TRAINING CITATION

Exercise Rider/Assistant Trainer TONY RUBALCAVA was in our office regarding a citation for entering the tunnel of the training track on horseback during the 15 minute workers-only period. Horses are not permitted in the tunnel during this period for safety reasons. Mr. Rubalcava acknowledged that he was in the tunnel and was very apologetic. He accepted the penalty. The following ruling was issued:

LATS RULING #065

Assistant Trainer / Exercise Rider TONY RUBALCAVA, is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to adhere to Santa Anita Park protocols) on March 25, 2019 at Santa Anita Park.

JUDE RULING (Case No:19SA0098)

The following ruling was issued against Jockey JOHN JUDE in reference to a hearing held on 3/15/19 for the amount of \$670.00. Mr. Jude boarded his ex-race horse for three weeks in the barn of Trainer Walther Solis. The ruling stated that Mr. Jude is ordered to pay the amount by May 10, 2019. Steward Baker voted to dismiss the complaint.

LATS RULING #064

Following an informal hearing held at Santa Anita Park on March 15, 2019, pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – boarding/insurance fees), it is ordered that Jockey JOHN JUDE pay Trainer Walther Solis the amount of \$670.00 by May 10, 2019. Failure to do so will result in an immediate suspension of all licenses held by JOHN JUDE.

TRAINING CITATION

Exercise Rider MARCELINO OLGUIN was in the office responding to a training citation for being in the training track tunnel on Sunday, during the 'workers only period' on March 17, 2019. Present at the hearing was Outrider Juan Garcia, who issued the citation. Mr. Olguin stated that he wasn't warned, however Garcia stated he had warned him previously. After hearing all the facts, Mr. Olguin was issued the following ruling:

RULING LATS #066

Exercise Rider MARCELINO OLGUIN, is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to adhere to Santa Anita Park protocols) on March 17, 2019 at Santa Anita Park.

LICENSE APPROVAL

Jockey GLENN CORBETT was in our office seeking approval for his jockey license. After reviewing his ARCI record and going over our rules, Mr. Corbett was granted a license.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey ALONSO QUINONEZ was in to review yesterday's first race (6 ½ furlongs turf) in which his horse (#11 NICE ICE) drifted in a few paths down the stretch. Mr. Quinonez admitted that it wasn't his best ride, and promised to do better in the future. The majority

felt the incident wasn't worthy of a suspension, but rather a warning. Steward Baker voted for a suspension.

STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE/ACCIDENT

We posted the inquiry sign after the running of the fourth race (about 6 ½ furlongs turf) when two horses fell crossing the transition. The #3 ARMS RUNNER (M. Pedroza) was injured and fell approaching the 3/16th, causing the #7 LA SARDANE (FR) (R. Fuentes) to fall unseating his rider. After reviewing the video and speaking to the Patrol Judges, we made no change to the order of finish. In our opinion the #3 fell on his own and therefore no change was made.

STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE/ACCIDENT

The inquiry sign was posted after the running of the eighth race when #1 COCO KISSES (H. Figueroa) lost his rider, when he clipped the heels of the #9 X S GOLD (K. Desormeaux) at the 3/16th pole on the hillside turf course. After reviewing the video and speaking to the Patrol Judges we made no change to the order of finish. In our opinion, the #1 was bearing out and clipped heels, therefore no blame was given to the #9. Thus, no change was made to the original order of finish.
