ENTRY DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday, March 3, 2018. Steward Scott Chaney was on duty. The draw for this day was completed at 2:30 p.m. Ten (10) races were drawn. Seventy- six (76) horses are slated to start.

GEORGE PAPAPRODROMOU HEARING (CASE:18SA0048)

The complaint in this matter, prepared by CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton, reads as follows:

Trainer George Papaprodromou is indebted to Exercise Rider Nicholas Parks for exercising thoroughbred race horses for Trainer George Papaprodromou. Total \$2,400.

Exercise Rider Nicholas Parks, Trainer GEORGE PAPAPRODROMOU and his bookkeeper Lydia Rivas were present for today's informal hearing. Trainer Papaprodromou told the stewards that he would pay the amount in full tomorrow. More to follow.

HECTOR PALMA COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0027)

A formal hearing was held today for Trainer HECTOR PALMA alleging violations of CHRB Rule #1844 (C), Rule #1866, Rule #1843 (A) (D), Rule # 1887 and Rule #1843.1 (B). Along with the Stewards present today were Trainer Hector Palma, CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton and Court Reporter Michelle Derieg. The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

On January 16, 2018 the horse 'Irray' trained by Hector Palma conducted an official work for removal from the Veterinarian's List. The official blood sample #NC 33435 was analyzed by U.C. Davis Laboratory and was found to contain the Class 4 drug 'Phenylbutazone' (0.77 ug/ml) 'Flunixin' (7.4 ng/ml).

Palma said his assistant trainer (Chino Valdez) administered the Flunixin paste. He said Dr. Vincent Baker administered the Phenylbutazone. Trainer Palma told the Stewards that the official workout of this horse was very early in the morning on January 16, 2018. He felt that the Flunixin treatment was probably administered to close to workout time. Decision to follow.

FUTURE APPRENTICE RIDER

Twenty- seven (27) year old Exercise Rider David Mussad paid a visit to the Stewards' office this morning. Mr. Mussad spent one (1) year at the Chris McCarron jockey school in Kentucky recently. The Stewards went over rider protocol with him. He will return to our office in order to get his 'Apprentice Certificate' after his name appears 'on the overnight' and he is set to ride his first race.

ANTONIO SOTO RULING (REF: LOS AL TB 12/16/17(2))

Turf Paradise Stewards informed us that a check in the amount of \$10,000 was dropped off in their office last weekend on behalf of Trainer ANTONIO SOTO. This check will be sent to Finish Line Self Insurance Group. The ruling below reinstates the license privileges of Mr. Soto.

LATS RULING #081

Trainer/Owner ANTONIO SOTO, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$10,000.00 to Finish Line Self Insurance Group) is restored to good standing. Ruling LATS #067 issued at Santa Anita Park Winter/Spring Meet on February 17, 2018, is set aside.

COREY BLACK RULING (REF: 2/25/18(2))

The Stewards left a voice message on the cell phone of Exercise Rider COREY BLACK informing him of the penalty in the ruling below. Mr. Black was several days late reporting to the Stewards' office to address a 'Violation Notice' that was issued to him by Santa Anita Stable Security on February 13, 2018. We have been unable to contact Mr. Black to deliver our decision.

LATS RULING #082

Exercise Rider COREY BLACK is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1481 (Occupational Licenses and Fees – expired license), rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – overnight parking in stable area) and rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to appear). Furthermore Corey Black shall sign a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.

EVIN ROMAN FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Jockey EVIN ROMAN appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review yesterday's (March 1) sixth race which was contested at 6 ½ furlongs on the main track. Valet/Interpreter Ozzie Ayala also attended. Film review of this race shows last place finisher #3 PARASAIL (Tyler Conner) steady while tiring in tight quarters at the 1/8th pole. First place finisher #5 PICA (Rafael Bejarano) bumped and steadied from between horses. The reason for this was that third place finisher #6 WEDDING BLUSH (Evin Roman) drifted in for a few strides at the 1/8 mile marker. Apprentice Roman was slapping his horse on its shoulder several times before and during this horses' drift which led to his horse to 'lose his compass' and cause the eventual interference. Following deliberation the majority voted for a warning and Steward Baker voted for a riding suspension feeling this was a careless ride.

HECTOR PALMA RULING (REF: 3/01/18²)

LATS RULING #083

Trainer HECTOR PALMA, who worked the horse IPRAY on January 16, 2018 at Santa Anita Park is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and #1866 (Veterinarian's List) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and #1844(c) (Authorized Medication – phenylbutazone (0.77 ug/ml) and flunixin (7.4 ng/ml).

ABELINO RIVAS RULING (REF: 2/17/18³)

Groom ABELINO RIVAS (Employed by Steve Miyadi) found a payroll check in the amount of \$785.61. It was not his. It was made out to Groom Lester Cortex (Employed by Simon Callaghan). Mr. Rivas cashed the check in the grandstand at Santa Anita Race Track. This offense happened on or about January 9, 2018. Santa Anita Paymaster Bridget Crawford reported that this check was cashed prior to Santa Anita issuing a 'stop payment' on the check. In addition to restitution the majority voted to issue the following ruling. Steward Baker voted for a seven (7) day suspension.

LATS RULING #084

Groom ABELINO RIVAS is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rules #1489 (a)(7) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – act of moral turpitude – cashing someone else's check) and California Horse Racing Board rule #1900 (Grounds for Suspension of Revocation). Mr. Rivas was also required to provide restitution.

FLAVIEN PRAT FILM REVIEW

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT was excused from a film review yesterday. The Stewards wanted to review Jockey Prat's use of the riding crop on #6 IKE WALKER, who finished second in eighth race on Sunday February 25. Jockey Prat informed the Stewards yesterday afternoon that he would like to waive his right to a hearing and accept the penalty issued in the ruling below.

LATS RULING #085

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in last 60 days), during the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on February 25, 2018; first offense January 27, 2018.

FRANKLIN CEBALLOS FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Jockey FRANKLIN CEBALLOS appeared in the Stewards' office today accompanied by Jockey Ruben Fuentes. The Stewards wanted to review Apprentice Ceballos' ride aboard #3 MOONLIGHT BLUE who finished second in yesterday's (March 1) seventh race. In the final furlong of this 1 1/16 mile main track event, Mr. Ceballos used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times without giving his horse a chance to respond. In a unanimous decision the following ruling as issued.

LATS RULING #086

Apprentice Jockey FRANKLIN CEBALLOS is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond), during the seventh race at Santa Anita Park on March 1, 2018.

CM RACING COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0036)

KC Horse Transport alleged that CM RACING is indebted to them in the amount of \$4,562.23. CM Racing agrees with that assessment. This office has been informed that this bill has now been paid in full and this complaint, which was scheduled to be heard today, has been withdrawn.

SECOND RACE INQUIRY/ OBJECTION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to look at an incident in mid-stretch on this race track that was officially labeled 'wet fast'. Jockey Kent Desormeaux, who rode fourth place finisher #1TEQUILA SUNRISE, also lodged a 'general objection' for activity around the far turn (3/8ths marker).

On the far turn #1 TEQUILA SUNRISE steadies while on the inside of a four (4) horse spread. After hearing from 3/8ths Patrol Judge Randy Valdez , reviewing replay angles and speaking with the riders involved, the Stewards did not change the outcome of the original placings for events in which the Stewards could not place blame.

The Inquiry sign was posted for the second incident in which second place finisher #5 TELL YOUR MAMA (Rajiv Maragh) lugs inward in mid-stretch and goes into the path of third place finisher #3 MALIBU MODEL (Tiago Pereira) forcing that rival to steady his horse. #3 TEA FOR TAM was beaten 3 lengths for a better placing and the Stewards, in a unanimous decision felt that this incident did not warrant a change in the original placings. This race was quite eventful and the Stewards felt these five (5) jockeys underestimated the atypical track conditions (wet/fast) here at Santa Anita today. Jockey Rajiv Maragh is scheduled to appear in the Stewards' office for film review tomorrow.

KENT DESORMEAUX FILM REVIEW

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in yesterday's first race. Jockey Desormeaux was aboard #1 SIEGE OF VICKSBURG who finished fourth in this five (5) horse field. Jockey Desormeaux was 'standing up in the saddle' in a very tight photo for fourth place with #9 SON OF THE SOUTH (Alonso Quinonez). During film review Desormeaux told the Stewards that he didn't realize that #9 SON OF THE SOUTH was closing on the outside when Jockey Desormeaux failed to ride his mount to the finish. He was shown a 'hard copy' of the photo and was very fortunate that he was not beaten for fourth place. Warning issued.

EDGAR PAYERAS FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Jockey EDGAR PAYERAS appeared in our office to review his use of the riding crop in yesterday's sixth race. Apprentice Payeras finished second in yesterday's sixth race. The Stewards were of the unanimous opinion, and Mr. Payeras agreed, that he violated CHRB Rule 1688 (Use of Riding Crop) in the stretch drive of this race. The following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #087

Apprentice Jockey EDGAR PAYERAS is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on March 2, 2018.

DRAYDEN VAN DYKE FILM REVIEW

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #7 TEN BLESSINGS who finished second in yesterday's (March 2) seventh race. It appeared that Van Dyke violated the 'cropping rule' by striking his horse with his riding crop five (5) consecutive times. He argued he gave his mount 2 or 3 strides before using the crop again. After a long film review Jockey Van Dyke was given the benefit of the doubt and in a unanimous vote excused with a warning.

RAJIV MARAGH FILM REVIEW (REF:3/2/18 (7))

Jockey RAJIV MARAGH appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #5 TELL YOUR MAMA who finished second in yesterday's (March 2) second race which was contested at one (1) mile on the main track. There was a Stewards' inquiry into this race. Nearing the 1/16th pole Jockey Maragh races off his straight course and veers in forcing eventual third

place finisher #2 MALIBU MODEL (Tiago Pereira) to steady sharply from between horses. In a second incident nearing the wire #7 GONNA FLY NOW bumps eventual winner #4 TEA FOR TAM (Brice Blanc). Jockey Maragh was in our office on January 27 (REF:1/27/18(2)) to review two (2) races with the Stewards in which he received separate warnings. Jockey Maragh received two (2) additional warnings (REF:2/11/18(1)) for rides in two (2) separate races on February 10. For these two incidents in the stretch on March 2, the Stewards, in the unanimous decision, issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #088

Jockey RAJIV MARAGH, who rode TELL YOUR MAMA in the second race at Santa Anita Park on March 2, 2018 is suspended for TWO (2) racing days (March 10 and 11, 2018) for crossing over without sufficient clearance, for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course and causing interference in the stretch. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

GABRIEL CARRANZA COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17DM0061)

The complaint in this case (17DM0061) and the next case (17DM0060) reads as follows:

On August 19, 2017 2049 hrs. Exercise Rider Jeff Catalan was involved in an altercation with Groom Gabriel Carranza. Apparently Groom Carranza swept some dirt onto Jeff Catalan's car because it was illegally parked. Jeff Catalan reported this incident to Del Mar Security. Gabriel Carranza was upset with Jeff Catalan for reporting the incident to Del Mar Security. A physical altercation resulted between the individuals.

CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton presented two separate twelve (12) page complaint packets in both of these cases. Groom Gabriel Carranza told the stewards he works for Trainer Neil Drysdale. Exercise Rider Jeff Catalan said he was working for Trainer Martin Jones last summer at Del Mar. The Stewards felt these two (2) men were equally responsible for an incident that we felt doesn't behoove licensees who work in this industry. Rulings #089 and #090 reflect the separate penalties issued.

LATS RULING #089

Groom GABRIEL CARRANZA is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – altercation).

JEFF CATALAN COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17DM0060)

LATS RULING #90

Exercise Rider JEFF CATALAN is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – altercation).

SECOND RACE OBJECTION

Following the running of this race, which was contested at one (1) mile on the main track, there was a jockey's objection. Jockey Corey Nakatani who rode second place finisher #1 SOLTERO, lodged a 'claim of foul' against first place finisher #3 HEARTFULOFSTARS (Santiago Gonzalez) for alleged stretch interference. Race replays showed #3 HEARTFULOFSTARS drift in and make light contact with #1 SOLTERO at least twice in the final furlong of this race. After a patrol judge report and speaking with both riders involved the Stewards determined this incident did not warrant a disqualification. The decision was unanimous. No change. Santiago Gonzalez will appear in our office for film review tomorrow to review this incident and another incident he was involved with inside the 3/16ths marker.

EIGHTH RACE STEWARDS REVIEW

The Stewards announced that a 'Stewards Review' would be conducted into the start of this race which was contested at 6 ½ furlongs on the main track. Three (3) of the five (5) starters in this race were involved with significant contact at the break. Fourth place finisher #6 BEAU SQUARE (Mario Gutierrez), who was beaten 3 ¾ lengths for third place, was arguably affected the most during this underwhelming dispatch. After a review the Stewards felt there was nothing to warrant a Stewards' inquiry.

SANTIAGO GONZALEZ FILM REVIEW (REF: 3/3/18⁷)

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ appeared in our office this morning to watch his involvement in two (2) separate incidents in yesterday's (March 3) second race. The first incident was approaching the 1/8th mile marker. In this incident #3 HEARTFULLOFSTAR (Santiago Gonzalez) who finished first, drifts in under his use of a right handed crop. This action caused fifth (last) place finisher #2 MORE HONOR (Joseph Talamo) to steady slightly in the opinion of the majority and check abruptly in the opinion of the minority. In a second incident #3 HEARTFULLOFSTARS drifts in and brushes second place finisher #1 SOLTERO (Corey Nakatani). Jockey Nakatani lodged an objection after this incident. Stewards Jauregui and Sawyer voted for a warning. Steward Baker voted for a riding suspension.

CESAR FRANCO FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Jockey Cesar Franco appeared in the Stewards' office to review his use of the riding crop in the fourth race yesterday March 3. Apprentice Franco, who was recently riding at the Los Alamitos night meet, has now hung his tack in the Santa Anita jockey's room. Film review shows Apprentice Franco aboard 5th place finisher #7 MR PARKER violate CHRB rule #1688. The following ruling was issued:

LATS RULING #091

Apprentice Jockey CESAR FRANCO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on March 3, 2018.

MATTHEW CHEW COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17LT0040)

The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

On November 19, 2017 the horse 'Streak of Luck' trained by Matthew Chew finished first in the 4th race at Del Mar race track. Post race sample #DM13825 was analyzed by U.C. Davis Laboratory and was found to contain the Class 4 drug Penalty C Phenylbutazone (0.63 ug/ml) and Flunixin (8.9 ng/ml). No split requested.

Trainer MATT CHEW and CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton were present today. Investigator Hamilton presented a twenty- three (23) page complaint packet at the hearing. Trainer Chew wasn't sure of the reason for the double NASID reading but felt a mix-up at his barn at the Del Mar fall meet may have been the cause. Steward Kim Sawyer chaired today's hearing. After deliberation the following ruling was issued in a unanimous decision.

Trainer MATTHEW CHEW who started the horse STREAK OF LUCK, first place finisher in the fourth race at Del Mar Race Track on November 19, 2017 is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and #1844 (c) (Authorized Medication – phenylbutazone [0.63 ug/ml] and flunixin [8.9 ng/ml] – second offense in 365 days).
