**ENTRY DAY**

**BOBBY GRAYSON SR. RULING (REF LA: 9/7/18<sup>2</sup>)**

The following ruling was signed and agreed upon by Los Alamitos (L.A. County Fair) Stewards and issued today (Opening Day) at Santa Anita. The hearing for this case was on September 7, 2018 at Los Alamitos.

**LATC RULING #001**

Trainer BOBBY WAYNE GRAYSON SR. is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1659 (Delivery of Claimed Horse – horse returned to the same stable after claim) regarding the horse “Arch Prince” after the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 26, 2018.

**VAL BRINKERHOFF RULING (REF LA: 9/7/18<sup>2</sup>)**

The ruling below was also issued by Los Alamitos (L.A. County Fair) Stewards after Trainer Brinkerhoff’s formal hearing was heard in conjunction with the hearing for Trainer Bobby Grayson Sr. at Los Alamitos on September 7, 2017. The decision for the ruling above and the ruling below were issued by Los Alamitos Stewards Chaney, Sawyer and Ward.

**LATC RULING #002**

Trainer VAL BRINKERHOFF is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1659 (Delivery of Claimed Horse – horse returned to the same stable after claim) regarding the horse “Arch Prince” after the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 26, 2018.

**JOHN JUDE RULING**

Jockey JOHN JUDE was issued the following penalty for being overzealous with his riding crop in the second race at closing day on September 23, 2018 at Los Alamitos (L.A. County Fair) meeting.

**LATC RULING #003**

Jockey JOHN JUDE is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the second race at Los Alamitos Race Course on September 23, 2018.

**OSCAR OLGUIN VIOLATION NOTICE**

Exercise Rider OSCAR OLGUIN was issued a violation notice on September 17, 2018 by Santa Anita morning outrider Francisco Cardenas. Outrider Cardenas testified by telephone that Mr. Olguin and his mount entered the training track before that track had been officially open. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui was also present. Exercise Rider Olguin said his watch

was seven (7) minutes off and he miscalculated the training tracks 4:30 a.m. opening. In a majority vote (Steward Sawyer dissent-Fine) Exercise Rider Olguin was excused with a warning.

**MEETING WITH JOCKEYS**

The Stewards met with members of the Santa Anita jockey colony prior to this afternoon's opening day card. Along with valets, jockeys and racing officials present for our 11:45 a.m. hearing were Dr. Rick Arthur (CHRB Equine Medical Director), Dr. Tim Grande (CHRB Veterinarian), Darin Scharer (Winner's Foundation) , Darrel Haire (Jockey's Guild), Dana Stead (Track Veterinarian) and Juan Espinoza (Symons Human Ambulance). The Stewards brought up at least fourteen (14) topics followed up by questions from the riding colony. A good 'back and forth' was had by all.

**FIRST RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of this one (1) mile turf race. Approaching the 1/16<sup>th</sup> pole #4 GRAY ADMIRAL (Ruben Fuentes) is in third position and shifts out into the body of second place finisher #1 IRON ALEX (Geovanni Franco). This action also shifted fourth place finisher #5 POINT GUARD (Drayden Van Dyke) off his path. All of the Stewards felt this action did not cost #1 IRON ALEX the win. In a majority vote (Steward Baker dissent-No Change) the Stewards disqualified #4 GRAY ADMIRAL and placed him fourth behind #5 POINT GUARD. Jockey Rueben Fuentes was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**EIGHTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to investigate an incident just inside the 1/8<sup>th</sup> pole in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. At this juncture first place finisher #3 CAPTIVATE (Drayden Van Dyke) angles inward under right handed cropping. Jockey Kent Desormeaux (#2 SARATOGA MORNING) was driving for an opening along the rail that had plenty of room to enter. While #3 CAPTIVATE is continuing to angle in Jockey Desormeaux checks his horse sharply nearly avoiding contact and avoid hitting the rail. The Stewards spoke to both jockeys involved, reviewed all camera angles and received a patrol judge report. In a unanimous decision #3 CAPTIVATE was disqualified and placed second. Jockey Drayden Van Dyke was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**BRAD PEGRAM RULING**

**LATC Ruling #004**

Jockey Agent BRAD PEGRAM fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases not Covered by Rules and Regulations – failure to conduct business in a proper manner).

Agent Brad Pegram gave out two (2) calls for the fourth race on Opening Day, September 28. They were the Jeff Mullins trained #6 KP PERGOLISCIOUS (IRE) and the Peter Miller trained #8 MONGOLIAN WINDOW. Agent Pegram, who represented Jockey Drayden Van Dyke in this matter ended up not participating in this race.

**ARON WELLMAN INFORMAL HEARING (CASE NO.18DM0074)**

A twenty-three (23) page complaint packet was put together by CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton alleging that Owner ARON WELLMAN violated CHRB Rule #1874 (3) (Disorderly Conduct). This hearing was originally scheduled for October 6, 2018 but was ‘moved up’ to today’s date at the request of Mr. Wellman. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui replaced Steward Grant Baker on the hearing panel today as Steward Baker testified as a witness. Investigator Hamilton was also present. The complaint in this case reads as follows:

*On September 2, 2018 after the 8th race at Del Mar the horse ‘ANIMOSITY’ was slow leaving the starting gate. The Del Mar Stewards conducted an Inquiry into the start of the race. During the Inquiry the owner of ANIMOSITY called the Stewards several times. The second time Owner Aron Wellman called the Stewards he talked to Steward Grant Baker. After the race Aron Wellman held up the Inquiry by speaking with Jockey Tyler Connor before the Stewards had a chance to speak with Jockey Tyler Connor before deciding if the horse ‘ANIMOSITY’ would be a starter. Owner Aron Wellman told Steward Grant Baker “Expect a Lawsuit F\*\*\*\*\*”. See declaration by Steward Grant Baker.*

Owner Wellman and Steward Baker testified at the hearing. Decision to follow.

**DRAYDEN VAN DYKE FILM REVIEW (REF: 9/28/18<sup>7</sup>)**

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE appeared in the Stewards’ office to review his ride aboard #3 CAPTIVATE who finished first but was disqualified and placed second for stretch interference in yesterday’s eighth race. In this 6 ½ furlong main track event #3 CAPTIVATE angles inward while Jockey Van Dyke uses his riding crop with his right hand. The Stewards were of the unanimous opinion that this was a careless ride. Jockey Van Dyke was not surprised by the following penalty but did tell the Stewards that he planned to appeal.

**LATC RULING #005**

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE, who rode CAPTIVATE in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on September 28, 2018, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 6, 7 AND 8, 2018) FOR FAILURE TO MAKE THE PROPER EFFORT TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE AND

causing interference in the stretch resulting in a disqualification from first to second. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

**RUEBEN FUENTES FILM REVIEW (REF: 9/28/18<sup>6</sup>)**

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES appeared in the Stewards' office for an informal hearing with the Stewards. In the first race of the meet Jockey Fuentes finished first aboard #4 GRAY ADMIRAL but was disqualified and placed second for stretch interference. While #4 GRAY ADMIRAL was looking for racing room he shifts out into the body #1 IRON ALEX (Geovanni Franco). The contact between these two (2) horses was quite significant and the responsibility was placed on Jockey Fuentes in this case and not on his horse. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #006**

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES, who rode GRAY ADMIRAL in the first race at Santa Anita Park on September 28, 2018, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 6, 7 and 8, 2018) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference in the stretch resulting in a disqualification from first to fourth. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

**INFORMATION LOSS**

Santa Anita Vice President, Racing & Racing Secretary Rick Hammerle told the Stewards that they would no longer receive copies of 'The Daily Racing Form'. The Stronach Group CEO Tim Ritvo visited the Stewards yesterday and expressed concerns to the Stewards as to the expense of 'The Daily Racing Form'. Records of the racing secretary and paymaster of purses may be substantiated by records of the Daily Racing Form or any other service recognized by the board as outlined in CHRB Rule #1610 (Official Records of Eligibility).

**NEW RACING DISTANCE**

For the first time in the history of Santa Anita Park a race was contested at five (5) furlongs on the turf course. The seven-year-old FOREST CHATTER (Joel Rosario) finished first in this race setting a New Course Record (obviously) tripping the timer at the 55.96 mark.

**GARY STEVENS FILM REVIEW**

Jockey GARY STEVENS appeared in our office to review two (2) happenings in the third race yesterday September 29. Jockey Stevens rode second place finisher #3 MOBOU in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. The first matter under review was Jockey Stevens' use of his riding crop in the stretch drive. Race replays indicated he used his crop twelve (12) times. The question of a chance to respond was difficult to determine. Warning issued.

The next matter the Stewards wanted to look at was the fact that # 3 MOBOU drifted out and bumped eventual winner #1 FIG (Mario Gutierrez) in the final Twenty-five (25) yards in the battle for first place. Jockey Stevens made little corrective action in an incident that fortunately didn't decide the outcome. The Stewards issued another warning in this second matter.

**HERIBERTO FIGUEROA RULING (REF:DM 8/19/18(3))**

Del Mar CA based attorney Bing Bush recently informed Sharyn Jolly (CHRB Administrative Hearings) that his client Apprentice Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA would like to drop his appeal of DMTD (Del Mar) Ruling #28 which suspended him three (3) racing days. This ruling reinstates the original ruling whereby Apprentice Figueroa will serve equivalent (same days of the week) suspension days.

**LATC RULING #007**

Having received notice from the California Horse Racing Board that the appeal of DMTD ruling #028 (August 19, 2018) has been withdrawn, the original ruling is reinstated. Apprentice Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 7, 8, & 12, 2018).

**JERRY HOLLENDORFER RULING**

Prior to the running of the fourth race on Saturday, September 29 Horseshoe Inspector Victor Tovar called the Stewards and informed us the Jerry Hollendorfer trained #11 FLYING SCOTSMAN was improperly shod prior to competing in this event on the turf course. This horse was not scratched by the Stewards, but Victor Tovar 'filed down' this horse's toe grabs for Santa Anita turf course shoe compliance. Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer was issued the following penalty.

**LATC RULING #008**

Trainer JERRY HOLLENDORFER, who started the horse FLYING SCOTSMAN in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on September 29, 2018 is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required – improperly shod).

**MINUS POOL**

In today's fifth race (Zenyatta Stakes-Grade 1) the Bob Baffert trained #2 ABEL TASMAN (Mike Smith) went off as the prohibitive 1/9 favorite.
