Campo (Vice President Stronach Group), Daniel Eidson (Racing Director), Ami Atkinson (Human Relations), Jason Spetnagel (Vice President, Operations), Juan Espinoza (Manager, Symons Human Ambulance Service), Chen Suin (Arcadia Fire Department Battalion Chief), Lou Scalera (SA Director of Security), John Cortez (Outrider, Shop Steward), Andy LaRocca (Track Superintendent), Dennis Moore (Retiring Track Superintendent), Jim Cassidy (CTT), Alan Balch (CTT), Frank Garcia (Supervisor Association Gate) and Robert Troeger (Stable Superintendent). Emergency protocol procedures regarding fire, ambulance and accident procedures for morning training and afternoon racing were some of the topics discussed. In attendance along with the BOS, were representatives for management, Official and Racing Veterinarians were also present. Paramedic employees were available for questions.

TRAINER OBJECTION /NO CHANGE/ NINTH RACE / 7 furlongs-dirt

Following the running of the race the trainer of #6 AXELROD (J. Velasquez 4th) Mike McCarthy lodged a claim of foul against #5 IDENTITY POLITICS (I. Ortiz 2nd) for possible interference near the quarter pole. After a review of the video, conversation with jockey John Velasquez and the Patrol Judge in a unanimous decision the Stewards made no change to the original order of finish. In their opinion, #5 did shift out, made contact with #6 to its outside but this action did not warrant a disqualification.

CATALAN RULING

The following ruling was issued after an informal meeting with MR. CATALAN who admitted he was at fault. The incident was confirmed with Outrider Francisco Cardenas.

LATS RULING #001

Jockey JEFF CATALAN is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting – jogging in front of starting gate when not permitted) on December 28, 2018.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Jockey Guild Regional Manager Darrell Haire appeared representing Irad Ortiz, Jr. for two possible riding infractions in the ninth and tenth races on Wednesday. The ninth race involved a trainer objection (ref 12-26-18³). There was not a disqualification but the actions of the Ortiz mount put a third horse on the outside of the spread on the heels of #6. In a majority opinion a warning was issued for this race. Steward Sawyer voted for a suspension penalty.

In the stretch run of the tenth race (1 1/8 turf), Mr. Ortiz on the outside in the clear in the middle of the track, drifted inward at least three paths eventually taking the path of #5

Trojan Spirit (D. Van Dyke 8th) causing that one to take up sharply to avoid heels. Unanimously, the BOS voted to issue the following ruling suspending Mr. Ortiz, Jr. for careless riding.

LATS RULING #002

Jockey IRAD ORTIZ, JR., who rode AVALANCHE in the tenth race at Santa Anita Park on December 26, 2018, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (January 4, 5 and 6, 2019) for crossing over without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

SPAWR FORMAL HEARING CASE 18SA0230

A complaint was filed by the CHRB against trainer BILL SPAWR for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(f)(9) (Authorized Medication), 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances).

Present for the hearing before the BOS were, representing the CHRB Investigator Greg Icamen, Bill Spawr and court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings. On October 7, 2018 at Santa Anita Park the Spawr trainee “Skye Diamonds” who finished first in the fifth race was post race tested by U C Davis and was found to contain a class four substance of Methocarbamol, level of 6.05 ng/ml (permitted level 1 ng/ml). This is a category C penalty.

Mr. Spawr in his testimony accepted responsibility and stated his only conclusion for the overage was the possibility of medicated feed not being cleaned out before the next feeding. Decision to follow.

JOCKEY OBJECTION /NO CHANGE /FIRST RACE/ 1 1/8 turf

Following the running of the race jockey Drayden Van Dyke who rode #1 SHINING THROUGH (2nd) lodged a claim of foul against #4 MAGNIFICENT MCCOOL (F. Prat 1st) for an incident that occurred approaching the quarter pole. In a three horse spread behind #9 MYSTICAL MOON (A. Espinoza 3rd), #1 was on the inside, #7 SEVEN OXEN (K. Desormeaux 5th) was in the middle and #4 was on the outside. After a review of the video and conversation with both jockeys involved in a unanimous decision the original order of finish was made official. In the BOS opinion jockey Van Dyke’s mount, stepped out forcing #7 to make contact with #4.

After a physical examination by Official Veterinarian Tim Grande of #10 ONE UPPER in the fifth race (Tr. R. Hanson) and #9 BROKEN UP (Tr. D. O’Neill) in the ninth race, both horses were placed on the Veterinarian’s List. The Stewards voided the claims and the horses returned to the stable of their trainers.

The afternoon outriders, Jesus Camacho, Edgar Alferez, Juan Alferez and Head Outrider/ Shop Steward John Cortez met with the BOS to discuss the jockey objection in the first race yesterday. It was discovered after the race was made official the jockey objection information given to the BOS was incorrect. The BOS were given the wrong number of the jockey that claimed foul. Kent Desormeaux claimed foul and the information relayed to the Stewards stated Drayden Van Dyke had. Since the Quick Official employee has been removed from the position the responsibility has now been given to the outriders. There is now a learning curve to have correct communication between the outriders, the jockeys and the Stewards. Hopefully this discussion will help produce the accurate information in the future.

DRAYDEN VAN DYKE met with the Stewards to review the first race yesterday that involved a jockey objection. In a three horse spread contact was made causing interference. His horse stepped out and he was given a warning as the horse to his outside also contributed to the incident.

VENOSA RULING

The following ruling was issued after MR. VENOSA failed to appear for the scheduled hearing.

LATS RULING #003

Owner EDUARDO VENOSA (dba Freedom Stables Inc.), having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – Equine Medical and Surgical Group - \$5,535.15) is suspended on January 5, 2019, for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of EDUARDO VENOSA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of

Stewards to Suspend and Fine), EDUARDO VENOSA is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

HELLUM RULING

The following ruling was issued after verification that MR. HELLUM had satisfied his debtors.

LATS RULING #004

Owner/Trainer LANCE HELLUM, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$1,159.61 to Angel's Feed Inc.) is restored to good standing. Ruling DFTD #009 issued at Del Mar Race Track on November 18, 2018, is set aside.

SPAWR RULING (ref: 12-28-18³)

The following ruling was issued after MR. SPAWR was notified of his penalty. Steward Baker voted for a thousand dollar fine.

LATS RULING #005

Trainer BILL SPAWR, who started the horse SKYE DIAMONDS, the first place finisher in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 7, 2018, is fined SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substance), and #1844 (f)(9) (Authorized Medication - methocarbamol [6.05 ng/ml] in excess of permitted level of 1 ng/ml).

FUENTES RULING

After MR. FUENTES contacted the BOS and admitted guilt to violating the crop rule the following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #006

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the ninth race at Santa Anita Park on December 28, 2018.

SIMPSON FORMAL HEARING CASE #18DM0113

The CHRB filed a complaint against veterinarian TED SIMPSON for possible violation of CHRB rule 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(e)(4) (Authorized Medication), 1842 (Veterinarian Report) and 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances). On June 7, 2018 the horse "Best of Me" trained by Peter Miller finished 1st in the 7th race at Santa Anita Race Track. Post race sample #SA 27613 was analyzed by U.C. Davis Laboratory and was found to contain the Class 4 drug dexamethasone (52 pg/ml). Permitted level is (5) pg/ml. Split sample results from Industrial Laboratory confirmed presence of dexamethasone (69.5 pg/ml). DVM Simpson's Veterinarian Confidential Report showed that the horse "Best Of Me" received a phenylbutazone injection on June 6, 2018 at 0815 hrs. UC Davis reported that there were no NSAIDS found in sample #SA 27613.

Present with the BOS at today's hearing were Veterinarian Ted Simpson, CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton and Court Reporter Michelle Derieg transcribed the proceedings.

Dr. Simpson testified his conclusion for the overage and the nonexistent NSAID level would be due to the fact that the syringe he used was filled with dexamethasone instead of the intended phenylbutazone. He also stated a temporary Veterinarian assistant filled the syringes. Decision to follow.

INQUIRY / NO CHANGE / SEVENTH RACE / 6 furlongs-dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident approaching the 1/4 pole, involved were #6 DO SOMETHING EASY, (H. Figueroa 10th) and #13 BULL FIGHTER, (E. Flores 5th). After a video review and conversation with the Patrol Judge in a unanimous decision there was no change in the original order of finish. #6 caused its own demise when it shifted out over the heels of #13, clipped those heels and stumbled.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Edwin Maldonado met with the Stewards to review the ninth race yesterday. In a three horse tight spread approaching the turn in the six furlong event with Maldonado on the outside, contact was made between the three horses. In a majority vote Mr. Maldonado was issued a warning and was told to not ride so tight. Steward Jauregui voted for a suspension.

KORINER /FORMAL HEARING/STIPULATED AGREEMENT

A complaint was filed by the CHRB against trainer BRIAN KORINER for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844(e)(4) (Authorized Medication), 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances).

Present for the hearing before the BOS were Investigator Jim Hamilton presenting his final complaint before retirement, court reporter Michelle Derieg documented the proceedings and Mr. Koriner was available by telephone.

On August 18th, 2018 the horse "Mr. Vargas" trained by Brian Koriner finished 1st in the 7th race at Del Mar race track. Post race urine sample # DM 14398 was analyzed by UC Davis Laboratory and was found to contain the Class III drug "procaine" (2,932 ng/ml). Permitted level is 25 ng/ml. No split was requested.

The signed Stipulated Agreement and Mutual Release stated Mr. Koriner is suspended thirty calendar days to be stayed and fined three thousand dollars. Respondent shall be placed on probation for one year pending CHRB rule violations regarding Class I, II or III drug substances. If respondent violates the conditions of probation the thirty calendar days stayed shall be lifted. With the approval of the Stewards, a ruling will follow.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE/FIRST RACE 6 1/2-turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident during the transition crossing from the turf to dirt. Involved was #1 BAHAMIAN (G. Franco 9th). After a review of the video it was determined the horse made contact with the inside fence approaching the dirt transition, ducked and tried to jump causing its own issue. In a unanimous decision the original order of finish was made official as no other horses were involved in the incident.

INQUIRY/JOCKEY OBJECTION/NO CHANGE/FOURTH RACE 1 mile-turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident near the 3/8 marker. Involved were #5 COLONIAL CREED (R. Bejarano 2nd) and #7 GIZA GODDESS (B. Blanc 1st). After a review of the video, conversation with the Patrol Judge and both jockeys in a unanimous decision there was no change in the original order of finish. #5 between horses with #7 to his outside was in tight but did not lose ground when #7 stepped in.

INQUIRY/ACCIDENT/NO CHANGE/NINTH RACE- 6 1/2-dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident at the start. Involved was #1 MEDIA TONE (E. Roman DNF) who stumbled and unseated the jockey.
