Report for the Week of Monday, June 15, 2020 through Sunday, June 21, 2020, Closing Day

WEDNESDAY6/17/20¹**ENTRY DAY**

Racing Secretary Steve Lym and his staff were on hand in the racing office, assembling a racing card for Saturday, June 20, 2020. Steward Luis Jauregui was on duty in the Stewards' office today. This penultimate entry day of racing for this meet yielded twelve (12) races. Ninety-seven (97) horses are scheduled to face Starter Jay Slender. Post time will be 12:30 p.m.

THURSDAY6/18/20¹**ENTRY/SCRATCH DAY**

Today entries were taken for the final (61st) day of the 2019/2020 Winter/Spring meet here at Santa Anita. The Covid-19 pandemic and cancelation of all Thursday racing cards led significantly to a reduced racing schedule this meet. Steward Luis Jauregui was on duty today in the Stewards' Office. One (1) scratch was submitted for Friday June 26. Assistant Clerk of Scales Charles McCaul activated the scratch at 10:00 a.m.

Twelve (12) races were drawn in the racing office today for Sunday, June 21, 2020 which is day 61 and closing day for this 2019/2020 Winter/Spring meet. This meet was originally scheduled for one hundred and two (102) days.

FRIDAY6/19/20¹**ANTONIO GARCIA HEARING (CASE NO. 19SA0112)**

Trainer ANTONIO GARCIA appeared in our office for an informal hearing today. Antonio Garcia has been charged with violating CHRB Rule #1894 (Duties of a Trainer). Owner Mario Garcia owned a horse and had Antonio Garcia listed as trainer. This horse raced on February 3, 2020 at Santa Anita. Antonio Garcia said he had little to do with the day to day training of this horse even though a 50% owner of this horse had other horses trained by Antonio Garcia. The horse in question was stabled, along with the stable pony, in a barn that was not in Antonio Garcia's main shed row.

CHRB Investigator Mike Barker prepared the complaint in this matter. The Stewards will deliberate on this case and render a decision.

MARIO LOPEZ GARCIA COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 20SA0040)

Owner MARIO LOPEZ GARCIA was recently suspended (REF: 6/6/20¹) for failing to appear at an informal hearing. Investigator Mike Barker filed a complaint against Mario Garcia alleging violations of CHRB Rule #1489 (a) Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) and CHRB Rule #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation). The details of this case are listed in the minute entry above. Testimony indicates Mario Lopez was training a horse while not licensed to do as such here in California. Mr. Garcia told us he is currently an assistant trainer in the State of Florida. He told us he did not know of his most recent hearing where he failed to appear. We told him to update his address with the CHRB as he still shows a California address. There will be more to follow on this matter.

APPRENTICE VICTOR FLORES MEETING

Apprentice Jockey VICTOR FLORES appeared in the Stewards' office today to inform us of a financial dispute he is having with his former agent Rene San Miguel. Their business relationship ended last Wednesday, June 17, 2020. The last day of entries in Santa Anita's final condition book was Thursday June 18, 2020. We contacted Agent San Miguel via telephone and got his side of the story. Due to time constraints this informal hearing will be continued on another day if needed.

DEREK LAWSON RULING

Trainer Jeff Mullins contacted the duty Steward Luis Jauregui on Wednesday June 17 and informed him that Jockey Agent DEREK LAWSON backed out of a commitment to ride the Mullins trained UNBRIDLED ETHOS on Saturday June 20. Agent Lawson represents Jockey Flavien Prat. When contacted Lawson, who is not a novice when it comes to the late cancellation of jockey engagements, felt that the Peter Miller trained SILARDI was a more appealing opportunity. In a unanimous vote the Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #101

Jockey Agent DEREK LAWSON, is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – failure to conduct business in a proper manner) on June 17, 2020 at Santa Anita Park.

IAN KRULJAC RULING (REF:6/14/20²)

The ruling below was issued in a majority decision following a hearing in our office last week. Steward Luis Jauregui voted for a \$500 fine. Trainer KRULJAC was originally cited by Santa Anita Stable security for two (2) incidents. The CHRB also filed a complaint (Case No. 20SA0029) in this matter. He was not sanctioned for an incident (Incident #1) at his barn with Dr. Laura Bohannon. He was fined for using the F bomb (Incident #2) a couple of times (speaking about Examining Veterinarian Jay Deluhery) over the phone to State Veterinarian Assistant Amy Nagakawa.

Twenty-five (25) months ago Ian Kruljac was fined for an outburst directed at CHRB Veterinarian Tim Grande (REF: SA MINUTES 05/24/18³). Hopefully, Mr. Kruljac's demeanor improves before alienating any more of the very professional equine practitioners working on the front and back side at Santa Anita.

LATS RULING #102

Trainer IAN KRULJAC, who was discourteous towards the State Veterinarian Assistant at Santa Anita Park on January 9, 2020 at Santa Anita Park is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – foul language).

KAREN VALKO DVM RULING (REF: 6/13/20¹)

The ruling below was issued in a unanimous decision. DR. VALKO was informed by telephone.

LATS RULING #103

Veterinarian KAREN VALKO, who signed a 'Recommendation for Removal from CHRB Veterinarian's List Form' at Del Mar Race Track on November 17, 2019, is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1866 (Veterinarian's List – failed to examine horse prior to removal).

HERIBERTO FIGUEROA FILM REVIEW

Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the eighth race on Sunday, June 14, 2020. Jockey Figueroa was eighth place finisher #12 AGENT ZERO in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. Jockey Figueroa needlessly employed his riding crop twelve (12) times in the final two (2) furlongs of this race.

LATS RULING #104

Jockey HERIBERTO FIGUEROA, is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop - excessive) during the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on June 14, 2020.

ABEL CEDILLO RULING (REF: 6/14/20⁵)

Jockey ABEL CEDILLO appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #3 SOLO ANIMO who originally finished third in the fifth race on Sunday June 14. This race was contested at 5½ furlongs on the infield turf course. Film review shows #3 SOLO ANIMO shift off his straight path after Jockey Cedillo looks to his right. This action led to contact with second place finisher #9 ABSOLUTE UNIT (Flavien Prat) who in turn gives fifth place finisher #10 Inch (Geovanni Franco) a significant bump.

The Stewards determined that Jockey Cedillo was 'not clear' when he rode his horse carelessly, leading to interference with two (2) rivals and the subsequent disqualification of his mount from third to fifth. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #105

Jockey ABEL CEDILLO, who rode SOLO ANIMO in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on June 14, 2020, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 26, 27 & 28, 2020), for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch, causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from third to fifth place. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

OSCAR HEREDIA RULING (REF: 6/12/20¹)

Trainer OSCAR HEREDIA was informed of the following majority decision on the telephone. Mr. Heredia, who is licensed as a trainer, shared in the earnings of another trainer when he raced a horse he owned at Santa Anita on March 2, 2019. Steward Sawyer believed Mr. Heredia did not share in any earnings of another trainer and felt the case should be dismissed.

LATS RULING #106

Owner/Trainer OSCAR HEREDIA, is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer – sublet duties to another trainer) on February 9, 2019 at Santa Anita Park.

OFFICIAL CHANGE

Horse Identifier JENNIFER PAIGE is off this week. Santa Anita Racing Department Executive Assistant Ami Atkinson renewed her racing official license today and will fill in. Ms. Atkinson has served as a horse identifier at the old Hollywood Park and Los Alamitos in years past.

FIFTH RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW

Track Announcer Frank Mirahmadi announced that a Stewards' Review would be conducted in this race. Of particular interest in this one (1) mile turf event were the actions of eighth place finisher #1 NEGOFATOR (Heriberto Figueroa) who bore out badly on the first turn and seventh

place finisher #4 PRESS BRIEFING (Abel Cedillo) who steadied to avoid interference. The interferer was beaten by the sufferer of this incident therefore no formal Stewards' inquiry was conducted.

DR. EDWIN LYNN 'TED' SIMPSON FORMAL HEARING (CASE NO: 20SA0042)

The cover page of this fifteen (15) page complaint stated in part that the Mark Glatt trained ZESTFULL tested positive for Triamcilonone Acetonide on September 15, 2019 at Los Alamitos Race Course. Treatments by DR. TED SIMPSON (Private Veterinarian) on 8/31/2019 caused the positive. The 'Veterinary Confidential Report' turned into CHRB on 8/31/19 from Dr. Simpson did not initially contain information on the treatment ZESTFULL which was given leading to the positive. A confidential report from Dr. Simpson containing the information on ZESTFULL getting the treatment in question was later received and it did not match the confidential report originally given to the CHRB.

Along with Stewards present at today's hearing were CHRB Investigator Mike Barker, Veterinarian Ted Simpson and Attorney Alan Klein (Rancho Mirage CA) who represented Dr. Simpson. Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribed today's proceedings. In his closing Statement Attorney Klein told the Stewards that this case essentially amounted to a "clerical error". Decision to follow.

VICTOR FLORES RETURNS (REF:6/19/20³)

Apprentice Jockey VICTOR FLORES returned to our office today to discuss his situation with his former agent Rene San Miguel. We're hoping these two (2) licensees can come to an agreement on the amount owed to Agent San Miguel. If not, we will adjudicate their disagreement in a more formal forum.

6/20/20³

SAM HERZBERG RULING

Trainer Simon Callaghan contacted the Stewards yesterday (6/19/20) and told us that Owner SAM HERZBERG (DBA Sterling Racing LLC) wanted to move his horse WORLD AFFAIRS to trainer Mark Glatt's barn after his horse was drawn into the 11th Race today Saturday June 20. The Stewards were of the unanimous opinion that the integrity of CHRB Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) would be severely compromised. The Stewards told Trainer Callaghan a penalty would be issued if this horse switched barns after time of entry

necessitating a late scratch. The Stewards spoke to Owner Herzberg and he accepted and understood the reasoning behind the following ruling.

LATS RULING #107

Owner SAM HERZBERG, who was scheduled to start WORLD AFFAIRS in the eleventh race on June 20, 2020, at Santa Anita Park, is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – owner decision - transferred horse after entry).

FIRST RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the start of this 5 ½ furlong (turf) event. Of particular interest were the actions of original third place finisher #6 HAMMERING LEMON (Evin Roman) who angled in sharply after the start. Race replays show #6 HAMMERING LEMON make contact with eventual second place finisher #4 CAERULEAN (Mario Gutierrez) who in turn shifts inward making contact with sixth place finisher #3 ME MACHO (Victor Flores) forcing that rival to check his mount sharply. After receiving a patrol judge report and reviewing all replay angles the Stewards, in a unanimous decision disqualified #6 HAMMERING LEMON and placed him sixth. Jockey Evin Roman was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

The complaint in this complaint reads as follows:
KC Horse Transport alleges that Tachycardia Stables is indebted to them in the amount of \$1,086.43 for transportation services rendered.

Owner Brendan Bakir (DBA TACHYCARDIA STABLES) was suspended February 22, 2020 for failing to appear in front of Golden Gate Fields Stewards (REF: GGF Ruling #41) at a hearing in Berkeley CA. We withdrew this complaint today. Nobody showed up for the hearing with Mr. Bakir already being suspended.

EDWIN 'TED' SIMPSON DVM RULING (REF: 6/20/20¹)

Rancho Mirage CA based attorney Alan Klein was contacted from our office via telephone this morning. The fine included in the ruling listed below was issued following deliberation of documents and testimony presented in a formal hearing yesterday June 20. Our decision was unanimous.

LATS RULING #108

Veterinarian EDWIN "TED" SIMPSON, is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1842 (Veterinarian Report – failed to disclose treatment) on August 31, 2019.

ANTONIO GARCIA RULING (REF:6/19/20 (1))

Trainer ANTONIO GARCIA appeared in our office Friday June 19, 2020 for an informal hearing. Testimony from an honest Antonio Garcia indicated that Owner Mario Garcia had more to do with the actual day to day training of a horse even though he was licensed as trainer. He was called on the phone and informed of our unanimous decision as CHRB Rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer) was violated.

LATS RULING #109

Trainer ANTONIO GARCIA, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer – sublet duties).

MARIO LOPEZ GARCIA RULING (REF: 6/19/20 (2))

MARIO LOPEZ GARCIA was suspended by Santa Anita Stewards on June 6, 2020 (LATS Ruling #92) for not appearing at a hearing. We conducted a telephonic informal hearing with him Friday June 19, 2020. He is currently working as an assistant trainer in the state of Florida. Mario Garcia was training a horse here in February 2019 at Santa Anita and not properly licensed as a trainer. The following ruling was issued in a unanimous decision.

LATS RULING #110

Owner MARIO LOPEZ GARCIA, having participated in a recorded informal hearing by telephone to answer case number #20SA0040, is restored to good standing. LATS Ruling #092, which was issued at Santa Anita Park on June 6, 2020 is set aside.

Furthermore, MR. GARCIA is fined is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for violation of CHRB rule #1489 (a)(4) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – unqualified to engage in the activities for which a license is required).

MIKE SMITH RULING

Jockey MIKE SMITH appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in yesterday's seventh race which he won aboard #7 AX MAN. In the final furlong of this 1 1/16th mile main track event the Stewards determined that Jockey Smith used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times without giving his horse a chance to respond. Jockey Smith agreed with our analysis. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #111

Jockey MIKE SMITH, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond) during the seventh race at Santa Anita Park on June 20, 2020.

6/21/20⁶

DRAYDEN VAN DYKE RULING

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE appeared in the Stewards' office to review his use of the riding crop in the 2nd Race yesterday June 20. This one (1) mile turf event was the \$100,000 Guaranteed Wilshire Stakes (Grade 3).

Jockey Van Dyke was aboard second place finisher #2 RED LARK (IRE). Film review at today's informal hearing shows Van Dyke use his riding crop four (4) consecutive times in two (2) separate (right-handed & left-handed) instances in the stretch drive. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

LATS RULING #112

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond) during the second race at Santa Anita Park on June 20, 2020.

EVIN ROMAN FILM REVIEW (6/20/20⁴)

Jockey EVIN ROMAN appeared in the Stewards' office this morning to review his ride in the first race yesterday June 20. Jockey Roman was aboard #6 HAMMERING LEMON who finished third but was disqualified and placed sixth for interference at the start.

Film review shows #6 HAMMERING LEMON bobble and angle inward immediately after the start. Jockey Roman then uses his riding crop (right-handed) one (1) time. This led to interference to two (2) rivals to his inside. Jockey Roman understood the reasons for a disqualification. In a 2-1 vote (Baker dissent-3 day suspension) Jockey Roman was given a warning. The majority blamed the horse for the incident.

ABEL CEDILLO/UMBERTO RISPOLI FILM REVIEW

Jockeys ABEL CEDILLO and UMBERTO RISPOLI appeared in our office to review their efforts in yesterday's (June 20) sixth race. In this 5 ½ furlong turf event. Jockey Cedillo was aboard third place finisher #2 UNBRIDLED ETHOS and Jockey Rispoli rode fourth place finisher #5 CITY RAGE.

JOCKEY CEDILLO--#2 UNBRIDLED ETHOS was racing along the rail entering the stretch. Jockey Cedillo shifts his horse outward after lacking racing room while closing strongly in the final 100 yards. In an aggressive move, he attempts to go up between first place finisher #8 SILARDI (Flavien Prat) and #5 CITY RAGE while drifting out. In a unanimous vote he was issued a warning for this ride.

JOCKEY RISPOLI- In the final sixty (60) yards, #5 CITY RAGE drifts out and makes contact with sixth place finisher #7 STRICTLY BIZ (Jose Valdivia). The majority voted for a warning for this ride. Steward Baker voted for a riding suspension for careless riding.

SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY/OBJECTION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of this 11/16th mile Melair Stakes (\$150,000 Guaranteed) which was contested on the main track. Jockey Mario Gutierrez, who rode fourth place finisher #5 HOMEHOME also lodged an objection against second place finisher #2 SMILING SHIRLEE (Mike Smith) for an incident at the seven (7) furlong marker. Race replays showed #2 SMILING SHIRLEE take back off the heels of third place finisher #1 BIG SWEEP (Flavien Prat) and shift outward after doing so. This shift led to contact with fourth place finisher #5 HOMEHOME. The Stewards spoke to both jockeys involved, received a patrol judge report and reviewed all camera angles of the incident. In a unanimous decision the Stewards ruled the incident did not warrant a change in the original placings. No change.

NINTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the 3/8ths pole. In this 6 ½ furlong main track event, second place finisher #6 SAVING SOPHIE (Jose Valdivia Jr.) angles in sharply forcing third place finisher #1 COSMIC LIGHT (Flavien Prat) to steady sharply. The margin at the finish between these two rivals was 15 ¾ lengths according to Equibase 'call taker' Ken Davis.

After speaking with both jockeys involved, a patrol judge report from far turn judge Randy Valdez an reviewing all camera angles the Stewards made 'no change' in the order of finish. Jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. was ordered to review films of the race with the Los Alamitos Thoroughbred Stewards' on opening day Friday June 26, 2020.

UNsung HEROS OF RACING

Equibase chart caller MIKE SCHNEIDER will be 'calling it a career' after today's twelfth race. Mike and his wife Kathleen will be moving to New Orleans LA next week to begin what we wish to be a happy and healthy retirement. Mike began working for 'The Daily Racing Form' in 1985 in the Bay Area and later replaced Jon White in the Southern California press box in1993. Like Jon White, Mike is a true professional whose written description of the running of a race is as good as anyone in the country. Like Sandy Koufax, he's retiring while performing at a very high level. He will be missed by everyone he worked with in California racing the last several decades.

4th Race Jockey Change #11 CONNIE'S PROMISE M. Gutierrez for K. Desormeaux— Failed to receive Covid-19 results)
