#### ENTRY DAY

The Santa Anita racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday, October 28, 2018. Steward Kim Sawyer was on duty overseeing entries. One hundred five (105) horses are slated to face Starter Jay Slender on this eleven (11) race card held on the closing weekend of the meet.

#### THURSDAY

10/26/17<sup>1</sup>

#### FLAVIEN PRAT FILM REVIEW

Jockey Flavien Prat appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in the fourth race on Sunday, October 22. Jockey Prat was aboard #1 Ritzy A.P. who finished second in this race. Film review this morning shows Jockey Prat use his riding crop four (4) consecutive times while closing strongly in the stretch run of this one (1) mile turf event. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

#### **LATS RULING #030**

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in last 60 days; last offense on October 8, 2017), during the FOURTH race at Santa Anita Park on October 22, 2017.

#### JAMIE THERIOT COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17LTOO11)

A fourteen (14) page complaint was filed against Jockey JAMIE THERIOT alleging violation of CHRB Rule #1682 (Weighing Out), Rule #1683 Maximum Overweight and Rule #1684 (Items Included in Weight). The complaint in this matter read as follows:

*On August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Clerk of Scales Charles McCaul was weighing out jockeys for the 2<sup>nd</sup> race at Del Mar. Charles McCaul weighed **out** Jockey Jamie Theriot with a small black saddle. After the 2<sup>nd</sup> Race Clerk of Scales McCaul was at the scales to weigh **in** the*

*jockeys after the race. Charles McCaul observed that Jockey Jamie Theriot was approaching the scales to weigh in had a different saddle than he weighed with.*

Along with the Stewards, present today were Safety Steward Luis Jauregui, Jockey Jamie Theriot, CHRB Supervising Investigator Phil Miyazaki, Jockey Guild Western Regional Manager Darrel Haire and Dawn Young (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) who transcribed the proceedings. Jockey Guild attorney Mindy Coleman listened in on the formal hearing from her office in Lexington KY. Del Mar Clerk of Scales Charlie McCaul testified at the hearing. CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton conducted the investigation into this matter.

This hearing was originally scheduled for November 12, 2017. On Saturday, October 21 Jockey Chantal Sutherland, representing Mr. Theriot stated that Jockey Theriot wanted to address this case as soon as possible therefore the hearing was 'moved up' to today's date. Testimony was given today and the complaint was entered into evidence. Decision to follow.

**AMMENDED RULING**

The following ruling, originally issued last week, corrects the name of the racetrack where the rule violation took place.

**LATS RULING #029**

Trainer JAVIER SIERRA, who started the horse GUTSY RULER, first place finisher in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 6, 2017, is fined SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)\* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), and #1843.1 (Prohibited Drug Substances – Flumethasone – 12 pg/ml).

**THIRD RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards informed Track Announcer Michael Wrona and the television department that a 'Stewards Review' would be conducted into the running of the third race which was contested at abt. 6 ½ furlongs on the downhill turf course. Of particular interest were the actions of tenth (last) place finisher Gringo Star (Victor Espinoza). Roughly a furlong after the start # 8 Gringo Stan ducks out sharply while racing towards the front of the pack. Jockey Espinoza lost his riding irons and no other horses were affected. Jockey Espinoza fortunately was able to control his horse after the incident. The Stewards determined that a Stewards' Inquiry was not necessary.

**REINSMAN RETURNS**

Twenty- five (25) year old journeyman Kyle Frey returned from a layoff to win a race on his first day back since he last rode the opening week of Del Mar (July 2017). Jockey Frey won today's eighth race aboard the Doug O'Neill trained #3 Extraordinary Jerry. Jockey Frey had surgery back in late July to address a previous injury he had back in Pennsylvania. He reports that he is feeling excellent now.

CHRB Executive Director Rick Baedeker and CHRB Equine Medical Director Rick Arthur visited the Stewards' office this morning. Several topics were discussed.

10/27/17<sup>2</sup>**ADAM KITCHINGMAN RULING (CASE NO. 17DM072)**

The ruling below was issued after deliberation following a hearing that was held on Sunday, October 22. Trainer Adam Kitchingman was notified of this penalty over the telephone.

**LATS RULING #031**

Trainer ADAM KITCHINGMAN, who started the horse UNOBTAINABLE, first place finisher in the FIFTH race at Del Mar Race Track on August 11, 2017, is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), and #1843.1(b) (Authorized Medication – Cobalt – in excess of permitted level [26.1 ng/ml]).

10/27/17<sup>3</sup>**RITO ALMANZA INFORMAL HEARING**

Jockey Rito Almanza appeared in the Stewards' office regarding an incident yesterday (October 26) where he arrived late to the walking ring prior to being legged up on the Sally Rivera trained #7 Southern Darling who finished seventh (last) in this race. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui helped with interpreting. Almanza apologized for his tardiness prior to being informed of the ruling below.

**LATS RULING #032**

Jockey RITO ALMANZA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – late to paddock), before the FOURTH race at Santa Anita Park on October 26, 2017.

10/27/17<sup>4</sup>**SALVADOR INIGUEZ MATTER**

Jockey Salvador Iniguez was late to the walking ring prior to riding his lone mount of the day, #4 Family Rules (Tr. Duff Shidaker) in yesterday's (October 26) fourth race. Jockey Iniguez pled guilty and was informed there would be a penalty yesterday. He appeared in our office today disagreeing with our addressing of this matter. While he was clearly upset with our enforcement yesterday he was a little more amenable today of the unanimous decision issued below.

**LATS RULING #033**

Jockey SALVADOR INIGUEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – late to paddock), before the FOURTH race at Santa Anita Park on October 26, 2017.

10/27/17<sup>5</sup>**COREY NAKATANI RULING**

Jockey Corey Nakatani appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in the sixth race on October 26. In this Abt. 6 ½ furlong turf race Jockey Nakatani was aboard third place finisher #3 Tribal Fighter. The Stewards unanimously felt that this rider used his riding crop five (5) consecutive times without giving his horse a chance to respond. The following ruling was issued.

**LATS RULING #034**

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – third offense in last 60 days), during the SIXTH race at Santa Anita Park on October 26, 2017 (last offense September 7, 2017).

10/27/17<sup>6</sup>**BOB SKIBINSKI RULING (REF:10/5/17(8))**

The following ruling reinstates the license privileges of Owner Bob Skibinski. Private Veterinarian Melinda Blue informed the Stewards that the \$319.31 that Dr. Blue claimed was owed to her has now been paid in full.

**LATS RULING #035**

Owner BOB SKIBINSKI, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – Satisfied Debt to Veterinarian Melinda Blue) is restored to good standing. Ruling LATC #007 issued at Santa Anita Park on October 6, 2017, is set aside.

10/27/17<sup>7</sup>**HUMBERTO BELTRAN RULING**

Santa Anita Park Security Sgt. Michael Valadez issued a 'violation notice' to Exercise Rider Humberto Beltran for disobeying the 'Horse Crossing Guard and her stop sign' on the bridle path between the paddock and the association gate on October 23, 2017, at Santa Anita Park. Mr. Beltran disagreed with the alleged violation. A still picture shows the 'crossing guard' clearly holding a stop sign up while Mr. Beltran is driving across the horse path. Mr. Beltran said he did not run through the stop sign. A high quality surveillance picture is time stamped at 9:51:16 which is during training hours. The review of this picture basically was essentially indisputable proof and the following ruling was immediately issued.

**LATS RULING #036**

Exercise Rider HUMBERTO BELTRAN is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – crossed horse path in vehicle against security's direction.).

10/27/17<sup>8</sup>**AMENDED RULING**

The following ruling corrects the date of the violation.

10/28/17<sup>2</sup>**JUAN OCHOA RULING**

Jockey Juan Ochoa was aboard #2 Trapper Peak, who finished second in a photo finish, in the 5<sup>th</sup> race on Thursday, October 26 at Santa Anita. After viewing the race the Stewards unanimously felt that Jockey Ochoa violated CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop). The Stewards spoke with Jockey Ochoa in the jockey's room and he waived his right to a hearing. The following ruling was issued.

**LATS RULING #037**

Jockey JUAN OCHOA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 26, 2017.

10/28/17<sup>3</sup>**TYLER CONNER FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Tyler Conner appeared in our office this morning in order to review his ride in the 4<sup>th</sup> race here yesterday October 27. Jockey Conner was aboard fourth place finisher #8 MASCO YODLER for trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. Jockey Conner stood up in the saddle about 100 yards before the finish while Jockey Stewart Elliott aboard #1 CHARMING RULER continued to race ride and 'get up' to defeat #8 MASCO YODLER by ½ of a length for third position. This was a one (1) mile main track event.

Jockey Conner apologized to the Stewards telling us that 'he made a mistake'. Mr. Conner was very professional by accepting responsibility for his actions of not riding his mount out to the finish line. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATS RULING #038**

Jockey TYLER CONNER, who rode MASCO YODELER in the FOURTH race at Santa Anita Park on October 27, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 4, 5, & 10, 2017) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer and Jockey – failure to ride his mount to the finish, costing him a better finish position).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

**BARBARA BOINEAU COMPLAINT (CASE NO. LT0013)**

Trainer Walther Solis has claimed that Owner Barbara Boineau is indebted to him for training fees for three (3) horses totaling \$10,381.68 and a ranch debt of \$5,783.32. CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton prepared the complaint for this case. The alleged rule violation is CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Owner Boineau failed to appear for this informal hearing which was scheduled for October 26. The stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATS RULING #039**

Owner BARBARA BOINEAU, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$10,381.68 to Trainer Walther Solis and \$5,783.32 to Solis Ranch) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of BARBARA BOINEAU, are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), BARBARA BOINEAU is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**CARLOS QUEVEDO COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA0207)**

Groom Carlos Quevedo appeared in the Stewards' office along with his employer Trainer Phil D'Amato. Also present was Sgt. Michael Valadez (SA Stable Security), CHRB Supervising Investigator Phil Miyazaki and Safety Steward Luis Jauregui. On October 2, 2017 Carlos Quevedo was arrested by Arcadia Police for stealing a police department 'bait bike' from the Westfield Mall which is located adjacent to Santa Anita Park. The stolen bike in this matter was located by Arcadia PD thanks to a very effective GPS tracking system. The bike was located in a tack room assigned to Trainer D'Amato. Groom Quevedo appeared in Pasadena Court and pled guilty. He was sentenced to community service and issued a \$150 fine. Quevedo told the Stewards that he purchased the 'Diamondback' model bike (picture included in complaint) for \$30 from an individual outside of the mall. Trainer D'Amato testified that Groom Quevedo is a very good employee who typically has outstanding character. The following unanimous decision includes a fine and probation.

**LATS RULING #040**

Groom CARLOS QUEVEDO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – receiving stolen property). MR. QUEVEDO is further placed on probation for term of his license.

**SUNDAY**10/29/17<sup>1</sup>**JAMIE THERIOT RULING (REF: 10/26/17<sup>2</sup>)**

The following ruling was issued following deliberation of evidence that was provided at a formal hearing (Case # 17LT0011) in our office on Thursday, October 26. The following ruling was issued in a unanimous vote.

**LATS RULING #041**

Jockey JAMIE THERIOT is suspended FIFTEEN (15) calendar days (October 30, 2017 to November 13, 2017, inclusively) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1684 (Items Included in Weight – switched saddles after weighing out) and #1701 (Weighing In – more than two pounds overweight) before and after the second race at Del Mar Race Track on August 20, 2017.

10/29/17<sup>2</sup>**MAURO FLORES RULING (CASE NO. 17SA0219)**

Exercise Rider Mauro Flores was suspended June 5, 2016 for failing to appear at a hearing to answer charges of violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). He was ordered to appear for allegedly being intoxicated during training hours. Mr. Flores was reinstated when he appeared in our office and given terms to adhere to by the Winners' Foundation. Darin Scharer (Winners' Foundation) told the Stewards that Mr. Flores has failed to attend the required counseling sessions and other meetings. Mr. Flores was ordered to appear October 27 in our office to answer to alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers) and failed to do so. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATS RULING #042**

Exercise Rider MAURO FLORES having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers - failed to attend Winners' Foundation meetings), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges MAURO FLORES suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), MAURO FLORES is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

10/29/17<sup>3</sup>**SHOE MATTERS**

Trainer Mark Glatt and Blacksmith Robert Sise appeared in our office to discuss the shoes worn by the horse SHARP SAMURAI who won the \$200,000 Twilight Derby (Grade 2) yesterday, October 28 at Santa Anita. Horseshoe Inspector Victor Tovar determined this horse was improperly shod as determined by Santa Anita policy that is listed in their condition book. Victor Tovar changed the hind shoes on this horse prior to its 9<sup>th</sup> race stakes victory. Trainer Glatt brought the original shoes to the Stewards' office today declaring that SHARP SAMURAI has worn the same shoes in previous races without question. CHRB Rule #1555 (Duties of Horseshoe Inspector) and Rule #1853 (Examination Required) will be reviewed following a discussion with Horseshoe Inspector Tovar. More to follow.

10/29/17<sup>4</sup>**POST TIME CHANGE**

Post time for today's eleven (11) race card was changed to 12:15 p.m. today from its 12:30 p.m. weekend start.

10/29/17<sup>5</sup>**THIRD RACE STEWARDS INQUIRY/JOCKEY OBJECTION**

There was a Jockey's objection and a Stewards' Inquiry following the running of this race which was contested at Abt. 6 ½ furlongs on the infield turf course. This inquiry involved third place finisher #6 PROUD 'N' READY (Flavien Prat) and sixth place finisher #7 COALINGA HILLS (Santiago Gonzalez). The incident in question took place in mid-stretch. Jockey Santiago Gonzalez aboard #7 COALINGA HILLS lodged a 'claim of foul' against #6 PROUD 'N' READY for alleged stretch interference.

Race replays show #7 Coalinga Hills begin to lug in before steadying off the heels of #6 PROUD 'N' READY who drifted out after his aforementioned rival began to lug in. The Stewards spoke to both jockeys involved and received a patrol judge report. The majority felt both horses contributed to the incident and voted for 'no change'.
