MILLER HEARING

We held a formal hearing into case number 17LT0015 which was a complaint filed by the CHRB against trainer PETER MILLER alleging violation of rule 1874 (Disorderly Conduct). The complaint alleged that Mr. Miller verbally assaulted assistant trainer Stephanie Korker-Murray at San Luis Downs in September. This case was continued twice – once at the request of the CHRB and then a second time at the request of Mr. Miller’s lawyer. Despite being properly noticed of the new hearing date, neither Mr. Miller nor his counsel appeared. We nevertheless conducted the hearing. Investigator Jim Hamilton represented the CHRB and Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings. Witnesses Ms. Korker-Murray and clocker Amanda Guthrie appeared in person while trainer Adam Kitchingman and exercise rider Paul Roberts appeared by telephone. All four witnesses were subpoenaed. Evidence showed, that Mr. Miller who believed that his former assistant was “stealing” stable employees from him for her new stable, verbally assaulted her near the clocker’s stand. The incident was quite loud and the epithets were of a disgusting nature including comments and her personal appearance and derogatory statements about her unborn child (Ms. Korker-Murray was seven months pregnant at the time). Evidence revealed that Mr. Miller has had six disorderly conduct related rulings since 2008. Documentary evidence was admitted to the record and the matter was closed. Decision to follow.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ came to the office to review his ride in the third race on Sunday. Video revealed that after the leaving the starting gate, Mr. Gutierrez angles his horse rather sharply from the outside post, and in so doing crosses in front of a rival while not clear, causing that rival to steady sharply. Mr. Gutierrez claimed that this type of behavior happens all the time but didn't really offer an explanation for his own actions. We unanimously issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #104

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ, who rode CROISSANT in the third race at Santa Anita Park on March 11, 2018 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (March 22, 23 and 24, 2018) for crossing over without sufficient clearance and causing interference entering the first turn. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Jockey GEOVANNI FRANCO came to the office to review his crop use in the second race on Sunday. Video revealed that he used his riding crop more than three times in succession without giving his horse the chance to respond. He agreed and accepted the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #105

Jockey GEOVANNI FRANCO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the second race at Santa Anita Park on March 11, 2018.

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA came to the office to review his crop use in the eighth race Sunday. Video revealed that he used his crop multiple times and that he was close in terms of giving the horse the chance to respond. He was warned to give his mount a little more time after using his crop three times in succession. He agreed.

3/15/18²

STARTER HEARING

We held a meeting with Starter JAY SLENDER and his assistant starter that were involved with the non-starter declaration on Sunday. They both explained that the horse was somewhat notorious for sitting back when the gate opened making it appear as if the assistant starter had held the horse too long. We explained that it was necessary to make the horse a nonstarter because of public perception and perhaps a horse that has this history should be placed on the Starter's List and required to behave properly in the gate.

MARCHIONNO HEARING

We held an informal hearing into case number 18SA0051 which was a complaint filed by Irish Rose Farms (Norman Day) against owner VINCENT MARCHIONNO alleging an unpaid board bill. Upon reading the complaint, the alleged amount was for \$588.00 which did not meet the regulatory threshold of \$1,000.00 in CHRB Rule 1876 for filing this type of complaint. Dismissed.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey RAJIV MARAGH came to the office to discuss his crop use during the stretch run of the third race yesterday. He explained that as he neared the wire, in an effort to win the race, he accidentally went over the three allowable strikes before giving his horse the chance to respond. We issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #107

Jockey RAJIV MARAGH is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in last 60 days; first offense on February 19, 2018), during the third race at Santa Anita Park on March 15, 2018.

Jockey DRAYDEN VANDYKE called in advance of his hearing this morning and accepted responsibility for a crop rule violation during yesterday’s seventh race. He explained that he was simply trying to win the race. We issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #106

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – third offense in last 60

days), during the seventh race at Santa Anita Park on March 15, 2018; first offense on January 27, 2018; second offense on February 18, 2018.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey TIAGO PEREIRA called in advance of his hearing this morning and admitted to a crop rule violation in the fourth race yesterday. We issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #108

Jockey TIAGO PEREIRA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on March 16, 2018.

Jockey MATT GARCIA was present in our office this morning to discuss his ride and crop use in the stretch of the fourth race yesterday. His crop use was close to the standard of not giving his horse the chance to respond so he was warned. The larger issue was his outward

drift as the field neared the wire. Mr. Garcia's mount won the race but in so doing interfered with the horse to his outside. It was close enough to the finish that it didn't affect the outcome of the race, but Mr. Garcia struck his horse two times as he drifted out. We therefore issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #110

Jockey MATT GARCIA, who rode MUCHOS BESOS in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on March 16, 2018 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (March 24, 25 and 29, 2018) for failure to maintain a straight course and causing interference in the stretch. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT did not come to the office as directed to review the video of his crop use in the stretch of the fourth race yesterday.

MCCLUSKEY-HICKMAN RULING

We issued the ruling that follows when owner CORTNEY MCCLUSKEY-HICKMAN failed to appear for case number 18SA0052 which was a complaint filed by veterinarian group San Dieguito Equine Group alleging an unpaid bill.

LATS Ruling #109

Owner CORTNEY MCCLUSKEY-HICKMAN, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$235.83 to San Dieguito Equine) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of CORTNEY MCCLUSKEY-HICKMAN are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), CORTNEY MCCLUSKEY-HICKMAN is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

RIVERA WITHDRAWAL

San Dieguito Equine Group withdrew its complaint (case number 18SA0053) against owner GERARDO RIVERA when the alleged debt was paid in full.

GARCIA HEARING

We held a formal hearing into case number 18SA0029 which was a complaint filed by the CHRB against trainer ANTONIO GARCIA alleging a post-race drug positive uncovered in one of his runners. On January 11, 2018, "Tuscany Beauty" tested positive for triamcinolone acetonide (214 pg/ml). Present at the hearing were this Board, CHRB Investigator Miyazaki, Mr. Garcia, and court reporter Michelle Derieg. Mr. Garcia explained that his veterinarian had injected the hocks and knee of the horse on January 5 which he believed explains the positive. We listened to the testimony and admitted documentary evidence. The hearing was brought to a close and a decision will be forthcoming.

GARCIA HEARING

We held an informal hearing into case number 18SA0059 which was a complaint filed by the CHRB against trainer ANTONIO GARCIA alleging that he bounced several payroll checks cashed by Santa Anita in the amount of \$7,260.00. He explained that his accountant had absconded with money from his business account and that is why the checks were returned by his bank. Since the incident he has reimbursed the paymaster \$4,226.00 and signed an agreement to pay off the rest. Complaint withdrawn.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ came to the office this morning to review his ride in the first race yesterday. Video revealed that his mount drifted out as the horses completed the turn into the stretch, making contact with the eventual winner to his outside. He explained that his horse wouldn’t switch leads and he was trying to prevent the outside drift. We disagreed with that analysis but nevertheless felt that a warning was appropriate.

Jockey FELIPE MARTINEZ came to the office to review his ride in the second race yesterday during which he allowed horse to drift out a bit in stretch. While the drift was minor, we wanted to warn him to keep a straighter course. He agreed.

Jockey agent Derek Lawson came to the office to represent FLAVIEN PRAT in the hearing he missed yesterday. The hearing was brief in that he watched one stretch run and agreed that his rider had violated the crop rule. We issued the following rulings:

LATS Ruling #112

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review) on March 17, 2018.

LATS Ruling #113

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – third offense in last 60 days), during the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on March 16, 2018; second offense on February 25, 2018.

MILLER RULING

After carefully considering the evidence presented at the Miller hearing described Monday, we issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #111 (Amended)

Owner/Trainer PETER MILLER is suspended SEVEN (7) days (April 2 to April 8, 2018), fined TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00)* and placed on probation for the term of his license (10/31/2019) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – 7th offense – aggressive/abusive behavior – derogatory words about licensee’s unborn baby) on September 11, 2017 at San Luis Rey Downs.

Terms of probation are to adhere to recommendation of the Winners’ Foundation regarding anger management education. Failure to do so will result in the suspension of all licenses of PETER MILLER. During the term of suspension all licenses and license privileges of PETER MILLER are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine) PETER MILLER is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

OBJECTION/DISQUALIFICATION

Following the running of the fourth race, jockey Ruben Fuentes (4th on #1 GRAY ADMIRAL) claimed foul against the second place #6 BLACK SITE (G. Franco) for interference going into the first turn. Films revealed that #6 did drop over into the path of #1 causing that horse to steady and lose ground. After speaking with the patrol judges and jockeys involved, the majority disqualified #6 for interference. Steward Chaney voted to make no change because he did not believe the horse was cost a better placing.

Original Order of Finish: 2-(6)-3-1-4-7-5-8

Corrected Order of Finish: 2-3-1-(6)-4-7-5-8

INQUIRY/STARTER

Following the running of the eighth race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine the actions of #3 LASEEN (IRE) (K. Desormeaux) shortly after the break of the 1 1/8 miles turf event. Video showed that the horse broke with the field but after a few strides pulled herself up and refused to participate. The jockey Kent Desormeaux conformed this analysis by radio. We therefore declared the horse a starter but placed the horse on the Starter’s list.

3/18/18⁵

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign during the running of the ninth race to examine the circumstances under which #6 BOOM BOOM BANGO (R. Bejarano) was injured near the 4 ½ mile pole on the dirt. Video revealed some contact at the start but that no other horses

were responsible for the incident and therefore the horse was declared a starter. Mr. Bejarano was transported to the hospital and a report was generated regarding the horse.
