Trainer HECTOR PALMA, who started the horse IPRAY, the second place finisher in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on February 11, 2018, is fined TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00)\* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(b)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1(b) (Prohibited Drug Substance) and #1844(f)(9)(Methocarbomal [74 ng/ml] in excess of permitted level of 1 ng/ml, third offense).

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey DRAYDEN VANDYKE called ahead of his scheduled hearing and took responsibility for his crop rule violation yesterday. We issued the following ruling:

**LATS Ruling #157**

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in last 60 days), during the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on April 26, 2018; first offense on March 15, 2018.

Jockey COREY NAKATANI came to the office to review his ride in the first race yesterday. He finished sixth beaten a head for fifth. We felt that he stopped riding before the finish. He agreed with that analysis but claimed that his horse was “wobbly legged” believing that the horse may have bled. He had no real answer for why he didn’t pull the horse up and dismount if the horse had bled or was so tired that he felt that he needed to negatively impact the wagering public and at the same time possibly exacerbate the horse’s perceived compromised condition. This is the fourth time he has been called in for such behavior this meet. He received a warning because we didn’t feel his actions cost the horse a better placing.

**MULHALL COMPLAINT WITHDRAWN**

KC Horse Transport withdrew its complaint (case number 18SA0076) against trainer KRISTIN MULHALL when the alleged vaning debt was paid in full.

**PAPAPRODROMOU HEARING**

We held an informal hearing into case number 18SA0078 which was a financial complaint filed by Angel’s Feed alleging unpaid feed bills. MR. PAPAPRODROMOU and the Unamuno brothers (Angel’s Feed) both appeared on their own behalf as well as the book keepers for the respective parties. The alleged amount is \$51,811.88. Before hearing testimony it became clear that there was a disagreement about credits for some payments. We ordered the two bookkeepers to meet and sort out all of the payments and set a new hearing date two weeks in the future. More to follow.

He allowed his mount to drift in and make contact with the horse to his inside. While he did correct the action, we warned him against making the contact in the first place.

**SALCEDO/RODRIGUEZ RULINGS**

Trainer MICHAEL MCCARTHY’s exercise riders CAESAR SALCEDO and NORMAN RODRIGUEZ came to the office pursuant to morning outrider citations for entering the track after it closed for a renovation. They admitted to the violation but also said they were following employer orders. We issued the following rulings:

We posted the inquiry sign after the running of the third race to examine an incident in the stretch involving the winner #3 FOXTAIL (T. Baze). A review of the video revealed that #3 ducked out and interfered with two horses causing both to steady and move off of their running lanes – third place finisher #4 SUNDAY PROPHET (F. Prat) and sixth place finisher #6 IT’S ALEXUS (K. Frey). After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved we unanimously voted to disqualify the winner and place her sixth since both rivals were beaten a head for their respective placings.

## JOCKEY/DRIVER ACCIDENT REPORT
