6/7/17¹

ENTRY DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday, June 10, 2017. Steward Scott Chaney was on duty. Eleven (11) races were drawn for this Belmont Stakes day card. The featured eighth race will be the \$75,000 Rainbow Stakes which drew a field of eleven (11). One hundred and nine (109) horses are scheduled to start.

THURSDAY

6/8/17¹

ROBERT BEAN REMAND HEARING (CASE NO.17SA124)

The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

On March 25, 2017 the horse 'Lil Lottie' trained by Robert Bean was entered in the 3rd race at Santa Anita Race Track. Under CHRB Rule 1845 (A) Trainer is required to fill out Form CHRB 194 (Authorized Bleeder Medication Request). Form shall be used to notify the Official Veterinarian prior to entry. Trainer Robert Bean was fined \$400 for late bleeder registration. (Ruling #106). Trainer Robert Bean appealed the ruling and the case was remanded back to the Board of Stewards at Santa Anita Race Track.

Along with the Stewards, present today were Trainer Robert Bean, Luann Bean (Wife), CHRB Investigator James Hamilton and court reporter Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Reporting LLC). Steward Sawyer chaired the hearing. The Stewards asked several questions and heard testimony from Robert and Luann Bean. The horse 'Lil Lottie' was shown in the program as being off the medication Lasix for the first time. The horse was treated with Lasix and announcements and video graphics addressed the error. Trainer Bean testified today as to the reasons that contributed to the program error. This hearing was originally scheduled for Sunday, May 28. Mr. Bean requested and was granted a continuance for that first hearing date. Decision to follow.

6/8/17²**SCRATCH TIME**

Scratches and changes for Friday, June 9 took place this morning in the racing office. There was one (1) scratch and three (3) jockey changes submitted. All changes were activated after the 10 a.m. deadline.

6/8/17³**RACING CANCELLED**

The racing office informed us on Saturday, June 3 that entries for Thursday, June 8 would be carried over until Sunday, June 4. On Sunday, Assistant Racing Secretary Zac Soto informed the Stewards during the races that racing on Thursday, June 8 would be cancelled. Racing will resume Friday, July 9.

FRIDAY6/9/17¹**RON ELLIS HEARING CONTINUED (REF: 5/23/17(2))**

A formal hearing was held in our office for Trainer Ron Ellis. Along with the Stewards and Trainer Ellis, present today were Pasadena based attorney Steve Schwartz, Deputy Attorney General Venessa Martinez and CHRB Staff Counsel Philip Laird. CHRB Equine Medical Director Rick Arthur testified in person. Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Reporting LLC) transcribed the proceedings.

This hearing (Case No. 16SA0260) began on May 22, 2017 and this is the third day of testimony. The CHRB complaint in this matter alleges that Trainer Ellis violated CHRB Rule #1843 (A) (D) Medication, Drugs and Other Substances, Rule #1843.1 (A) Prohibited Drug Substances and Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse). This hearing involves the official urine and blood samples taken on November 5, 2016 from the horse Masochistic which contained Stanazolol. Masochistic finished second in the Breeders' Cup Sprint (Purse \$1,500,000) and was subsequently disqualified in a separate hearing and subsequent ruling (ref: LATS ruling #009 – 12/31/16). Following this third day of testimony the Stewards adjourned this matter due to time constraints. All parties agreed to the next hearing date which will be June 15, 2017 at 9 a.m.

6/9/17²**FIRST RACE INQUIRY JOCKEY OBJECTION/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following this race after viewing fourth place finisher #2 What'sontheagenda (Tiago Pereira) steady sharply from between horses inside the 1/8 mile marker. Jockey Tiago Pereira also lodged an objection against both first place finisher #6 Vending Machine (Norberto Arroyo Jr) and second place finisher #5 Mr. Hinx (Evin Roman).

Film review shows #7 Vending Machine and #5 Mr. Hinx racing 'head and head' with #2 What'sontheagenda ½ of a length back, while racing between those two (2) rivals in this contest at about 6 ½ furlong race on the Hillside Turf Course. The Stewards determined that #6 Vending Machine stepped out slightly from his straight path along the rail and initiated contact with #2 What'sontheagenda forcing Jockey Pereira to steady sharply and lose much ground costing him an opportunity for third position. The Stewards received a patrol judge report and spoke with all three (3) jockey's involved. In a unanimous decision #6 Vending Machine was disqualified and placed fourth. Jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. was ordered to film review with the stewards.

6/9/17³**FOURTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to review to review three (3) separate incidents in this one (1) mile turf event.

Incident #1- Third place finisher #2 Captain Cali (Brice Blanc) and fifth place finisher #6 Hi Heat Boy (Austin Solis) made contact at the 1/8 mile marker.

Incident #2- Sixth place finisher #3 Fall Harvest (Chantal Sutherland) drifts in under right handed cropping and makes contact with #4 seventh place finisher Burnie's On Board (Santiago Gonzalez) forcing that rival to steady very sharply approaching the 1/16th pole.

Incident #3- Second place finisher #5 Warren's Fandango (Tyler Baze) drifts out and makes contact with #6 Hi Heat Boy (Austin Solis).

The Stewards made no change for incidents #1 and #3. However in Incident #2 #3 Fall Harvest was disqualified and placed seventh. This decision was unanimous. Jockey Sutherland was ordered to film review.

6/9/17⁴**PETER MILLER RULING**

Trainer Peter Miller called us this morning from Belmont Park, New York stating that he would need to scratch #8 Juansagain from today's sixth race. The majority of Trainer Miller's horses are stabled at San Luis Rey Downs. During morning pre-race examination CHRB Veterinarian Tim Grande, while checking a lip tattoo, noted that the horse he was examining for Miller was a horse that is racing here tomorrow and not 'Juansagain'. Juansagain was still at San Luis Rey Downs and had been incorrectly medicated with bute. Trainer Miller apologized for the mix up and the Stewards who, in a unanimous decision, issued the following ruling.

RULING #186

Trainer PETER MILLER is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – treated in-today horse) in the sixth race on June 9, 2017, at Santa Anita Park.

VICTOR ESPINOZA FILM REVIEW

Jockey Gary Stevens appeared in our office this morning in order to represent Jockey Victor Espinoza who is in New York today in order to ride in the 149th running of The Belmont Stakes. Yesterday (June 9) Jockey Espinoza was aboard third place finisher #7 Skelton Pass in the seventh race which was contested at about 6 ½ furlongs on the hillside turf course. At the ½ mile marker, coming down the hill #7 Skelton Pass shifted inward 'coming out' of the right hand turn. This shift caused sixth place finisher #6 Mischief Clem (Jamie Theriot) to check sharply in order to avoid clipping heels. Jockey Espinoza appeared to be unaware of this rival who was in close proximity when he shifted over to his left. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, felt this constituted a careless ride. Jockey Espinoza's agent Brian Beach was notified via telephone of the following sanction.

RULING # 187

Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA, who rode SKELTON PASS in the seventh race at Santa Anita Park on June 9, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 16, 17 and 18, 2017) for altering course without sufficient clearance causing interference near the half mile pole on the hillside turf course. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

CHANTAL SUTHERLAND FILM REVIEW (REF:6/9/17³)

Jockey Chantal Sutherland appeared in the Stewards office in order to review her ride in the fourth race yesterday (June 9). In this one (1) mile turf race Jockey Sutherland was aboard #3 Fall Harvest who finished sixth. Approaching the 1/16th pole #3 Fall Harvest drifts in and takes the path of seventh place finisher #4 Burnie's On Board (Santiago Gonzalez) forcing that rival to steady sharply in tight quarters along the rail. Ms. Sutherland was disappointed in her own efforts and accepted full responsibility for a careless ride. In a unanimous decision the stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #188

Jockey CHANTAL SUTHERLAND, who rode FALL HARVEST in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on June 9, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 16, 17 and 18, 2017) for altering course without sufficient clearance causing interference in the stretch resulting in the disqualification of her mount from sixth to seventh position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

NORBERTO ARROYO JR. FILM REVIEW

Jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. appeared in the Stewards office, accompanied by his agent Nelson Arroyo, in order to review his ride aboard #6 Vending Machine in yesterday's first race. Jockey Arroyo Jr. was aboard #6 Vending Machine who finished first but disqualified and placed fourth for stretch interference (REF: 6/9/17² in this about 6 ½ furlong turf event. Agent Arroyo did most of the talking during film review. #6 Vending Machine stepped outward inside the 1/16th pole of this race. While this horse's path did not change dramatically it was enough to cause interference and led to a subsequent disqualification. The Stewards unanimously felt that this was not a careless ride. Jockey Arroyo was subsequently excused.

6/10/17⁴

KENT DESORMEAUX MATTER

Jockey Kent Desormeaux used his riding crop three (3) times following a morning workout on the R.B.Hess Jr. trained 'Dragonslayer' on May 28, 2017. XBTv videotaped the workout which was provided to the Stewards. Jockey Desormeaux told the Stewards his horse was attempting to prop following the workout. None of the stewards were

convinced of this analysis. Steward Baker voted for a 1874 (Disorderly Conduct) violation. The majority felt that there was no rule addressed misuse of the riding crop during morning workouts in our rulebook. However an 'Official Warning' memorializing this matter will be put on Jockey Desormeaux's record.

SIXTH RACE STEWARDS REVIEW/INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

A Stewards' review was originally announced following this race after which the Inquiry sign was posted. Entering the first turn original fifth place finisher #3 Runasaurus Rex (Norberto Arroyo Jr.) bolts in this one (1) mile turf event. This affects the efforts of three (3) horses. Most affected was eighth (last) place finisher #11 Hawk's Eyes(BRZ) who lost ground while being forced very wide. For this action #3 Runasaurus Rex, in a unanimous decision, was disqualified and placed eighth.

EIGHTH RACE STEWARDS INQUIRY/JOCKEY OBJECTION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the eighth race (\$75,000 Added Rainbow Stakes) in order to review the stretch run of this 1 1/8 mile turf race. There was also a jockey objection in this race (#1 against #2). At the 1/16th mile marker second place #2 Conquest Fahrenheit (Norberto Arroyo Jr.) drifts in under right handed crop and forces third place finisher #1 Monster Man (Santiago Gonzalez) to steady his mount sharply from between horses. The horse to his inside was eventual winner #9 Sharp Samurai (Gary Stevens). #1 Monster Man was not cost the opportunity of a better placing, so the stewards, in a unanimous decision allowed the original placings to stand. No change. Jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

Jockey David Flores appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #8 Big Bane Theory, who finished third in today's third race which was contested at one (1) mile on the turf course. Jockey Flores used his riding crop over the allowable three (3) consecutive time in the stretch drive of this race. He did not dispute the following rule violation.

LATS RULING #189

Jockey DAVID FLORES is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on June 10, 2017.

6/11/17²**MARTIN PEDROZA FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Martin Pedroza was ordered to film review today in order to review his ride aboard #1 Harrovian (Martin Pedroza) who finished seventh in the seventh race yesterday June 10. Approaching the ¼ pole of this one (1) mile main track event #1 Harrovian, steps inward and forces eventual fifth place finisher #2 Waldorf (Gary Stevens) to 'check his mount'. Jockey Pedroza was cautioned to be more 'heads up' in his riding endeavors. No penalty. The decision was unanimous.

6/11/17³**BRICE BLANC FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Brice Blanc appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #2 Captain Call who finished third in this one (1) mile turf event which was run on Friday June 9. There was a Stewards' inquiry in this race (REF: 6/9/17²). #2 Captain Call lugged in at the 1/8 mile marker in this race and makes contact with fifth place finisher #6 Hi Heat Boy (Austin Solis). After the film review the Stewards unanimously determined that the blame for the bumping in this event should be on Jockey Blanc's mount and not the jockey himself.

6/11/17⁴**TYLER BAZE FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Tyler Baze appeared in the Stewards' office in order review his ride aboard #5 Warren's Fandango who finished second in the fourth race on Friday June 9. In the stretch drive of this one (1) mile turf event #5 Warren's Fandango drifts out and brushes with #6 Hi Heat Boy (Austin Solis) at the 1/16th marker. This incident was deemed minor and Jockey Baze was excused without any sanction.

6/11/17⁵**FLAVIEN PRAT FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Flavien Prat appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #9 Daddy D T who finished first in the third race yesterday, June 10. Replays of the stretch run of this race show Jockey Prat use his riding crop more than three (3) consecutive times. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #190

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the third race at Santa Anita Park on June 10, 2017.

6/11/17⁶**JOSEPH TALAMO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Joe Talamo was called in for film review in order to observe his ride aboard #5 Lyrics who finished third in the first race yesterday which was contested at one (1) mile on the turf course. Around the 1/8th pole Jockey Talamo drifts in on fourth place finisher #2 Oh Scatty Oh (Flavien Prat) causing that rival to check his mount. Jockey Talamo was cautioned that repeated actions similar to this may result in penalties from the Stewards.

6/11/17⁷**NORBERTO ARROYO JR. FILM REVIEW (REF:6/10/17⁶)**

Jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. appeared in the Stewards office this morning in order to review his ride in yesterday's (June 10) eighth race (\$75,000 added-Rainbow Stakes) which was contested at 1 1/8 miles on the turf course. Jockey was aboard second place finisher #2 Conquest Farenheit who drifted in under a right handed crop and forced third place finisher #1 Monster Man to steady sharply. Film review also shows #2 Conquest Farenheit being steered inward. Jockey Arroyo was issued a five (5) day riding suspension on May 4, 2017 (REF LATS Ruling #143). That ruling was his second riding suspension in a 60 day period. This ruling is also his second riding suspension in a 60 day period. The majority voted for the ruling below. Steward Baker voted for a 5 day suspension.

LATS RULING #191

Jockey NORBERTO ARROYO, JR., who rode CONQUEST FARENHEIT in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on June 10, 2017 is suspended for FOUR (4) racing days (June 17, 18, 23 and 24, 2017) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course and causing interference in the stretch. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

6/11/17⁸**HUGO ALAVAREZ COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA139)**

Pony Rider Hugo Alvarez failed to appear for a scheduled 10:00 a.m. hearing today in the Stewards office. The CHRB alleges that Mr. Alvarez violation CRBB Rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations). This case revolves around the alleged theft of a 'muck cart' on or about May 21, 2017 in the Santa Anita stable area. Mr. Alvarez was placed on probation March 25, 2017 (REF: LATS Ruling #104) for failing to properly clean and maintain a pony stall. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #192

Pony Rider HUGO ALVAREZ having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874(3) (Disorderly Conduct – alleged muck cart theft) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges HUGO ALVAREZ are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), HUGO ALVAREZ is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

6/11/17⁹**RACING SCHOOL VISITOR**

Wendy Davis is the longtime director of the University of Arizona Race Track Industry Program. Ms. Davis visited the Stewards in our judges' stand today. The majority of Southern California Stewards will be attending a 16 hour continuing education (CE) program which starts tomorrow at the Courtyard Marriott in Monrovia CA. In addition to our local contingent, there are around 25 additional students from throughout the country and also world (Korea & Jamaica). The bulk of the students in town are participating in a 60 hour (Monday thru Sunday) class. They are scheduled to visit the Stewards and several other racing officials here at Santa Anita on Saturday, June 17.

6/11/17¹⁰**SECOND RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards announced that a Stewards review would be conducted into the start of today's second race which was contested at six (6) furlongs. Race replays showed #1 Precious Caroline (Evin Roman) rear at the start and lose much ground. Apprentice Roman lost his irons in the process. The Stewards did not post the Inquiry sign. Apprentice Roman regained his irons and this longshot went on to a fifth place finish.

6/11/17¹¹**FIFTH RACE POST PARADE MISHAP**

During the warm-up period prior to today's fifth race (Special Goddess Stakes-\$75,000 added) Jockey Rafael Bejarano (#4 Spy King (IRE)) was unseated. This horse ran loose, at a significant amount of speed, up the hill, prior to this about 6 ½ furlong stake race. The Stewards scratched this horse. It was reported that this horse made contact with Jockey Bejarano's leg.

Jockey Rafael Bejarano was transported via human ambulance to Arcadia Methodist Hospital for observation.
