FILM REVIEW

Jockey ASSAEL ESPINOZA was in our office today to review his ride down the stretch in the sixth race on Monday. Mr. Espinoza made it a little too tight on the horse just inside of him. He stated that his horse was lugging in and he did say that he could of have done better. We felt the incident didn't warrant a suspension; a warning was issued.

Apprentice Jockey JORGE VELEZ also came to review Monday's sixth race in which his horse drifted out from a left handed urging. The young rider agreed that he should of have kept a tighter hold of his inside reign to prevent his horse from drifting out when using his riding crop. We wanted to review the race with him for educational purposes. He appreciated the input and stated he would be better in the future.

TREECE FORMAL HEARING (case#19SA0161)

Trainer CHARLES SCOTT TREECE responded to a complaint filed by the CHRB regarding a probation violation of CHRB LAQL Ruling #186. Mr. Treece was placed on probation by the Los Alamitos Quarter Horse Stewards on August 17, 2018 (ruling #186). The probation violation occurred on 1/11/19 at Santa Anita Park in the second race, where his horse "SEA GLASS" tested positive of the Class 4 medication "Dexamethasone", which is a class C penalty. Presenting the case for the CHRB were Investigators Angelica Merz and Greg Icamen, and recording the proceedings was Court Reporter Michelle Derieg. Mr. Treece stated he knew the conditions of the probations and did not disagree that he violated it. After hearing all the facts and entering all the exhibits the formal hearing came to an end. Decision to follow.

TREECE RULING

The following ruling was issued regarding yesterday's formal hearing (ref: 5/31/19¹) regarding Trainer CHARLES TREECE. Mr. Treece is ordered to pay the \$4,000 fine that was stated in the Los Alamitos Quarter Horse Stewards ruling (#186) dated on August 17, 2018.

LATS Ruling #108

Following a formal hearing held at Santa Anita Park on May 31, 2019, the Santa Anita Board of Stewards find Trainer CHARLES TREECE in violation of the terms of probation as outlined in Los Alamitos Quarter Horse Racing Association Ruling #186 dated August 17, 2018.

Following the issuance of Santa Anita Park Ruling #83 dated April 26, 2019, the stay of the fine (\$4,000.00) listed in Los Alamitos Quarter Racing Association Ruling #186 (August 17, 2018) has now been lifted.

Trainer CHUCK TREECE is ordered to pay FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,000.00)* to the Santa Anita Paymaster of Purses by June 8, 2019.

FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Jockey Jorge Velez was in to review yesterday’s first race in which he violated the riding crop rule. The apprentice jockey did not disagree that he violated the rule and he was very apologetic. The following the ruling was issued.

LATS Ruling #109

Apprentice Jockey JORGE VELEZ, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the first race at Santa Anita Park on May 31, 2019.

BARRIENTOS CASE #19SA0140

The following ruling was issued after Groom JEOVANY BARRIENTOS failed to appear for a complaint filed by the CHRB regarding rule violations of #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), #1889 (Entry to Area Assigned to Trainer) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

LATS Ruling #110

Groom JEOVANY BARRIENTOS, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), #1889 (Entry to Area Assigned to Trainer – entering trainer’s stalls without approval) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Racing) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of JEOVANY BARRIENTOS are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), JEOVANY BARRIENTOS is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

STEWARDS INQUIRY/NO CHANGE/ACCIDENT

After the running of the first race (5 furlong turf) we posted the inquiry sign to review a single horse incident. The #3 “SILENCED” (T. Pereira) bolted at the ¼ pole, causing him to lose his rider. After speaking to the patrol judges and reviewing the video, we made no change to the order of finish. We determined that the #3 bolted and therefore there was no blame to place on any other runners. Business and Professions Code Section 19481.3(e) provides that the stewards shall investigate and prepare a report regarding all on-track accidents involving jockeys that occur during the performance of the jockeys' duties. The investigation shall commence no later than the next live racing day and shall be completed expeditiously.
