Luis Jauregui replaced Scott Chaney for morning matters as Mr. Chaney had to attend to a personal matter. Judge Chaney was back in attendance by 11:00 AM.

**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice FRANKLIN CEBALLOS met with the BOS to review the eighth race on Sunday. After watching the Blu-Ray it was apparent he stood up inside the eighth pole and was passed by a closing horse which cost him fifth place position. He stated he thought he had fifth place wrapped up. He was told he needs to pursue a wagering placing through the wire. He stated he understood and the following ruling was issued.

**LATS RULING #063**

Apprentice Jockey FRANKLIN CEBALLOS, who rode STOLE MY 'ART in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on February 11, 2018 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (February 23, 24, & 25, 2018) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer and Jockey – failure to ride his mount to the finish, costing him a better finish position).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Apprentice ASA ESPINOZA failed to meet with the Stewards as directed to review two races and the following ruling was issued.

**LATS RULING #064**

Apprentice Jockey ASA ESPINOZA is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review) on February 15, 2018.

FLAVIEN PRAT also met with the Stewards to review the fourth race on Sunday in which he drifted out in the stretch inside the 16th marker. The BOS did not feel this was penalty worthy but he was strongly warned that more is expected from him. He stated he understood.

**SEPULVEDA HEARING CASE 18SA0017**

A complaint was filed by the CHRB against groom MICHAEL SEPULVEDA for alleged violation of CHRB rules 1489 (a) (7) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), 1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and 1900 (Grounds for Suspension and Revocation). Mr. Sepulveda was accused of and admitted that he threatened to shoot a male co-worker while under the employment of trainer Keith Desormeaux.

Present for the hearing before the BOS were Supervising Investigator Phillip Miyazaki, Santa Anita Security Guard, Byron Carter and Sargent Mike Valadez, witnesses for the CHRB, groom Freddie Diego and groom Juan Castellanos. Executive Director of Winners' Foundation Darin Scharer also attended the hearing. Mr. Sepulveda was given a "Denial of Access" by Santa Anita Security and was removed from the grounds before this hearing. After all testimony was heard, Mr. Sepulveda was directed to be evaluated by Mr. Scharer. Decision to follow.

**STANISIC CASE 18SA0033**

A financial complaint (CHRB rule 1876) was filed by practicing veterinarian Melinda Blue against owner VICK STANISIC in the amount of \$257.00. Because neither party involved appeared for the hearing. The complaint was dismissed.

**INQUIRY SECOND RACE NON STARTER 5 1/2 dirt**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the race. Involved was #1 HER ROYALNESS (R. Maragh 6th) who in a unanimous decision did not receive a fair start (CHRB rule 1696) and was declared a non-starter. In the opinion of the BOS the horse reared at the start because the assistant starter failed to release the horse when the doors opened.

**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

CECILY EVANS reviewed the eighth race with the BOS in which her reaction time to correct a dramatic drift was slow at best. Warning.

TIAGO PEREIRA, in the eighth race stretch run, entered into a narrow opening causing a slight shuffle. He was warned he needs to do a better job guiding his horse when trying to thread the needle.

Apprentice ASA ESPINOZA along with his agent Brian Beach met with the Stewards, a day late, to review the fifth and sixth race last Sunday. In the fifth race Mr. Espinoza came very close to violating the crop rule leaving the starting gate. Warning. In the sixth race he stood up early while easily in front of the horse behind him, the Stewards wanted him to be aware standing up early would not be a good habit for his riding career. Warning.

**CORALLES RULING ref 02-08-2018<sup>1</sup>**

MR. CORRALES met with the Stewards to receive notice of the penalty decision issued in the ruling listed below.

**LATS RULING 065**

Exercise rider/Valet MAXIMO CORRALES is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – fighting in Jockeys Room) on December 29, 2017 at Santa Anita Park. Furthermore Maximo Corrales is to adhere to the recommendation of the Winners' Foundation regarding anger management education. Failure to do so will result in a suspension of his license.

**PEDROZA RULING ref 02-08-2018<sup>1</sup>**

The following ruling was issued after a decision was made following three days of testimony. MR. PEDROZA and his agent Richie Silverstein came to the BOS office to be informed of the sanction.

**LATS RULING 066**

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA is suspended FIFTEEN (15) DAYS (February 20 to March 6, 2018) and fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Fighting - struck licensee on head with helmet) on December 29, 2017 at Santa Anita Park. Furthermore MARTIN PEDROZA is to adhere to the recommendation of the Winners' Foundation regarding anger management education. Failure to do so will result in a suspension of his license.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of MARTIN PEDROZA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), MARTIN PEDROZA is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**GARCIA COMPLAINTS/FORMAL HEARING CASE 17SA0216, 17SA0217, 17SA0218**

The CHRB filed three complaints related to the same incident; against pony rider PEDRO GARCIA, groom JORGE GARCIA and trainer ANTONIO GARCIA. The complaints alleged that in a tack room assigned to the three licensees, Safety Steward Luis Jauregui during his participation in a barn search, found syringes and injectable medications. These complaints were originally scheduled to be heard on January 13, 2018. At the beginning of that formal hearing, the three licensees requested a continuance to have time to obtain an attorney (ref 1-13-18<sup>5</sup>).

The complaints involved alleged violation of CHRB rule 1890 (a)(b)(Possession of Contraband).

Present for the formal hearing before the BOS were the three Respondents, without counsel, representing the CHRB Supervising Investigator Phillip Miyazaki and court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui was a witness for the CHRB.

During a barn search in Barn 77, tack room "D", assigned to trainer Antonio Garcia a bottle of Adequan and a carton of Tribedoce RX containing syringes were found. Neither item had a prescription label attached. Both groom Jorge Garcia and pony rider Pedro Garcia testified they reside in this tack room. Pony rider Pedro Garcia testified that both contraband items found in the living quarters belong to him. Jorge Garcia and Antonio Garcia testified they were not aware these items were in the room. Decision to follow.

**ARSLANIAN CASE 18SA0023**

A financial complaint (CHRB rule 1876) was filed by practicing veterinarian Melinda Blue against owner HARRY HAROUT ARSLANIAN in the amount of \$2,196.43. Mr. Arslanian and Dr. Blue both appeared and came to an agreement before the hearing. The complaint was withdrawn.

**INQUIRY ACCIDENT NO CHANGE FOURTH RACE 6 1/2 dirt**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an accident near the 3/8 pole. While racing in the clear #1 DEL MAR DARLING was injured and fell, no other horses were involved and the original order of finish was made official. Jockey Tyler Conner was attended to immediately by the Paramedics and was transported to First Aid for further evaluation.

**LATS RULING #067**

Trainer/Owner ANTONIO SOTO is suspended for failure to comply with LWTL Ruling #018 dated December 17, 2017 for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility -- \$10,000 to Finish Line Self Insurance Group).

During the term of the suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ANTONIO SOTO are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Soto is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

MIKE SMITH met with the Stewards to review his crop use in the sixth race yesterday. Mr. Smith hit his horse more than three times continuously on the shoulder in the stretch while the crop was underhanded. Even though this style of crop use is probably less onerous than overhanded, as discussed, it still violates the crop rule as stated in the ruling listed below.

**LATS RULING #068**

Jockey MIKE SMITH is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in last 60 days – first offense on December 30, 2017), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on February 16, 2018.

**RIVAS HEARING CASE 18SA0020**

The CHRHB filed a complaint against groom ABELINO RIVAS for alleged violation of CHRHB rule #1489 (a)(7) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing) #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) and #1877 (Checks).

Present for the hearing before the BOS were the Respondent and representing the CHRHB, Investigator Jim Hamilton. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui was present to translate.

A payroll check issued by trainer Simon Callaghan to his employee Lester Cortez was lost and a stop payment was issued on the check. In the interim groom Rivas employed by trainer Steve Miyadi found the check and cashed it at Santa Anita Race Track using his CHRHB license. Mr. Rivas was present, admitted he cashed the check and today he returned the money to the paymaster. Decision to follow.

**HERNANDEZ HEARING CASE 18SA0016**

**VASQUEZ HEARING CASE 18SA0015**

These two complaints filed by the CHRHB against grooms VERONICA VASQUEZ and YESSICA HERNANDEZ for alleged violation of CHRHB rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and #1900 (Grounds for Suspension and Revocation).

Ms. Vasquez is accused of lying to Stable Gate Attendant Yolidaved Garcia in an attempt to gain entry to the stable area for her unlicensed daughter at the "A" gate. Ms. Hernandez is accused of entering through gate #7 without being in possession of a valid CHRHB license after being denied entry through the "A" gate.

Present for the informal hearing, both respondents, Santa Anita Security Sargent Mike Valadez, witness Yolidaved Garcia and representing the CHRHB Supervising Investigator Phillip Miyazaki.

After testimony was given and omission of guilt by the Respondents, they were informed of their penalty. The two rulings will be issued tomorrow.

Groom VERONICA VASQUEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – impeding stable gate personnel from performing their duties) on January 12, 2018 at Santa Anita Park.

**RULING #071**

Stable employee YESSICA HERNANDEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – impeding stable gate personnel from performing their duties) on January 12, 2018 at Santa Anita Park. Ms. Hernandez is further ordered to enter into a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.

**INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION RACE NINE 1 mile-turf**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident entering the first turn. Involved were #4 SEKHMET'S SONG (S. Elliot 5th) and #7 CURLIN'S JOURNEY (M.Gutierrez 2nd). When the #7 horse came in two paths to fold into the turn, initiating contact with #4 who then stepped in and clipped the heels of #3 MISCHIEVOUS SONG (R. Bejarano DNF). After conversation with the Patrol Judge and both jockeys involved in a unanimous decision #7 was disqualified from second position and placed 5th behind #4 who lost its opportunity of a better placing.

**RULING #073**

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – third offense in last 60 days), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on February 18, 2018; first offense on January 13, 2018; second offense on January 27, 2018.

**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

RAFAEL BEJARANO met with the Stewards as directed to review his ride and effort to guide his mount (#7) into the first turn in a mile race on the turf. Mr. Bejarano was cautioned to make sure he is clear of horses to his inside before crossing over. Warning.

MARIO GUTIERREZ also met with the Stewards to review the disqualification of his mount in the ninth race yesterday. The majority felt several factors played into the incident therefore Mr. Gutierrez was not held culpable; Steward Baker voted for a three day suspension.

Apprentice CESAR FRANCO appeared to review the first race on Saturday. After crossing the transition in the 6 ½ turf event, while trying to switch sticks his mount drifted in, he was slow to correct creating contact with a horse to his inside. Warning.

**INQUIRY NO CHANGE NINTH RACE 6 1/2 turf**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident near the wire. Involved were #2 RADIO SILENCE (F. Prat 5th), #6 MESUT (E. Roman 6th) and #9 SKELTON PASS (R. Bejarano 3rd). Approaching the finish line, #2 was on the inside, #9 outside, drifted in three paths, caused #6 who had advanced between those two and made contact with #2. After talking to the Patrol Judge and the jockeys involved in a unanimous decision the incident did not effect the original order of finish due to the fact the contact happened a few strides from the finish line and the original order of finish was made official.
