ENTRY DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Day 40, Saturday, July 17, 2017. Steward Kim Sawyer was on duty. Ten (10) races were drawn. Eighty seven (87) horses are scheduled to start.

THURSDAY
6/29/17¹

ENTRY/SCRATCH DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Day 41, Sunday, July 18, 2017. Nine (9) races were drawn for Sunday, July 2, 2017. Seventy three (73) horses are scheduled to start. Scratches and changes for Friday, June 30 were taken today in the racing office. One (1) scratch was submitted. That change was activated after the 10:00 a.m. deadline.

JOHN SADLER COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA162)

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer John Sadler for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1866 (Veterinarian's List). The cover page of the complaint reads as follows:

The horse 'Nothins Free' trained by John Sadler was entered in the 3rd Race at Santa Anita Race Track on June 9th 2017. The horse 'Nothins Free' was subsequently scratched for being injured and placed on the veterinarians list. On June 11, 2017 the horse 'Nothins Free' worked 4F out of the gate at Santa Anita Race Track in 47.20 handily. Under Rule 1866 (A)(3) a horse placed on the veterinarian's list may not work out for 72 hours after being placed on the list without permission of the official veterinarian.

Trainer Sadler appeared in our office and told us that this horse was entered on a Sunday for Friday, June 9. Mr. Sadler told us this two year old filly 'tied up' on Monday, June 12. He was candid and told us that he forgot about the portion of Rule #1866 that prevents horses from working out after being placed on the vet's list without the permission of the official veterinarian. Decision to follow.

6/29/17³**PETER MILLER COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA161)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer Peter Miller for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). The cover page of the complaint reads as follows:

On June 10, 2017 the horse 'Fly To Mars' trained by Peter Miller was entered in the 11th race at Santa Anita Race Track. The official program listed 'Fly To Mars' as a colt. The foal papers; computerized entry form; hard copy entry for all show 'Fly To Mars' to be a colt. Jennifer Paige (Official Horse Identifier) identified 'Fly To Mars' as a gelding when the horse 'Fly To Mars' as a gelding when the horse 'Fly To Mars' arrived at the receiving barn. Follow-up report for additional info.

Trainer Miller testified today via telephone. This horse was announced as a first time gelding (REF: 6/10/17⁷) roughly 22 minutes prior to the 11th race on June 10th 2017. The official entry blank did not state the sex of this horse. Trainer Miller accepted responsibility in this matter stating it was an 'oversight'. Decision to follow.

6/29/17⁴**ALI NILFORUSHAN COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA0079)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Owner Ali Nilforushan for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). The cover page of the complaint reads as follows:

Trainer Rueben Gomez alleges that in December 2016 owner Ali Nilforushan sent him harassing text messages to his cell phone. On March 25, 2017, Nilforushan yelled at Gomez and called him a "horsekiller" at Santa Anita Race Track near the Gift Shop.

Present today were Owner Ali Nilforushan, his wife Francie Nilforushan, Santa Anita Security Guard Ben Denovel and CHRB Investigator Phil Miyazaki.

Copies of twelve (12) threatening (some very threatening) text messages were included in Investigator Miyazaki's twenty six (26) page complaint packet. Owner Nilforushan and Trainer Gomez both testified regarding the threats in this case that allegedly took place between December 2016 and March 25, 2017. Decision to follow.

6/30/17¹**EDUARDO MUNOZ (CASE NO. 17SA0165)**

The complaint in this race reads as follows:

Trainer Alfredo Marquez alleges owner Eduardo Munoz is indebted to him in the amount of \$8,661.00 Trainer Alfredo Marquez appeared in our office today. Owner Eduardo Munoz failed to appear. This complaint alleges that Owner Munoz violated CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). This case involves training bills for two (2) horses that have been In Trainer Marquez' barn. Decision to follow.

6/30/17²**JOHN SADLER RULING (REF: 5/29/17²)**

The following ruling was issued following deliberation of an informal hearing (Case No.17SA162) involving trainer John Sadler at Santa Anita yesterday. The decision was unanimous.

LATS RULING #215

Trainer JOHN SADLER who worked out the horse NOTHINS FREE on June 11, 2017 48 hours after being placed on the Veterinarian's List) is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1866(b)(3) (Veterinarian's List – may not work out for 72 hours after being placed on list {injured}).

6/30/17³**MARIO GUTIERREZ FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Agent and former Racing Secretary Tom Knust appeared in our office on behalf of Jockey Mario Gutierrez. The Stewards wanted to review the running of the tenth race on Sunday, June 25, 2017. In this one (1) mile turf event Gutierrez was aboard second place finisher #5 Over Par. Film review shows Jockey Gutierrez violate the crop rule (CHRB Rule

#1688) on two (2) separate occasions in the stretch drive of this race. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #216

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for two (2) violations of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first and second offenses in last 60 days), during the tenth race at Santa Anita Park on June 25, 2017.

6/30/17⁴

ISRAEL OCAMPO FILM REVIEW

Jockey Israel Ocampo appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in the sixth race on Sunday, June 25, 2017. Jockey Ocampo finished second (#5 Watch This Cat) in this 6 ½ furlong turf (down the hill) race which had five (5) participants. At the ½ mile marker, during the downhill portion, of this race #5 Watch This Cat angles in very sharply forcing fifth (last) finisher #3 Roo's Valentine (Martin Pedroza) to steady very sharply while nearly clipping heels. Jockey Ocampo acknowledged that he was not aware of the location of that rival at the time of the incident. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following penalty.

LATS RULING #217

Jockey ISRAEL OCAMPO, who rode WATCH THIS CAT in the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on June 25, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (July 9, 13 and 14, 2017) for altering course without sufficient clearance causing interference near the half mile pole on the hillside turf course. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

NICK CAFARCHIA VISIT (REF: 6/23/17¹ & 6/25/17⁴)

Owner Nick Cafarchia appeared in our office this morning wanting to know the status of purse monies being frozen by the Stewards following the first place finish of the Cafarchia owned #8 My Italian Babbo (8th Race-June 24). Mr. Cafarchia's license was in good standing on the day of entry but he was suspended prior to race day for failing to appear at a hearing. Mr. Cafarchia was notified that the Stewards have received two (2) protests from other owners in this race and that a formal hearing would be upcoming. He indicated he would be hiring a lawyer. More to follow.

6/30/17⁶

PETER MILLER RULING (Ref: 6/29-17³)

Trainer Peter Miller called in today to participate in an informal hearing. The Miller trained 'FLY TO MARS' was listed as a colt in the 11th race on June 10, 2017. Horse Identifier Jenifer Page caught the error when the horse arrived at the receiving barn on race day. Trainer Miller took responsibility for not identifying this horse as a gelding at entry time. Miller was fined \$1,000 last month (Ref: LATS Ruling #204) in a separate case. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

LATS Ruling #218

Trainer PETER MILLER is fined ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,250.00)* for failure to properly report the gelding of the horse FLY TO MARS which ran in the eleventh race at Santa Anita Park on June 10, 2017. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse – third offense).

SATURDAY7/1/17¹**SAUL MARQUEZ MEETING**

Valet/Colors Room Attendant/Assistant Trainer Saul Marquez appeared in the Stewards' Office as ordered this morning. Mr. Marquez is the colors room attendant at Santa Anita. He is also assistant trainer for Trainer Mick Ruis. Mr. Marquez was told last week to attend to his jockey's room duties (colors) and not act as an assistant trainer while doing his primary job in the jockey's room.

7/1/17²**ALI NILFORUSHAN RULING (REF: 6/29/17⁴)**

The ruling below serves two (2) purposes. First it reinstates the license privileges of Owner Ali Nilfourushan who failed to appear for two (2) previous hearings regarding this matter earlier this year. It also penalizes Mr. Nilforushan for violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). Steward Chaney agreed on a penalty albeit a smaller fine.

LATS RULING #219

Owner ALI NILFORUSHAN having appeared before this Board of Stewards for a rescheduled hearing is restored to good standing, LATS ruling #177 dated May 27, 2017, is set aside. Furthermore Owner ALI NILFORUSHAN is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – threatening, abusive or aggressive behavior toward another person).

7/1/17³**DRAYDEN VAN DYKE RULING**

Jockey Drayden Van Dyke was ordered to film review following his victory aboard #4 Pleasant as Pie in yesterday's third race. Jockey Van Dyke waived his right to a hearing after appearing to use his riding crop (5) consecutive times in the stretch drive of this 6 ½ (down the hill) turf race. The Stewards reviewed race replays this morning and the films substantiated the violation. The following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #220

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the third race at Santa Anita Park on June 30, 2017.

7/1/17⁴**BRANDON BOULANGER RULING (CASE #17SA138)**

At the Santa Anita Stewards' request, Jockey Brandon Boulanger submitted to a drug test with CHRB enforcement on May 23, 2017. Quest Diagnostic Laboratory report indicated that Brandon Boulanger was positive for marijuana metabolites (31ng/ml). (REF: 6/17/17²). In a unanimous decision, the Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #221

Jockey BRANDON BOULANGER is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489(a)(8) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – marijuana positive).

For as long as he holds a California Horse Racing Board license, BRANDON BOULANGER must abide by the terms of a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board. He shall also enter into a contract with the Winners' Foundation and abide by their terms. Failure to comply will be grounds for actions against his license and license privileges.

7/1/17⁵**EDUARDO MUNOZ COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17SA0165)**

Owner Eduardo Munoz failed to appear for a hearing here at Santa Anita yesterday (June 30). Trainer Alfredo Marquez filed a complaint against Mr. Munoz alleging horse training bills past due in the amount of \$8,661.00. Trainer Marquez did appear in our office and was told that we would issue the following ruling.

LATS RULING #222

Owner EDUARDO MUNOZ, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility –Trainer Alfredo Marquez - \$8,661.00) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of EDUARDO MUNOZ are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine) EDUARDO MUNOZ is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

7/1/17⁶**GEORGE PAPAPRODROMOU DECISION (REF:6/18/17⁵)****LATS RULING #223**

Trainer GEORGE PAPAPRODROMOU is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting – assisted in avoiding 3 horse entry rule per race).

Trainer George Papaprodromou was informed of the ruling above via telephone. Steward Sawyer believed there was not a rule violation, therefore dissented voting for a dismissal. Mr. Papaprodromou assisted Owner Ariel Beca and Ruben Loza, who also shoes horses for Trainer Richard Baltas, in racing the horse 'Flaming Vixen' on August 18, 2016 (5th Race) at Del Mar. Flaming Vixen was in the barn of Trainer Richard Baltas at San Luis Rey Downs. Trainer Baltas already had two (2) runners entered in this race and could not start three (3) per conditions of the race meeting. Owners Beca and Loza put his horse into the care (transferred) of Trainer Papaprodromou after the horse was entered while in Trainer Baltas' stable. An investigation determined that 'Flaming Vixen' was never trained by Papaprodromou and was only in his barn at Del Mar for less than forty eight (48) hours. All of the Stewards felt that Rule #1502 (Program Trainer Prohibited) was not violated as it primarily addresses avoiding worker's compensation. This hearing was held on June 18, 2017 (Case No. 17SA144)

7/1/17⁷**MERSAD METANOVIC COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA0173)**

Owner Wendy Soo Hoo, representing Bliss Canyon Stables, informed the Stewards that Owner Mersad Metanovic has paid in full his alleged debt to this farm in the amount of \$1,068.75. Case dismissed.

7/1/17⁸**THIRD RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

Following this race the Stewards informed the public that a 'Stewards' Review' would be conducted into the start of this seven (7) furlong event. Film review shows post time favorite (Odds 8/5) #1 Papa Papa Papa 'pull back' at the break and lose several lengths from his inside post. After the Stewards spoke with Starter Jay Slender via two-way radio the Stewards determined there was no reason to conduct a Stewards' Inquiry.

SUNDAY7/2/17¹**EDGAR OROZCO RULING**

Apprentice Jockey Edgar Orozco allegedly violated CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop) on Sunday, June 25, 2017 at Santa Anita. Mr. Orozco was originally ordered to appear Friday, June 30. He asked for and was granted permission to attend film review yesterday July 1. He failed to appear yesterday nor did he call us. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #224

Apprentice Jockey EDGAR OROZCO is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review on June 30, 2017).

7/2/17²**ANOTHER EDGAR OROZCO RULING**

Apprentice Jockey Edgar Orozco appeared in our office to review his ride in the fourth race on Sunday, June 25. Apprentice Orozco was aboard #4 Ryderroo who finished second in this 5 ½ furlong main track event. Mr. Orozco used his riding crop excessively from the 3/16th marker to the wire. He understood the reasoning behind the following sanction.

LATS RULING #225

Apprentice Jockey EDGAR OROZCO is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for blatant violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – multiple violations in one race), during the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on June 25, 2017.

7/2/17³**KENT DESORMEAUX RULING**

Jockey Kent Desormeaux was issued a four (4) day suspension by Santa Anita Stewards on June 18, 2017 (REF: Ruling #201). He rode in the Mother Goose Sakes at Belmont Park New York yesterday while still on suspension in California. The following ruling issues a new suspension day (July 15) that is an equivalent day (Saturday) which is in accordance with CHRB Rule #1766 (Designated Races).

LATS RULING #226

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX is suspended for ONE (1) additional RACING DAY (July 15, 2017) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races – participated in one designated race in another jurisdiction on July 1, 2017).

7/2/17⁴**RAFAEL BEJARANO RULING**

Jockey Rafael Bejarano appeared after receiving a violation notice from the Santa Anita morning outriders yesterday July 1. Jockey Bejarano was accused of working out a horse after being advised not to by a morning outrider following an injury during training. Lead Outrider John Cortez testified via speaker phone that race track warning lights and siren were on at the time of the workout. The following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #227

Jockey Rafael Bejarano is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – breezing during an emergency).

7/2/17⁵**COREY NAKATANI RULING**

The circumstances of this ruling are almost identical to Ruling #226 listed above. Jockey Corey Nakatani was working out a horse yesterday (July 1) while the warning lights were flashing and a siren was blaring. Jockey Nakatani was present while Head Outrider John Cortez recounted the events via speaker phone. The following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #228

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – breezing during an emergency).

7/2/17⁶**LATE CORRECTED WEIGHT**

While the horses for the fifth race (Landaluce Stakes - \$100,000) were being assembled to saddle, Clerk of the Scales Kevin Colosi and Assistant Charlie McCaul informed the Steward in the paddock that there was an incorrect lighter weight on #3 SPIRIT OF SHANGHAI (Edwin Maldonado). Clerk of the Scales Colosi was informed of this error by a trainer that did not have a horse in the race.

Jockey Maldonado had to recheck on the scales in the jockeys' room after the error was corrected. According to race conditions SPIRIT OF SHANGHAI was to carry 120 lbs. Announcements of the corrections were made. The CHRB investigative staff will look into what led to the error. The official program listed 118 lbs. as the weight.

Exercise Rider JOHN BUCKLEY is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – breezing during an emergency).

LATS RULING #231

Exercise Rider PATRICE ROUX is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – breezing during an emergency).

7/3/17³**AUSTIN SOLIS FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice Jockey Austin Solis failed to appear for a film review as ordered yesterday July 2. Today he appeared to review his ride in the second race on Saturday July 1.
