#### ENTRIES AND SCRATCHES

Steward Scott Chaney was on duty in the Stewards' office in order to oversee entries for Saturday, May 26, 2018. There will be three (3) graded stakes races on this day. The Gold Cup at Santa Anita (Purse \$500,000) and the Gamely Stakes (\$300,000) are both Grade I events. The Charles Whittingham Stakes (\$200,000) is a Grade 2 event. Nine (9) races will be carded with seventy two (72) horses slated to face Starter Jay Slender.

#### THURSDAY

#### OFFICIAL CHANGE

Starter Jay Slender is off today for personal reasons. Longtime head Assistant Starter John Lopez will dispatch the fields for today's eight (8) races.

#### ADOLFO RODRIGUEZ RULING

Exercise Rider Adolfo Rodriguez appeared in our office after receiving a 'Violation Notice' from a Santa Anita morning outrider. Lead Outrider John Cortez testified via telephone that Mr. Rodriguez was galloping his horse adjacent to the inside rail which is in violation of morning training policies here at Santa Anita. Following this informal hearing Rodriguez was informed of the following penalty which was issued in a unanimous decision.

#### **LATS RULING #184**

Exercise rider ADOLFO RODRIGUEZ is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – morning outrider citation for galloping on the inside rail).

**IAN KRULJAC DECISION (REF: 5/20/18<sup>3</sup>)**

The Stewards deliberated over testimony that was given at an informal hearing that was held for Trainer Ian Kruljac for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). The Stewards directed CHRB Veterinarian Tim Grande after the Kruljac trained 'Powder' did not finish (DNF) the ninth race (Odds 8/5) on April 21, 2018. The examination was ordered after Trainer Kruljack became upset that Jockey Kent Desormeaux pulled up this filly on the backside of this 6 furlong (Main track) allowance/optional claiming event. While Dr. Grande was interviewing Ian Kruljac at his barn (Barn #46), Kruljac became irritated and told State Veterinarian Grande to get out of his barn and to \*\*\*\* Off. Dr. Grande immediately left the barn and this ended the interview/examination that the Stewards requested. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATS RULING #183**

Owner/Trainer IAN KRULJAC, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – vulgar language impeding State Veterinarian from performing duties) at Santa Anita Park on April 21, 2018.

**ROBERT HESS JR. COMPLAINT (CASE NO: 18SA0099)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer Bob Hess Jr. for four (4) separate rule violations. The complaint in this matter reads as follows.

*On April 7, 2018 the horse 'Fire When Ready' trained by Robert Hess Jr. finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 6<sup>th</sup> race at Santa Anita Race Track. Post race test sample #SA27982 was analyzed by U.C. Davis Laboratory and was found to contain the Class 4 drug 'Methocarbamol' (8.2 ng/ml). Permitted level is (1) ng/ml.*

Trainer Bob Hess Jr. testified on the telephone and told the Stewards he forgot about the hearing until he was driving his car on the freeway. CHRB Investigator Greg Icamen presented a twenty three (23) page complaint packet at the hearing. Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribed the proceedings. Trainer Hess was candid telling the Stewards an employee of his put a different horses' feed tub (medication included) into the stall of "FIRE WHEN READY". He said corrective measures at his barn would take place. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

**LATS RULING #185**

Trainer ROBERT HESS, JR., who started the horse FIRE WHEN READY, the second place finisher in the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on April 7, 2018, is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1(b) (Prohibited Drug Substance) and #1844(f)(9) (Authorized Medication - methocarbamol [8.2 ng/ml] in excess of permitted level of 1 ng/ml – second offense in 365 days).

**FIFTH RACE ACCIDENT**

Following the running of the fifth race (6 ½ furlongs-Turf) seventh place finisher #5 IVY MIKE stumbled unseating Jockey Martin Garcia. #5 IVY MIKE was not injured. Paramedics were on the scene immediately and Garcia was driven to First Aid office located in the grandstand. He was subsequently cleared to ride his remaining mount (7<sup>th</sup> race) on the day's card.

**HEATHER WHARTON/GENARO VALLEJO COMPLAINTS (CASE NOS. 18SA0102 & 18SA0117)**

The complaint in both of these complaints reads as follows:

*The horse ‘Rprettyboyfloyd’, trained by Genaro Vallejo, was entered in the 3<sup>rd</sup> race at Santa Anita on April 21, 2018. On April 19, 2018, Dr. Heather Wharton administered a banamine injection to Rprettyboyfloyd 48 hours prior to post. On April 20, 2018, Dr. Wharton inadvertently administered another banamine injection to Rprettyboyfloyd instead of Phenylbutazone. When Dr. Wharton realized her mistake she immediately notified Grant Baker in the steward’s office and Chris Merz in the racing department (Racing Office) and informed both offices of the medication scratch.*

Present today were Trainer GENARO VALLEJO, Veterinarian HEATHER WHARTON, CHRB Investigator Greg Icamen and Court Reporter Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC). Trainer Vallejo testified at the hearing as did Veterinarian Wharton. Dr. Wharton acknowledged that she mistakenly treated the Vallejo trained Rprettyboyfloyd two (2) days in a row with the drug ‘Banamine’. An employee of Trainer Vallejo’s was with Dr. Wharton at the time of treatment as Trainer Vallejo was attending to another horse. Decision to follow.

**JAMES CHAPMAN COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0116)**

A hearing was scheduled for Trainer JAMES CHAPMAN on May 18, 2018 alleging violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Veterinarian Karen Valko has alleged that Trainer Chapman is indebted to her in the amount of \$1,718.79 for veterinarian services.

Trainer Chapman did not appear at that hearing. Today Dr. Valko brought us a 'Financial Complaint Agreement' (CHRB-51) that has been signed by both parties. Chapman has paid Dr. Valko \$650 of the bill and two (2) more payments are required to be made by July 15, 2018 in order to satisfy the terms of this agreement.

#### **HERIBERTO FIGUEROA RULING**

The Stewards called for a film review of the sixth race on Thursday, May 24 with Apprentice Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA. He was aboard first place finisher #2 MIRACLE MARCH in this one (1) mile main track event. The Stewards felt Apprentice Figueroa used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times without giving his mount a chance to respond, after being notified to see the Stewards Figueroa waived his right to a hearing, pled guilty and accepted the ruling issued below.

#### **LATS RULING #186**

Apprentice Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on May 24, 2018.

#### **PURSE INCREASE ANNOUNCEMENT**

A 'press release' put out by Santa Anita Park today announced that there will be a ten (10) percent increase in overnight purses effective Friday, June 1, through Sunday, June 24. The purse increase for the last FIFTEEN (15) days of the winter spring meet is due to a \$70 million increase in overall pari-mutuel handle dating back to December 26.

#### **SECOND RACE INQUIRY**

Following the running of this 6 ½ furlong main track event the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to review an incident at the ¼ mile marker in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. Of particular interest were the actions of third place finisher #2 NO HONEY MONEY (Asa Espinoza) and sixth (last) place finisher #1 CANDY COATED WORLD (Barrington Harvey). Race replays show Jockey Harvey check his mount sharply and then continue to do so for roughly 30 yards. Films were inconclusive as to the reason why #1 CANDY COATED WORLD steadied so sharply. It appeared that #2 NO HONEY MONEY maintained a fairly straight course. In a unanimous decision the original placings were allowed to stand. No change. Apprentice Espinosa was ordered to film review with the Stewards tomorrow.

**ASA ESPINOSA FILM REVIEW (REF: 5/25/18<sup>4</sup>)**

Apprentice Jockey ASA ESPINOSA appeared in the Stewards' office this morning in order to review his ride aboard #2 NO MORE HONEY, who finished third in the second race yesterday May 25. He was accompanied by his agent Brian Beach. There was an inquiry in this race and the Stewards determined that Apprentice Espinoza was blameless as far as initiating interference. We encouraged him to be aware of rival jockey's who are having issues with their mounts 'getting out'. We also told Espinoza to come to the telephone when he sees 'his number flashing' (involved in Inquiry and/or Objection). He told us he did not know where the phone was. His agent, Mr. Beach told all of us that after the hearing he would walk him down to the scales' and show him where it is.

**DRAYDEN VAN DYKE FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Drayden Van Dyke appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in yesterday's 5<sup>th</sup> Race (ABT 6 1/2 Furlongs Turf). Van Dyke was aboard sixth place finisher #6 DIVA LA MOUSSE. The Stewards were concerned with his compliance with CHRB Rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer and Jockey) which requires jockeys to ride their mount out until the finish line is passed.

**STEVEN SIMONOVIC COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0124)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Owner STEVEN SIMONOVIC for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). The complaint in this case read as follows.

*Trainer Art Sherman alleges owner Steven Simonovic is indebted to him in the amount of \$5,170.00. Owner Simonovic had his horse SILENT FAME with Trainer Art Sherman. Ron Bergum and Mr. Simonovic were partners on the horse HOLY PLAN. This partnership was put together by suspended licensee Danny Alameda whose name has been popping up again recently (REF:5/4/18<sup>1</sup>) in our office. Owner Simonovic called from his location in the Midwest for this hearing. Training bills in this complaint were from October 2017. Owner Simonovic testified that he hadn't paid the bills because Danny Alameda told him that the daily training rate that he was going to have to pay was \$40 less then what Trainer Sherman actually charges. At the end of the hearing Owner Simonovic agreed to send Trainer Sherman a check for a slightly lower amount then what was initially listed in the complaint. Even though we don't have jurisdiction over Danny Alameda we recommended to both parties that they no longer have business dealings with this former Bloodstock Agent/Jockey Agent/Track Announcer (Bay Meadows).*

**HEATHER WHARTON DVM & GENARO VALLEJO DECISION (REF: 5/25/18<sup>1</sup>)**

The Genaro Vallejo trained RPRETTYBOYFLOYD was scratched from the 3<sup>rd</sup> race on April 21, 2018 due to being mistreated by Heather Wharton. She treated the horse with Banamine on April 19. She meant to administer Phenylbutazone on April 20 but once again treated the horse with Banamine. She was very candid at yesterday's hearing and accepted full

responsibility for the mistreatment. The complaint against Trainer Vallejo was dismissed, in a unanimous decision Veterinarian Wharton was issued the following sanction.

**LATS RULING #187**

Veterinarian HEATHER WHARTON who treated the horse RPRETTYBOYFLOYD for the third race at Santa Anta Park on April 21, 2018 is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843.5(g) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances Permitted After Entry in a Race – incorrect medication).

**EIGHTH RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards called for a ‘Stewards Review’ into the start of the 1 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile (Turf) Gamely Stakes (Grade 1--\$300,000 Guaranteed). Odds-on favorite #7 HAWKSMOOR (IRE) (Odds 1/1) stumbled badly and lost much ground before going on to a fifth-place finish. This horse caused its own problems and there was no reason for a Stewards’ inquiry.

Jockey Ruben Fuentes appeared in the Stewards’ Office in order to review his ride in yesterday’s second race. Jockey Fuentes was aboard #1 WHERESTEMONEYJACK who finished third in this 5 ½ furlong race for older horses on the main track.

Today’s film review shows #1 WHERESTEMONEYJACK break outward two (2) paths. Jockey Fuentes appears to make an effort to straighten his mount but his left hand is so far back on his inside rein that his efforts have little effect. This was a borderline call as far as issuing a penalty. However Jockey Fuentes’ effort (albeit mediocre), recent riding record and accountability during film review led to a warning being issued. Our decision was unanimous.

Jockey Prat is currently serving three (3) suspension days (REF: Ruling LATS #177) following the disqualification of a horse he rode in the first race on May 17, 2018 (REF: 5/17/18<sup>4</sup>).

**LATS RULING #188**

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT is suspended for ONE (1) additional RACING DAY (June 2, 2018) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races – participated in more than one designated race on May 26, 2018).
