### WONG FORMAL HEARING CASE 17SA0003

A complaint was filed against trainer Jonathan Wong for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(c)(1) (Authorized Medication), 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). Present for the hearing before the BOS were, CHRB Investigator Phillip Miyazaki, trainer Jonathan Wong was present by telephone and court reporter Michele Derieg recorded the proceedings. Mr. Wong's runner "Liana Skye" tested for Phenylbutazone by U C Davis Laboratories at a level of 2.45 ug/ml. Mr. Wong stated his practicing Veterinarian, Melinda Blue, treats all his runners with this medication. Official Veterinarian Will Farmer recommended the withdrawal time be extended. Mr. Wong is eligible for and received a warning due to the fact this overage accrued in 2016. The penalties have been revised starting January 1, 2017.

**FRIDAY**02/10/17<sup>1</sup>**MARTINEZ MEETING**

Assistant trainer Silverio Martinez met with the Stewards to discuss his financial situation pertaining to groom wages owed to Adolfo Cardenas in the amount of \$5,300. A revised financial agreement was agreed upon, signed and the following ruling was issued.

**RULING LATS #056**

Assistant trainer/Owner SILVERIO MARTINEZ, having appeared and entered into a financial agreement to settle a debt to groom Adolfo Cardenas (\$5,300.00), is restored to good standing. LATS Ruling #055 dated February 5, 2017 at Santa Anita Park is set aside.

02/10/17<sup>2</sup>**PALMA HEARING CASE #17SA0002**

The CHRB filed a complaint against groom Antonio Palma for a possible violation of CHRB rule 1874 (Disorderly Conduct). After Mr. Palma failed to appear for the scheduled hearing, the following ruling was issued.

**RULING LATS #057**

Groom ANTONIO PALMA having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – fighting and threats ), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges ANTONIO PALMA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), ANTONIO PALMA is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

02/10/17<sup>3</sup>**PENA MEETING**

Jockey Bryan Pena met with the BOS as directed after receiving a complaint about his crop usage during morning training hours. The complaint was that he used the crop four times in succession and the sound reverberated due to the empty grand stand. The strikes sounded loud to those at Clocker's Corner. This is not a violation of a CHRB rule, but Mr. Pena was cautioned to be less aggressive, he stated he would do so.

02/10/17<sup>4</sup>**VALLEJO FORMAL HEARING CASE #16SA263**

The CHRB filed a complaint against assistant trainer Genaro Vallejo for a possible violation of CHRB rules 1690 (Prohibited Equipment) and 1902.5 (Animal Welfare). Present at the hearing were Investigator Jim Hamilton, Genaro Vallejo and court reporter, Dawn Young recorded the proceedings.

The issue being, Genaro Vallejo, assistant trainer for John Brocklebank, hired Mauricio Leyte to gallop the horse "Edlin". On October 31, 2016, he worked the horse a half mile with a spur on his right boot. "Edlin" is the horse involved with the accident and injury of jockey Edwin Maldonado last fall at Del Mar. After the workout, Safety Steward Luis Jauregui witnessed blood on the right side of the horse in the area of the spur. Mr. Vallejo testified he was in the grandstand when Mr. Leyte got on the horse at the barn and he failed to appear on his own behalf and to testify in the Vallejo hearing. Mr. Leyte was also scheduled for a hearing but was not available for testimony. Documents were entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. Decision to follow.

02/10/17<sup>5</sup>**INQUIRY SECOND RACE DISQUALIFICATION 5 1/2 furlong (dirt)**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start. Involved were #1 Tremors Code (J. Sanchez 2nd), #2 Fireball (J. Delgado 5th) and #3 Gato Dolce (F. Prat 3rd). At the break #3 broke inward making contact the second stride with #2 (a step slow), knocking it off stride. #1 did break out slightly. After talking with the Patrol Judge and both jockeys involved, in a majority vote (Chaney dissent) #3 was disqualified from third and placed fifth behind #2. In the majority opinion, #2 was cost the opportunity of a better placing, a neck for fourth place. Jockey Prat made an effort to correct and was held blameless.

The following ruling was issued after Mr. Leyte failed to appear for the rescheduled hearing.

**RULING LATS #058**

Exercise rider MAURICIO LEYTE having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare – spur that caused bleeding), and #1690 (Prohibited Equipment – spurs) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges MAURICIO LEYTE are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), MAURICIO LEYTE is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction

02/11/17<sup>2</sup>**KORINER FORMAL HEARING CASE #17SA0004**

A complaint was filed against trainer Brian Koriner for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(f)(9) (Authorized Medication), 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances). Present for the hearing before the BOS were CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton, trainer Brian Koriner was present by telephone and court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceeding. Mr. Koriner's runner "Loyalist" tested positive for Methocarbamol at a level of 60.0 ug/ml. Mr. Koriner testified there was a runner in his stable that was receiving the medication. He feels the reason for the overage was a mix up of the feed tubs in his shed row. He has since changed his medication program and medication is no longer given in the horse's feed. The following ruling was issued.

**RULING LATS #059**

Trainer BRIAN KORINER, who started the horse LOYALIST in the fifth race at Los Alamitos on December 11, 2016 is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a)(d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances), #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and #1844 (f)(9) (Authorized Medication - Methocarbamol – 60 ng/ml).

02/11/17<sup>3</sup>**THERIOT HEARING CASE #17SA0013**

The CHRB filed a complaint against jockey Jamie Theriot for a possible violation of CHRB rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers.) Representing the CHRB, Investigator Jim Hamilton and Investigator Phillip Miyazaki was present as a witness. Mr. Theriot appeared along with Jockey Guild Representative Darrel Haire and jockey Chantal Sutherland. This case was filed after several reports indicating Mr. Theriot continued to enter the ladies' jockeys' quarters to visit jockey Sutherland after the Stewards had ordered him not to. On the date of the report in the complaint, Investigator Miyazaki, as written in his report that he witnessed, Mr. Theriot enter the room, shut the door and two minutes later come out. Mr. Theriot testified, he did knock on the door to talk to jockey Sutherland for personal reasons, but did not enter, Ms. Sutherland stated his testimony was correct. Today Mr. Miyazaki testified he "thinks" Theriot might have entered the room. After lack of any definitive testimony, the BOS felt it was necessary to dismiss the case.

02/11/17<sup>4</sup>**INQUIRY NO CHANGE EIGHTH RACE 5 1/2 furlongs dirt**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the race. Involved was #2 Who's Hot (F. Prat 8th) who was very late to come out of the gate. After conversation with the Patrol Judge, Starter Jay Slender and a review of the video it was a unanimous decision that the horse reared as the gates opened, causing its own problems, therefore it was declared a starter and the race was made official.

02/11/17<sup>5</sup>**INQUIRY ACCIDENT NO CHANGE NINTH RACE-one mile turf**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an accident approaching the 1/8 pole. Involved was # 5 Eaglemaker who went wrong, falling and unseating jockey Rafael Bejarano. After a review of the video it was a unanimous decision that no other horse was involved in the incident and the race was made official.

**LOWE RULING**

The following ruling reinstating owner Lowe was issued to try and recoup money owed by Mr. Lowe to trainer Jorge Periban for training and farm fees.

**RULING LATS #060**

Trainer Jorge Periban has withdrawn his complaint alleging an unpaid training bill (\$5,904.00) against owner WAYNE LOWE. Therefore, the owner's license of WAYNE LOWE is reinstated. LATC Ruling #042 dated November 6, 2016 at Santa Anita Park is set aside.

02/12/17<sup>2</sup>**LEYTE FORMAL HEARING CASE #16SA238 ref 02-10-17<sup>4</sup>**

The CHRB filed a complaint against exercise rider Mauricio Leyte for a possible violation of CHRB rules 1690 (Prohibited Equipment) and 1902.5 (Animal Welfare). Present at the hearing were Investigator Jim Hamilton and Mauricio Leyte. As were witnesses, Safety Steward Luis Jauregui and assistant trainer Genaro Vallejo. Court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings and trainer Jorge Periban translated for Mr. Leyte. Testimony given is as follows:

Mr. Leyte was hired by Genaro Vallejo, assistant trainer for John Brocklebank, to gallop a specific horse "Eldin" with spurs on.

The horse "Eldin" bolted at Del Mar fall meet, injuring jockey Edwin Maldonado.

The horse "Eldin" is proven to be hard to control and since this incident, trainer John Brocklebank was ordered by Santa Anita to remove the horse from the grounds.

Mr. Leyte testified he was on the horse eleven times, three workouts, always with spurs. to help control the horse.

The day of the incident, he stated the horse was trying to bolt during a workout while inside another horse and he used his outside spur to try to prevent this action. This is what caused the bleeding on the horse's side after the workout.

He stated he did not know spurs are not allowed per CHRB rule 1690 (Prohibited Equipment).

Genaro Vallejo testified that he did accompany Mr. Leyte to the race track the first time he galloped "Eldin".

Decision to follow.

The following ruling was issued after Mr. Leyte appeared for the rescheduled hearing.

**RULING LATS #061**

Exercise rider MAURICIO LEYTE having appeared for a rescheduled hearing is restored to good standing. LATS Ruling #058 issued at Santa Anita Park on February 11, 2017 is set aside.

02/12/17<sup>3</sup>**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

Tyler Baze met with the Stewards to review a possible crop violation in the third race yesterday. After a review of the angles of the stretch run, in a majority decision (Sawyer dissent) Mr. Baze violated the rule by not giving the horse a chance to respond while cropping. The following ruling was issued.

**RULING LATS #062**

Jockey TYLER BAZE is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in last 60 days), during the third race at Santa Anita Race Track on February 11, 2017 (last offense on December 31, 2016).

02/12/17<sup>4</sup>**ACUNA HEARING CASE #17SA014 LATS #063**  
**NICHOLS HEARING CASE #17SA015 LATS #064**

The CHRB filed a complaint against trainers Nicolas Acuna and Samuel Nichols for a possible violation of CHRB rule 1874 (Disorderly Conduct).

On January 6, 2017 Mr. Acuna and Mr. Nichols got into an altercation at the training center at San Luis Rey Downs. It began with verbal accusations over the back wall of the barn they were both stabled in, Mr. Nichols was invited over to Mr. Acuna's side and he accepted. The tension heightened, and the two ended up wrestling on the ground. Mr. Acuna used a rake handle on Mr. Nichols and Mr. Acuna left with a bleeding nose. They were both warned if this kind of action occurs in the future, suspensions would be involved.

Both licensees admitted to their childish behavior and the following two rulings were issued.

**RULING LATS #063**

Owner/Trainer/Outrider NICOLAS ACUNA is fined two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – fighting in stable area).

**RULING LATS #064**

Owner/Trainer SAMUEL NICHOLS is fined two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – fighting in stable area).

02/12/17<sup>5</sup>**MILLER FORMAL HEARING CASE #16DM0116**

A complaint was filed against trainer Peter Miller for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(c)(1)(2) (Authorized Medication), 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances). Present for the hearing before the BOS were CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton, trainer Peter Miller and recording the proceeding, court reporter Michelle Derieg. Mr. Miller's runner "Serbian Cyclone" post race tested by U. C. Davis Laboratory for Phenylbutazone at a level of 0.63 ug/ml and Flunixin at a level of 10.7. Both of these medications were under the permitted level allowed but, only one NSAID is allowed in a post race test samples. Mr. Miller stated his normal medication used for runners is Phenylbutazone. He feels his practicing Veterinarian treated the horse with flunixin instead of Phenylbutazone which has been discussed with them. Decision to follow.

02/12/17<sup>6</sup>**INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION SECOND RACE 6 1/2 furlongs-dirt**

Following the running of the race the Inquiry sign was posted to review an incident approaching the quarter pole. Involved were, #1 Avaudrey (E. Roman 5th), #6 Irish Devil (V. Bednar 7th) and #7 Madera Jubilee (C. Chaparro 4th). After talking to the Patrol Judge and a review of the available views of the incident, in a unanimous decision #1 was disqualified from fifth and placed last behind #6. The opinion being, #1 drifted out forcing #6 on the heels of #7, causing it to clip heels, #7 was not culpable.
