FIGUEROA RULING

Apprentice HERIBERTO FIGUEROA admitted by telephone he violated the crop rule as stated in the following ruling.

LATS RULING #189

Apprentice Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond - second offense; first offense on May 24, 2018), during the ninth race at Santa Anita Park on May 28, 2018.

HANSON FORMAL HEARING CASE 18SA0122

A complaint was filed by the CHRB against trainer RYAN HANSON for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(f)(1) (Authorized Medication), 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances). Present before the BOS, trainer Ryan Hanson, representing the CHRB, Investigator Greg Icamen and court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings.

Mr. Hanson's runner WONDERFUL LIE who finished eighth in the eighth race on April 13, 2018 at Santa Anita Park post race tested positive for the class four substance, category C penalty Betamethasone (57 pg/ml). Mr. Hanson testified that his practicing veterinarian Melinda Blue injected three joints six days prior to race day. The recommended withdrawal of this medication is seven days. He stated Dr. Blue was aware of the day of the race in which horse was to run and she was comfortable administering the medication on April 7, 2018. Decision to follow.

ACCIDENT INQUIRY NO CHANGE FIRST RACE 6 ½ dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident at the 5 1/2 marker (6 1/2 furlong-dirt) that involved #3 CANDY CREW (H. Figueroa). After a review and conversation with the Patrol Judge, it was apparent that apprentice Figueroa's foot slipped out of the left iron, he lost his balance and fell to the ground. There were no other horses involved and the race was made official. Mr. Figueroa was taken to first aid for further evaluation and was removed from the remainder of his mounts. He will have to be cleared by the track physician before riding again.

STEWARDS' REVIEW SEVENTH RACE ¾ dirt

Following the running of the race a Stewards' review was conducted to study the start of the race which involved #4 MAMA'S KID (F. Ceballos 4th) who turned its head as the starting gate opened and was tardy to break. In a unanimous opinion there was no need for an official inquiry, the horse caused its own problem.

INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION FIFTH RACE one mile turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in mid stretch that involved #1 LOOKING AT THELAKE (G. Stevens 6th) and #3 PROPER DRINK (A. Quinonez 4th). After a review of the video angles and a report from the Patrol Judge in a unanimous decision # 3 was disqualified from fourth position and placed sixth behind #1. Approaching the 1/16 pole, #1 drifted inward causing #1 to take up sharply costing it a placing. During the inquiry, the telephone to communicate with the jockeys was out of order.

ACCIDENT INQUIRY NO CHANGE SEVENTH RACE 1 1/8 turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an accident approaching the 1/16 marker. Involved in the inquiry were #3 WAYA ED (T. Pereira DNF), #5 HIT THE SEAM (G. Franco 4th) and #6 PSYCHO DAR (R. Fuentes 3rd). Approaching the 1/16 pole, in the unanimous opinion of the Stewards, while clear #5 drifted out slightly, #3 was closing to its outside, stepped out and clipped the heel of #6 to its outside, #3 also contributing to the incident. The Stewards could not blame #5 or #6 and the original order of finish was made official. With the knowledge of no phone service, communication was performed by using the winners' circle security guard's radio attached to his chest.

INQUIRY NO CHANGE TENTH RACE 6 ½ turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review contact between #1 VENDING MACHINE (D. Sanchez 1st) and #8 TINA'S EXCHANGE (E. Maldonado 2nd) in the late stretch. After conversation with both jockeys (security guard's radio, no telephone) in a unanimous decision the BOS felt the contact involved both horses and the original order of finish was made official.

HANSON RULING (Ref: 06-01-18²)

MR. HANSON was eligible for and received the minimum recommended penalty listed in the ruling below.

LATS RULING #191

Trainer RYAN HANSON, who started the horse WONDERFUL LIE, the eighth place finisher in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on April 13, 2018, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1(b) (Prohibited Drug Substance) and #1844(f)(1) (Authorized Medication - betamethasone [57 pg/ml] in excess of permitted level of 10 pg/ml).

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

VICTOR ESPINOZA appeared as directed to review a drift late in the stretch of the third race on Friday. Mr. Espinoza admitted the drift got away from him. Warning.

EDWIN MALDONADO and DIEGO SANCHEZ met with the Stewards to review the tenth race yesterday that involved an inquiry (ref 06-02-18⁴). After a discussion about both drifts by the two jockeys, each received a warning.

KYLE FREY met with the Stewards and admitted he overused the crop in the second race yesterday as stated in the following ruling.

LATS RULING #192

Jockey KYLE FREY is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the second race at Santa Anita Park on June 2, 2018.

ALONSO QUINONEZ and his agent Nelson Arroyo came to the Stewards' office to review his ride in the fifth race yesterday that involved an inquiry, jockey objection and a disqualification of his mount (ref 06-02-18²). Mr. Quinonez stated he didn't realize there was a horse to his inside when he drifted inward and cut it off. In a unanimous decision he was penalized in the following ruling.

LATS RULING #193

Jockey ALONSO QUINONEZ, who rode PROPER DRINK in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on June 2, 2018 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 10, 14 and 15, 2018) for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch resulting in a disqualification from fourth to fifth position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

MATT GARCIA came to the BOS office to watch his crop use in the 3rd race yesterday. After Mr. Garcia agreed he used the crop four consecutive times the following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #194

Jockey MATT GARCIA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond), during the third race at Santa Anita Park on June 2, 2018.

STEWARDS’ REVIEW

Following the running of the race the Stewards’ Review was announced to show the public that soon after the start the saddle slipped dramatically on the Vladimir Cerin runner #8 VAN CORTLANDT (A. Espinoza 9th), no other participants were involved and the race was made official.
