICAP**

Sometime following the running of last Saturday’s (February 7) Super Bowl Party Handicap (Purse \$40,000 Added) a racing fan contacted Santa Anita Racing Secretary RICK HAMMERLE questioning the eligibility of that race’s winner #3 CHINA GIRL who

was ridden by DRAYDEN VAN DYKE and trained by DAN HENDRICKS. Preliminary indications are that there is a possibility that this horse may not have qualified for the conditions of this race, therefore making it ineligible. The Stewards ordered Paymaster of Purses BRIDGET CRAWFORD to place a hold on the winner's portion of this purse as this matter is looked into further. More to follow.

2/11/16⁸**SIXTH RACE - STEWARDS' INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of this race in order to review the start of this 6 ½ furlong main track even. Seventh (last) place finisher #1 STEALTH DRONE (Rafael Bejarano) reared high in the air at the start. This event caused the filly to trail the rest of the field at least ten (10) lengths immediately after the gates opened. After speaking with starter JAY SLENDER and reviewing replays of the start, the Stewards found nothing that would warrant a change in the order of finish or a refund of wagers placed on this horse. Bottom line is unfortunately this horse caused her own issues in this event.

Santa Anita Mutuel Manager RANDY HARTZELL stopped by the Stewards' office this morning. Mr. Hartzell wanted to review the scheduled post times for tomorrow, Saturday, February 13. He gave the Stewards a list of scheduled post times for Tampa Bay Downs, Laurel, Gulfstream, Aqueduct, and of course, Santa Anita. The Stewards make every effort to 'work with' the mutual department. The goal being to not run races in North America 'on top' of each other with time considerations for horse and rider always taken into account.

2/12/16²**APPRENTICE JOCKEY MEETING**

CHRB Safety Steward LUIS JAUREGUI held his weekly meeting with the Santa Anita apprentice jockey colony this morning. Several race replays were shown. One of this morning's discussions was about how a rider should dismount when something unexpected happens in the starting gate.

2/12/16³**KAYLA STRA FILM REVIEW**

Jockey KAYLA STRA appeared in our office today along with her agent KEN HUTH. The Stewards wanted to review Ms. Stra's ride aboard #8 BACK STREET CAT who finished second in the eighth race on (Super Bowl) Sunday, February 7. Approaching the 1/8 pole in this 5 ½ furlong race, jockey Stra used her riding crop five (5) consecutive times before giving her mount a chance to respond. She did not disagree with the Stewards' issuance of the following ruling. The decision was unanimous.

LATS #048

Jockey KAYLA STRA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the eighth race at Santa Anita Race Track on February 7, 2016.

2/12/16⁴**EIGHTH RACE - ACCIDENT/INQUIRY**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of this race in order to review an accident approaching the 3/8 marker. On the far turn #5 DEATH VALLEY GIRL (Kieren Fallon) goes wrong and is immediately pulled up by jockey Fallon. Eventual fourth place finisher #8 LUCKY CHARM (Stewart Elliott) was trailing #5 DEATH VALLEY GIRL and reacting quickly, narrowly avoids this horse. #11 ICONA (David Lopez) was racing in tenth position, at least a half dozen lengths behind the incident, when he races up on #5 DEATH VALLEY GIRL and makes contact with this horse from behind. This incident unseated apprentice Lopez sending him to the track surface. The human and horse ambulances were quickly on the scene. There was no change in the order of finish. An accident report will be attached to these minutes.

SATURDAY2/13/16¹**CHINA GIRL LOVER MATTER (REF: 02/11/16⁷)**

The eligibility of the horse CHINA GIRL LOVER, who finished first in the fifth race on February 7, 2016, is still in question. The matter has been handed over to CHRB enforcement in order to investigate. The purpose of this ruling is to let all parties know that an inquiry into this issue will be made in a timely fashion in accordance with the rules, followed by a hearing and ultimately a decision.

LATS #049

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1750 (Stewards to Make Inquiry) this Board of Stewards, upon its own motion, is conducting an Inquiry into the eligibility of CHINA GIRL LOVER, the winner of the fifth race on February 7, 2016 at Santa Anita Park. A hearing will be scheduled and interested parties will be noticed.

2/13/16²**VICTOR ESPINOZA - INFORMAL HEARING**

Paddock Judge KAREN DENOVEL informed the stewards last week that jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA was late to the walking ring (paddock) for the second race on Sunday, February 7. Jockey Espinoza was out of town yesterday and appeared in our office today on the matter. The Stewards could not find Witness/Racing Official Denovel when Jockey Espinoza appeared in our office to discuss the alleged incident. Matter dismissed.

2/13/16³**FIFTH RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident approaching the 1/8 pole. At this point of the race second place finisher #9 CRIMSON AND GOLD (Mike Smith) shifts outward from behind a rival and bumps seventh place finisher #7 FOXY FRESH

(Joseph Talamo) forcing that horse to steady sharply off the heels of this race's eventual winner, #10 ALWAYS BELIEVE (Victor Espinoza). #7 FOXY FRESH appeared to tire after steadying. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, let the original placings stand. No change. Jockey MIKE SMITH was ordered to film review with the Stewards tomorrow.

In a separate incident in this race, fourth place finisher #5 WIFE APPROVED broke outward in this 5 ½ furlong event. Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT was also ordered to film review.

CHRB Investigator PHIL MIYAZAKI brought an eight (8) page complaint to the Stewards which was filed against Owner EDELLE LOGAN (Towerview Stables). This complaint was initiated by Veterinarian MICHAEL MANO. CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) is the applicable rule in this matter. The amount owed in this case is allegedly \$3,644.26. Ms. Logan resides in Ireland and the Stewards want to make sure that her 'notice to appear' was properly served by the CHRB and received by Edelle Logan. More to follow.

DAVID JACOBSON HEARING (CASE NO:16SA0030)

Groom MANUEL VALDIVIA has alleged that trainer DAVID JACOBSON owes him \$630.00 in past due wages. Along with Mr. Valdivia, present today were assistant trainer LUIS GRACIA, Safety Steward LUIS JAUREGUI and exercise rider/interpreter MERCEDES GOMORI. There were two reasonable questions in this matter.

1. Did Mr. Valdivia quit or get fired by trainer Jacobson?
2. Should the cost of Mr. Valdivia's airplane ticket (New York to Burbank) be taken out of wages allegedly owed?

The Stewards also spoke (via telephone) to trainer Jacobson who was in New York today. Assistant trainer Gracia gave groom Valdivia a check following today's hearing and this case has now been settled /withdrawn.

FLAVIEN PRAT - FILM REVIEW

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review the start of yesterday's fifth race which was contested at 5 ½ furlongs. Prat's mount, #5 WIFE APPROVED (fourth place), broke out and bumped tenth place finisher #6 MADERA JUBILEE (Kayla Stra). The bad start of jockey Prat's horse was not his fault. However, we felt he could have made an attempt to correct his mount in a swifter fashion. No penalty was warranted in this matter.

MIKE SMITH FILM REVIEW (REF: 02/13/16³)

Jockey MIKE SMITH appeared in the Stewards' office today in order to review his ride aboard #9 CRIMSON AND GOLD who finished second in yesterday's (February 13) fifth race. Jockey Smith survived a Steward's Inquiry in this race. Today's film review shows Jockey Smith and #9 CRIMSON AND GOLD shift out and take the path of #7 FOXY FRESH (Joseph Talamo). This action forced #7 FOXY FRESH to steady off of the heels of eventual winner #10 ALWAYS BELIEVE. Jockey Smith agreed with the Stewards' analysis that this particular ride was not his best. In a unanimous decision, the following ruling was issued;

LATS #050

Jockey MIKE SMITH, who rode CRIMSON AND GOLD in the fifth race at Santa Anita Race Track on February 13, 2016, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (February 20, 21, and 25, 2016) for crossing over without sufficient clearance and causing interference in the stretch. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

2/14/16⁵

FIFTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident in this race's final furlong. Original first place finisher #10 JUST BOOKIN (Efrain Hernandez) attempted to pass #2 ROCKPORT DANCER (Santiago Gonzalez) by racing up from behind her and passing to her outside with less than a furlong to race. While doing this #10 JUST BOOKIN closed an opening for fourth place finisher #1 RYDERROO (Tyler Baze) who like #10 JUST BOOKIN was closing quite well in this race's later stages. #1 RYDERROO (Tyler Baze) was forced to steady sharply and the Stewards, in a unanimous decision, voted to disqualify #10 JUST BOOKIN and place her fourth. Jockey Efrain Hernandez was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

MONDAY2/15/16¹**EFRAIN HERNANDEZ - FILM REVIEW (REF: 02/14/16⁵)**

Jockey EFRAIN HERNANDEZ appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #10 JUST BOOKIN, who finished first but was disqualified and placed fourth for interference in the stretch, in yesterday's (February 14) fifth race. Jockey TYLER BAZE accompanied jockey Hernandez to today's hearing.

The Stewards viewed all race replay angles with jockey Hernandez. He was candid with the Stewards and accepted responsibility for shifting out in mid-stretch and impeding a rival that was closing hard on his outside, #1 RYDERROO (Tyler Baze - 4th Place). He was more focused on getting around original second place finisher #2 ROCKPORT DANCER (Santiago Gonzalez) and didn't realize that #1 RYDERROO was quickly behind him to his outside. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling:

LATS #051

Jockey EFRAIN HERNANDEZ, who rode JUST BOOKIN in the fifth race at Santa Anita Race Track on February 14, 2016, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (February 21, 25, and 26, 2016, for crossing over without sufficient clearance in the stretch, resulting in a disqualification from first to fourth. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

2/15/16²**KENT DESORMEAUX - FILM REVIEW**

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #5 TATTENHAM who finished second in the sixth race yesterday (February 14), which was a 1 ½ mile turf event. Film review today regarding this race's final sixty (60) yards when #5 TATTENHAM was in a stretch duel with #8 MALKO (IRE) (third place) when this race's eventual winner #9 BOURBON SOUL (Tyler Baze) slips up along the rail to win this race in a 'photo finish'. Film review shows that jockey Desormeaux started to put his crop away and looked over his shoulder before using the crop three more times. Steward CHANEY entertained a penalty for this ride; however, the majority felt jockey Desormeaux gave his best effort.

2/15/16³**APPRENTICE JOSE BARNES**

JOSE BARNES, an apprentice jockey from South Africa, has paid us three (3) visits in the last two weeks. The Stewards have requested thorough documentation regarding adequate proof of Barnes' riding records and medical clearance following two injuries, before issuing him an apprentice license. More to follow.
