**Week 1 – Friday, September 30, 2016, through Sunday, October 2, 2016.**

**TUESDAY**

9/27/16

**ENTRY DAY**

Steward SCOTT CHANEY will be on duty today, tomorrow, and Thursday to oversee entries and declarations. Nine (9) races filled for opening day Friday, September 30. Four (4) races will be contested on the new infield turf course. Eighty-one (81) horses are scheduled to start.

**WEDNESDAY**

9/28/16

**ENTRY DAY**

Vice President Racing, Racing Secretary RICK HAMMERLE and his crew assembled a stellar card for Saturday, October 1. Eleven (11) races will be carded. Five (5) Grade I races will be held. These races serve as prep races for the races here on Breeders' Cup weekend which will be held here on November 4 and 5. One hundred nine (109) horses are scheduled to face Starter JAY SLENDER this Saturday.

**THURSDAY**

9/29/16

**ENTRY/ SCRATCH DAY**

Scratches and changes for opening day Friday, September 30, were taken today in the racing office. Two (2) scratches, two (2) jockey changes and one (1) equipment change were made. All changes were activated after the 9:00 AM deadline. Entries for Sunday October 2 were taken today in the racing office. Nine (9) races will be carded. Seventy-eight (78) horses are scheduled to start.

**FRIDAY**

9/30/16<sup>1</sup>

**ALFREDO CASTRO RAMOS MATTER (CASE NO. 16DM067)**

Exercise Rider ALFREDO RAMOS appeared in the Stewards' office in order to get back on the grounds at Los Alamitos. He was accompanied by Exercise Rider JENELLE TOMECK. Ramos was scheduled to appear before the Stewards at Del Mar on September 1, 2016. (REF 9/1/16<sup>2</sup>). Alfredo Ramos was suspended for failure to appear (DMTD Ruling #99) on September 2, 2016. He has been working the last three (3) weeks while under suspension. CHRB enforcement was contacted at Los Alamitos yesterday (September 29) and ordered Ramos to get off the grounds of that race track. Ramos entered Trainer CARLA GAINES' shed row and fought with another licensee (Apprentice Jockey Jimmy Guzman) on August 7, 2016, at Del Mar. Ramos and Guzman had a history of 'bad blood' before that incident. The two (2) pugilists very much impacted the rhythm and training activities at Ms. Gaines' barn on this particular morning. Ramos tested positive for marijuana following this incident. He told the Stewards today he wasn't aware of the Del Mar hearing. This was possible due to the fact that his address that was on file with the CHRB was incorrect. In a unanimous decision, the following ruling was issued today by the Stewards.

**LATC #001**

Having now appeared before the Board of Stewards, Exercise Rider ALFREDO

CASTRO RAMOS is restored to good standing. Ruling DMTD #099, issued at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on September 2, 2016, is set aside. Further, Mr. RAMOS is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) for violation of CHRB Rules #1889 (Entry to Area Assigned to Trainer), and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – fighting). Lastly he must sign a testing agreement and is placed on probation through the term of his license.

9/30/16<sup>2</sup>**KENT DESORMEAUX RULING**

In the second race on Sunday, September 25, at the Los Alamitos thoroughbred meet Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX rode #3 PEPPERMINT KITTY who finished fourth at odds of one to two (1/2). This horse was beaten a nose for third place in this race. The purse of this race was \$14,000. The third place finisher received \$1,680.00. The fourth place finisher received \$840.00. The photo finish for third place shows third place jockey MARTIN PEDROZA down on his horse (#5 PUBLIC HOUSE – second place) and Jockey Desormeaux ‘up in the saddle’. Jockey Desormeaux called the Los Alamitos Stewards’ after the race, pled guilty, and waived his right to a hearing. The Santa Anita Stewards issued the following ruling:

**LATC #002**

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX, who rode PEPPERMINT KITTY in the second race on September 25, 2016, at Los Alamitos Race Course, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer, and Jockey – stood up before finish line).

9/30/16<sup>3</sup>**OFFICIAL CHANGE**

Starter JAY SLENDER is off today due to personal reasons. Lead Assistant JOHN LOPEZ will replace him.

9/30/16<sup>4</sup>**PATROL JUDGE SHIFT**

Patrol Judge RANDY VALDEZ has typically manned the patrol judge stand at the 1/8 pole at prior meets here at Santa Anita. Starting today the Stewards will have Patrol Judge Valdez working on the far turn at the 3/8 pole location. We feel a patrol judge at that spot will be more of an asset with a human head-on view of sprint starts, far turn activity, and pre-race warm-up views. Santa Anita General Manager JOE MORRIS assisted with the logistics of getting the Patrol Judge Valdez to his new position.

9/30/16<sup>5</sup>**OPENING DAY JOCKEY MEETING**

The Stewards met with the Santa Anita Jockey colony today to go over several CHRB rules today. Members of Santa Anita management JOE MORRIS, AMY ZIMMERMAN, track veterinarians Dr. DANA STEAD, Dr. WILL FARMER and paramedics were also at the meeting. DARRELL HAIRE (Jockeys’ Guild) was also present. Many topics were covered during the twenty (20) minute meeting.

9/30/16<sup>6</sup>**NINTH RACE INQUIRY/JOCKEY OBJECTION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after observing an incident at the 1/8 pole. This \$100,000 Eddie D Stakes - 2<sup>nd</sup> Division was contested at 6 ½ furlongs on the turf course. Jockey BRICE BLANC (fifth place) also lodged a claim of foul against second place finisher #11 BOOZER (Gary Stevens) and third place finisher #8 GUNS LOADED (Rafael Bejarano). Race replays show #6 OHIO (BRZ) actually initiate contact by bumping rival #8 GUNS LOADED. #6 OHIO (BRZ) bobbled and took the worst of this contact. Second place finisher #11 BOOZER (Gary Stevens) did drift in slightly in this incident. However, the Stewards allowed the original placings to stand. This decision was unanimous.

**SATURDAY**10/1/16<sup>1</sup>**ADAM KITCHINGMAN COMPLAINT (CASE NO.16LT010)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer ADAM KITCHINGMAN for alleged violation of Rule #1843.1 (B) (Prohibited Drug Substances), Rule #1844 (F)(1) (Authorized Medication), Rule #1843 (A)(D) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse).

Trainer Kitchingman started the horse ROMAN TIZZY in the first race on August 28, 2016, finishing fourth. Along with the Stewards, present today were Court Reporter MICHELLE DERIEG (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) and CHRB Investigator JIM HAMILTON who presented a twenty-seven (27) page investigative report. Adam Kitchingman testified via telephone. The test sample of the horse ROMAN TIZZY contained the Class 4 drug 'Betamethasone' (86 pg/ml). The permitted level is 10 pg/ml. Kitchingman testified that Dr. VINCE BAKER was his veterinarian. The investigative report indicates that Dr. Baker said Dr. RYAN CARPENTER treated the horse on August 20, 2016. Trainer Kitchingman felt he was safe regarding withdrawal times when treating his horse. The blood sample (test result) from UC Davis Laboratories indicated otherwise. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling:

**LATC#003**

Trainer ADAM KITCHINGMAN, who started the horse ROMAN TIZZY in the first race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on August 28, 2016, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and #1844 (f)(1) (Authorized Medication – Bethamethasone – in excess of permitted level [86 pg/ml] – Class 4).

10/1/16<sup>2</sup>**CHRIS HARTMAN COMPLAINT (CASE NO 16LT0014)**

Groom LEONARDO AVILA filed a complaint against his employer, Trainer CHRIS HARTMAN. Groom Avila alleges that Trainer Hartman owes him \$430.00 in past due wages. The Stewards were notified that Mr. Avila has now been paid in full and the complaint has been withdrawn

10/1/16<sup>3</sup>**GARY STEVENS FILM REVIEW (REF: 9/30/16<sup>6</sup>)**

Jockey GARY STEVENS appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #11 BOOZER who finished second in yesterday's ninth race (Eddie D Stakes -2<sup>nd</sup> Division). Jockey Stevens was involved in a Stewards' Inquiry and jockey's objection in this race. His mount drifted in slightly at the 1/8 pole and played what the Stewards felt was a relatively minor role in the outcome of the race. Jockey Stevens was excused without sanction.

10/1/16<sup>4</sup>**RAFAEL BEJARANO FILM REVIEW (REF: 9/30/16<sup>6</sup>)**

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #8 GUNS LOADED, who finished third in yesterday's (September 30) ninth race. There was an Inquiry and jockey objection in this race. The Stewards determined that Jockey Bejarano maintained a straight course in this race and this film session was for review only.

10/1/16<sup>5</sup>**BRANDON BOULANGER FILM REVIEW**

Jockey BRANDON BOULANGER appeared in the Stewards' office in order to watch the start of yesterday's 2<sup>nd</sup> race which was contested at 5 ½ furlongs. Jockey Boulanger was aboard #4 GAVIN STREETSENSE who broke out bothering rivals to his outside. The Stewards felt Boulanger was slow to straighten his mount after the break. In a unanimous decision a warning was issued.

10/1/16<sup>6</sup>**SIXTH RACE INQUIRY/NON-STARTER**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after reviewing the start of today's sixth race which was the Grade 1 FrontRunner Stake going 1 1/16 miles on the main track (Purse \$300,000). #3 SECRET HOUSE (Santiago Gonzalez) left the starting gate without a jockey and ran loose the entire race. SECRET HOUSE bears out (riderless) on the first turn causing eventual third place finisher #5 STRAIGHT FIRE (Flavien Prat) to race wide. Race replays showed #3 SECRET HOUSE act up and crowd the front portion of the starting gate before being properly reset by the assistant starter in this race. As the assistant starter had this horse's head properly pointed down the racetrack, Jockey Gonzalez steps off onto the starting gate pontoon on his horse's far (grandstand) side. #3 SECRET HOUSE raced riderless and fortunately event free for the rest of this race.

The Stewards spoke with Starter JAY SLENDER and reviewed all camera angles of the start. There was no gate malfunction or assistant starter error in this event. The Stewards ultimately felt full refunds were warranted as 6<sup>th</sup> race bettors did not receive a fair start regarding this horse with the jockey stepping off. In a unanimous decision #3 SECRET HOUSE was declared a non-starter which as far as the tote department is concerned equates to a late scratch. The Santa Anita tote department reported refunds totaling \$75,054.18. Jockey Gonzalez was ordered to see the Stewards tomorrow.

10/1/16<sup>7</sup>**QUALITY RACING**

Today's eleven (11) race card was highlighted by five (5) Grade 1 races. All of these events carried purses of \$300,000. The two (2) most anticipated races of the day were the Awesome Again Stakes (7<sup>th</sup> race) and the Zenyatta Stakes (9<sup>th</sup> race). In the 'Awesome Again' #1 CALIFORNIA CHROME (Victor Espinosa) defeated four (4) rivals in a facile 2 ¼ length victory going off at odds of two to five (2/5). The Santa Anita tote department reported a total minus pool following this race of \$158,309.36.

In today's Zenyatta Stakes (9<sup>th</sup> Race) #2 STELLAR WIND (Victor Espinoza) defeated the two to five (2/5) favorite #2 BEHOLDER (Gary Stevens) by a neck margin. A minus pool of \$73,846.38 was reported following this race. A crowd of 18,563 were on hand on a very warm but pleasant early fall day. Total handle today was \$17,553.118.78.

**SUNDAY**10/2/16<sup>1</sup>**NORBERTO ARROYO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Norberto Arroyo appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #4 ZAPPERKAT who finished third in yesterday's tenth race (\$300,000 Chandelier Stakes-Grade 1). Race replays this morning showed Jockey Arroyo appear to initiate contact with #6 BITZKA (Tyler Baze, 6<sup>th</sup> place). This incident caused eleventh (last) place finisher #8 MISTRESSOFTHENIGHT (Kent Desormeaux) to check his mount. This ride by Jockey Arroyo fell short of warranting a penalty in the unanimous opinion of the Stewards. We communicated with Jockey Arroyo that continued over aggressive riding will be dealt with firmly and fairly.

10/2/16<sup>2</sup>**SANTIAGO GONZALEZ FILM REVIEW (REF: 10/1/16(1))**

A meeting was held in our office today in order to conduct a video review and discuss what led to the Inquiry involving the start of yesterday's 6<sup>th</sup> race (FrontRunner Stakes-\$300,000-Grade 1) which was contested at a distance of 1 1/16 miles on the main track. Present this morning, along with the Stewards were Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ, Valet OZZIE AYALA, Safety Steward LUIS JAUREGUI, Starter JAY SLENDER and DARRELL HAIRE (Jockey's Guild).

Jockey Gonzalez stepped off #3 SECRET HOUSE prior to the start of yesterday's \$300,000 Grade 1 FrontRunner Stakes. This horse ran riderless in this 1 1/16 mile event. This horse was ultimately declared a non-starter by the Stewards. Safety Steward Jauregui and Valet Ayala, who assists Jockey Gonzalez during the races, helped interpret at this meeting. Jockey Gonzalez thought the track veterinarian should look at his horse after #3 SECRET HOUSE became edgy in the starting gate. Today's meeting revealed that Jockey Gonzalez gave no indication to anyone, including most importantly his assistant starter, that he was going to 'step off' his mount. Jockey Gonzalez was involved in a similar, but not identical, incident (REF:LA County Fair Minutes 9/24/16<sup>5</sup>) recently at Los Alamitos. Gonzalez was told to communicate (holler, shout etc.) when he is not secured on his mount, feels that he is not 'tied on' or feels he is not ready for the start of a race in any way.

10/2/16<sup>3</sup>**SHELBE RUIS RULING**

Yesterday Horseshoe Inspector VICTOR TOVAR notified the Stewards that on September 30, 2016, the SHELBE RUIS trained #5 WAR ENVOY showed up at the receiving barn prior to the sixth race (\$100,000 Eddie D Stakes-Grade 3) wearing toe grabs on his shoes. This violates the Santa Anita turf course shoeing policy. The Stewards issued the following ruling:

**LATC #004**

Trainer SHELBE RUIS, who started WAR ENVOY in the sixth race at Santa Anita Race Track on September 30, 2016, pursuant to CHRB rule #1555 (Duties of Horseshoe Inspector) is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for violation of CHRB Rule #1853 (Examination Required – improperly shod for turf).

10/2/16<sup>4</sup>**JERRY HOLLENDORFER COMPLAINT (CASE #16LT012)**

A complaint was filed by the CHRB against Trainer Jerry HOLLENDORFER for working out his trainee MADIBA while this horse was on the veterinarian's list. MADIBA was in the 7<sup>th</sup> race at Los Alamitos (LA County Fair Meet) on September 9, 2016, and was subsequently scratched for being sick. MADIBA recorded a 5 furlong workout (1:02:00) at Golden Gate Fields two (2) days later on September 11. A horse cannot workout for seventy-two (72) hours after being placed on the veterinarian's list without the permission of the state veterinarian. Trainer Hollendorfer testified (via telephone) that there was a mix-up regarding this horse, with his Northern California (Golden Gate Fields) barn which is headed by his wife Assistant Trainer JANET HOLLENDORFER. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, issued the following ruling:

**LATC #005**

Trainer JERRY HOLLENDORFER, who worked out the horse MADIBA on September 11, 2016, (48 hours after being placed on the Veterinarian's List), is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1866(b)(1) (Veterinarian's List – may not work out for 72 hours after being placed on list [sick]).

10/2/16<sup>5</sup>**SMOOTH CARD**

Today's nine (9) race card was problem free as it was conducted without stewards' inquiry and/or jockey's objection.

10/2/16<sup>6</sup>**PROGRAM CHANGES**

1<sup>st</sup> Race Declaration #2 KENJI'S GIANT (Tr. Richard Baltas) injured  
Refund: \$1,762.09 Will Farmer, DVM
