The following ruling was issued after a telephone conversation with Norberto Arroyo Jr. concerning his tardiness to the jockey quarters which made it necessary to remove him from his mount in the second race on Monday. He stated he thought post time was 12:30 P.M. instead of 12:00 P.M.

RULING LATS #002

Jockey NORBERTO ARROYO, JR. is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report) and California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) at Santa Anita on December 26, 2016.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Rafael Bejarano met with the Stewards to review the third race on Monday which involved an inquiry and disqualification of his mount (ref 12-26-16⁵). Along with his agent Tora Yamaguchi, the race was reviewed and discussed. All agreed Mr. Bejarano failed to make an adequate correction when his horse was drifting out from a left handed crop, bumping a horse to his outside and therefore the following ruling was issued.

RULING LATS #003

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO, who rode DABSTER in the third race at Santa Anita Race Track on December 26, 2016 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (January 2, 6 and

7, 2017) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course and causing interference in the stretch, which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from first to fourth position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

SUTHERLAND/ THERIOT RULINGS

The following two rulings were issued after jockeys Chantal Sutherland and Jamie Theriot met with the Stewards, a day late, to discuss their tardiness arriving at Los Alamitos on Sunday December 18, 2016.

The three issues were:

Late to the jockey quarters and not notifying the Stewards before the one hour deadline.

Falsifying the time on the sign in sheet.

Failure to meet with the Stewards on December 26, 2016 as directed.

They stated the reason for being late was an accident on the freeway, they had no excuse for the wrong time on the sign in sheet and they said they just forgot to meet with the BOS when directed to do so.

RULING LATS #004

Jockey CHANTAL SUTHERLAND is fined two hundred dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules 1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend Stewards' hearing), and 1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report – late to Jockeys' room and inaccurate sign in).

RULING LATS #005

Jockey JAMIE THERIOT is fined two hundred dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules 1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend Stewards' hearing), and 1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report – late to Jockeys' room and inaccurate sign in).

INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION 2ND RACE 3/4 mile-dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident inside the 1/16 marker. Involved were #6 St. Reno (T. Baze 3rd) and #7 River Hess (S. Elliot DH 4th). After a review of the videos and conversation with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys, it was a unanimous decision to disqualify #6 from third and place him fifth behind #7 who was originally placed fourth in a dead heat with #2. The rider of #6 hit the nose of #7 as his crop came down and again on the upward motion with his hand. The Stewards felt this incident cost #7 the opportunity of a better placing (nose).

FRIDAY12/30/16¹**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

Bryan Pena met with the Stewards to review the seventh race yesterday in which there was an incident after coming out of the first turn in the one mile event. Involved were #5 Scatastic (B. Pena 8th) and #9 Willing to Travel (J. Theriot 1st). In a majority opinion (Sawyer dissent), Mr. Pena was careless when shifting in slightly causing #9 to clip a heel. The minority opinion was there were mitigating factors involved in the shift of Mr. Pena's mount which would alleviate his culpability of the incident and the following ruling was issued:

RULING LATS #006

Jockey BRAYAN PENA, who rode SCATASTIC in the seventh race at Santa Anita Race Track on December 29, 2016 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (January 6, 7 and 8, 2017) for crossing over without sufficient clearance and causing interference on the backstretch. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

12/30/16²**JOCKEY COLONY MEETING**

Along with the BOS, Chief Steward Darrel McHargue, Darrell Haire (Guild Rep), Safety Steward Luis Jauregui participated in a meeting with the jockey colony to discuss the new changes to the CHRB riding rule (1699(f)) which starts January 1, 2017. The open forum also encouraged the riders to discuss other concerns they have that pertain to decisions made on penalties given to jockeys. It was the overall opinion this was a good discussion and will occur again as requested.

12/30/16³**ORANTES HEARING CASE 16SA0218**

Pony rider Wilver Orantes met with the Stewards for a possible violation of CHRB rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). Mr. Orantes was involved in an altercation with another pony rider, Julio Garcia while on horseback during AM training hours at Santa Anita. Both Mr. Garcia and Mr. Orantes testified about events that occurred leading up to the altercation and the altercation itself. Exercise rider Matthew Falcon also testified on the behalf of Mr. Orantes. The hearing was adjourned until the results of Mr. Orantes misdemeanor battery arrest by the Arcadia Police Department is heard in court.

12/30/16⁴**MASOCHISTIC FORMAL DQ HEARING CASE 16SA264**

Attending the hearing for the disqualification of runner Masochistic, second place finisher in the Grade I TwinSpires Breeder's Cup Sprint were: representing the CHRB,

Staff Counsel, Philip Laird, CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton, Steve Anderson (Daily Racing Form) and Jeremy Balan (Bloodhorse). Court Reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings. Masochistic connections, trainer Ron Ellis, owners, Samantha Segal dba Jay Em Ess Stable and William Shamlan dba Los Pollos Hermanos Racing, and jockey Mike Smith did not appear to contest the positive test results from the Maddy Laboratory at the University of Davis, California, verifying the drug Stanozolol and its metabolite 16-Hydroxy Stanozolol (class 3 drug) in the blood and urine of runner Masochistic. The complaint package was entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. Ruling to follow.

After an examination of #5 TRIBAL JEWEL in the sixth race by Official Veterinarian Tim Grande it was verified the horse was unsound and placed on the Veterinarian's List. The Stewards voided the claim and the horse returned to trainer Bill Spawr.

RULING LATS #008

Exercise Rider JOSE VACA is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to follow instructions of outrider).

12/31/16²**MASOCHISTIC RULING ref 12-30-16⁴**

The following ruling was issued following the hearing yesterday.

RULING LATS #009

Acting on a report from the University of California, Davis, Maddy Analytical Laboratory, the official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample SA23993, obtained from the horse MASOCHISTIC, the second place finisher in the sixth

race at Santa Anita Park on November 5, 2016, contained prohibited substance stanozolol and its metabolite 16 hydroxy stanozolol (Class 3), it is ordered that MASOCHISTIC be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race and deemed unplaced in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding). It is further ordered that jockey MIKE SMITH return \$12,760.00 to the Paymaster of Purses at Santa Anita Park by January 31, 2017 and that the remainder of the purse money being held by the Paymaster of Purses at Santa Anita be distributed in accordance with the revised order of finish:

2nd	MIND YOUR BISCUITS
3rd	A. P. INDIAN
4th	LIMOUSINE LIBERAL
5th	DELTA BLUESMAN
6th	NOHOLDINGBACK BEAR

All records are ordered to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1856 (Race Declared Official) neither pari-mutuel payoffs nor the distribution of a pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.

A complaint was filed against trainer Lance Hellum by vendor Angel's Feed in the amount of \$1,259.61. After a financial agreement was formulated and signed the complaint was signed off.

12/31/16⁴**BELL RULING**

The following ruling was issued after a telephone conversation with trainer Ray Bell. It was reported he has been a repeat offender of the new safety vest rule, a vest is required while on a horse. Mr. Bell stated he had forgotten to wear it in the past.

RULING LATS #010

Trainer THOMAS RAYMOND BELL is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1689.1 (Safety Vest Required) at Santa Anita Park on December 6, 2016.

12/31/16⁵**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

Corey Nakatani and Stewart Elliot joined the Stewards to review their ride yesterday in the third race approaching the 3/8 marker in the 6 furlong event. In a three horse spread going into the turn, Mr. Elliot on the outside, angled inward with marginal clearance causing Mr. Nakatani to apply pressure on a horse to his inside, the inside horse was hanging in a bad spot going into the turn. They were cautioned to be more aware and they agreed, warning.

Mario Gutierrez, a day late, met with the Stewards to review a possible crop violation in the third race on opening day. After a review it was confirmed that he did not violate the rule, but due to his absence on Thursday the following ruling was issued.

RULING LATS #011

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review on December 29, 2016).

Drayden VanDyke met with the Stewards to review his ride in the seventh race yesterday. Mr. VanDyke over used his crop in the stretch run to finish second. As it states in the following ruling this is his third violation in the last sixty days.

RULING LATS #007

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – third offense in last 60 days), during the seventh race at Santa Anita Race Track on December 30, 2016; last offense on November 25, 2016.

12/31/16⁶ **INQUIRY / ACCIDENT / NO CHANGE SECOND RACE ¾ MILE - DIRT**
 Following the running of the race the Inquiry Sign was posted to review the start wherein, #1 GOOD N NAUGHTY stumbled and unseated Jockey Rafael Bejarano. After verifying the stumble was the only reason for the accident, the race was made official.

12/31/16⁷ **VOIDED CLAIM**
 After an examination of #5 Daring Darling in the fifth race by Official Veterinarian Tim Grande, the horse was placed on the Veterinarian's List for being unsound. The claim was voided and the horse returned to the stable of Jerry Hollendorfer.

12/31/16⁸ **INQUIRY JOCKEY OBJECTION DISQUALIFICATION NINTH RACE ¾ dirt**
 The inquiry sign was posted followed by a jockey objection by Martin Pedroza aboard #12 Lucky Dolly who finished second by a neck. The other horse involved was #9 Jill Madden (D. VanDyke 1st). The incident started at the 3/16 marker and continued to the wire. The majority (Chaney dissent) felt the first contact initiated by #9 was enough to cost #12 a better placing. #12 did drift out to make contact late with #9, but the majority felt the effect of this contact was minor at best. Steward Chaney felt the contact made by each horse formulated offsetting penalties and that neither horse was cost a placing. After talking with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved #9 was disqualified and placed second behind #12 and the race was made official.
