BREEDERS' CUP ENTRY/DRAW DAY

The final entry deadline for the 2019 Breeders' Cup at 10:00 a.m. today. The Rood & Riddle Breeders' Cup Post-Position Draw was held between 3:30 and 5:30 p.m. at the Breakfast Marque located adjacent to Clocker's Corner. Stewards Baker, Jauregui and Sawyer were on duty in the Stewards' Office. Undercard (Non-Breeders' Cup) races for Friday and Saturday were drawn in the racing office.

There will be ten (10) races on Friday November 1. Seven (7) of the races are Breeders' Cup events. A total of One hundred fourteen (114) horses are scheduled to start. First post time is 10:45 p.m. Twelve (12) races will be contested on Saturday November 2. First post time is 10:07 a.m. Nine (9) Breeders' Cup races will be contested. One hundred twenty-eight (128) horses are scheduled to start on this day that has an extraordinary racing card.

EQUIPMENT CHANGE MEETING

Director of Racing Steve Lym and Paddock/Patrol Judge Ed Reese appeared in the Stewards' Office for an unscheduled meeting this morning. Alex Sausville, an intern from the University of Arizona Racetrack Industry Program (RTIP), was a visitor for the meeting. The discussion of this meeting dealt with the equipment (blinker) information that we receive from foreign countries. There is some concern over the accuracy of racing equipment from the many countries that

conduct horse racing overseas. Paddock Judge Reese is being as proactive as possible this week, and tries to keep equipment information as accurate as possible, particularly for this Breeders' Cup week at Santa Anita.

OFFICE OPEN

Stewards Baker, Jauregui and Sawyer were on duty in the Stewards' Office today. Routine duties including eligibility checks, rulings etc. were worked on. Steward Baker served as a Safety Steward during morning training hours.

Stewards Baker, Jauregui and Sawyer were on duty in the Stewards' Office today. Steward Sawyer served as a Safety Steward during morning hours. Trainer Eddie Kenneally, who trains the Breeders' Cup horse GIRLS KNOW BEST, visited the Stewards' Office at our request. GIRLS KNOW BEST is on the 'also eligible' in the Breeders' Cup Sprint (\$1,000,000) on Saturday, November 2. She is also entered on Saturday in the Senator Ken Maddy Stakes (\$100,000 Guaranteed -Grade 3). She is #9 in the 'body' of the race. Mr. Kenneally was concerned about Lasix treatment for his trainee on this day. We told him it was his responsibility to communicate his Lasix administration with the proper officials.

THURSDAY

FLAVIEN PRAT FILM REVIEW

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT appeared in in the Stewards' office to review two (2) races with the Stewards. In the third race on Sunday, October 27 Jockey Prat was aboard third place finisher #4 COSMIC COWGIRL who finished third in this six (6) furlong main track event. Entering the stretch #4 COSMIC COWGIRL swings out in front of fifth place finisher #3 MAJESTIC GIGI (Eswan Flores). #3 MAJESTIC GIGI steadies at the time of the incident. Jockey Prat was given a 'warning' for not being sufficiently clear of his rival.

The second incident took place on Saturday, October 26. The third race on Saturday was contested at one (1) mile on the infield turf course. Jockey Prat was aboard #3 M IS FOR MAGIC, who finished third in what was a competitive battle for the show position. After the field passes the finish line Jockey Prat rides his mount up onto the heels of second place finisher #2 MAGICALLY HONORED (Martin Garcia). #3 M IS FOR MAGIC then shifts off heels forcing three (3) rivals to steady their horses. Jockey Prat was told to be careful of interference even after the race is over.

GEORGE LOPEZ RULING

The following ruling was issued today in what was a unanimous decision the Stewards. The complainant in this matter, Trainer Librado Barocio, appeared in our office on the hearing date of October 27. The hearing was originally scheduled for October 19. Owner GEORGE LOPEZ requested and was granted a continuance at that time. Mr. Lopez failed to appear for the rescheduled hearing date.

LATC RULING # 032

Owner GEORGE LOPEZ, (dba Hay Day Racing), having failed to appear before the Board of Stewards at Santa Anita Park on October 27, 2019 to answer a complaint regarding case #19DM0043 alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility –Librado Barocio - \$1,500.00) is suspended pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). Suspension to commence on November 7, 2019.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of GEORGE LOPEZ are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), GEORGE LOPEZ is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

KENJI MORINAGA RULING (REF:10/20/19³)

The Stewards' were contacted by a representative of the veterinarian group Equine Medical Center. We were told that the debt allegedly owed by KENJI MORINAGA has been paid in full. The following ruling reinstates the licensee privileges of Mr. Morinaga.

LATC RULING #033

Owner KENJI MORINAGA, (dba K M Racing Enterprises, Inc.), having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$18,211.97 to Equine Medical Center) is restored to good standing. Ruling LATC #022 issued at Santa Anita Park on October 20 18, 2019, is set aside.

RANDY RENNON RULING (REF:10/27/19¹)

Patricia Valenzuela, representing Robert K. Mitchell (Bonnie Acres Ranch), called the Stewards office to inform us that the outstanding debt owed to Mr. Mitchell has been paid in full. The following ruling reinstates the license privileges of MR. RENNON.

ASSAEL ESPINOZA / JORGE VELEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey ASSAEL ESPINOZA and Apprentice Jockey JORGE VELEZ appeared in our office to review their rides in the fifth race on Sunday, October 27. These riders finished seventh and eighth (last and next to last) in this six (6) furlong main track event. Apprentice Velez (#4 HERGAME) and Jockey Espinoza (#8 TIME FOR EBBY) both used their riding crop while being very well beaten, racing in the back of the pack. Both riders understood the reasoning behind the Steward's unanimous decision in the issuance of the following two (2) rulings.

LATC RULING #035

Jockey ASSAEL ESPINOZA, is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule ##1688(b)(5) (Use of Riding Crop – when the horse was clearly out of the race), during the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 27, 2019.

LATC RULING #036

Apprentice Jockey JORGE VELEZ is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(5) (Use of Riding Crop – when the horse was clearly out of the race), during the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 27, 2019.

JOCKEYS ROOM MEETING

The Stewards met with the jockey's that are riding in the Breeders' Cup this weekend. Twenty-three (23) jockeys that ply their trade either out of state or overseas are riding overseas. The Stewards reviewed CHRB Rule #1688 with the riding colony. We also introduced them to veterinarians, human ambulance personnel and racing officials. Normally routine matters such as arriving in the walking ring on time and listening for the 'Riders Up' call of Paddock Judge Ed Reese were discussed. How to lodge an objection and riding safety were also discussed. Questions from the outstanding jockey colony were taken at the end of the meeting.

EXTRA PATROL JUDGE---EXTRA PADDOCK JUDGE

Santa Anita has hired a third patrol judge for Friday and Saturday. Veteran racing official Matt Nichols will be in radio contact with the Stewards from the 1/8th pole patrol tower location. Also Racing Office Entry Clerk Don August will assist Paddock Judge Ed Resse in the 'saddling barn' and walking ring.

11/01/19⁴

THIRD RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards' posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident approaching the far turn (3/8ths pole). This seven (7) furlong event was the \$200,000 Guaranteed Golden State Juvenile Fillies Stakes. Approaching the far turn eleventh (last) place finisher #5 STRADARI (Flavien Prat) drifts out and starts chain reaction contact between third place finisher #4 WARREN'S SHOWTIME (Jorge Velez), tenth place finisher #6 BELLA RENELLA and finally ninth place finisher #10 WARM SUMMER (ABEL CEDILLO) who was bothered most of all. The Stewards received a patrol judge report, spoke to jockeys and reviewed all camera angles. In a unanimous decision the Stewards ruled that the majority of interference/confusion in this race was caused by the aforementioned last place finisher. Therefore, no change was made in the order of finish.

11/01/19⁵ **SIXTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards' posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident coming out of the turn and entering the stretch. This one (1) mile turf event was the Grade 1-\$1,000,000 Guaranteed Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. The Stewards were viewing the actions of #14 HIT THE ROAD (Flavien Prat-Original Dead Heat 7th) and fourteenth (last) place finisher #15 DEVIANT (Drayden Van Dyke). Film review shows #14 HIT THE ROAD shift out in front of #15 DEVIANT forcing that rival to stumble badly after clipping the heels of #14 HIT THE ROAD. Fourth place finisher DECORATED INVADER (Irada Ortiz Jr.) was racing alongside #15 DEVIANT and the Stewards felt he did not 'play in' to the incident. After speaking with jockeys involved, receiving a patrol judge report and reviewing all camera angles the Stewards disqualified #14 HIT THE ROAD and placed him fourteenth. Jockey Flavien Prat was ordered to film review with the Stewards. Our decision was unanimous.

11/02/19² **IRAD ORTIZ, JR. RULING**

Jockey IRAD ORTIZ, JR. took off his assigned mount in the third race yesterday November 1. This assignment was aboard #10 WARM SUMMER who started in the third race (\$200,000 Guaranteed – Golden State Juvenile Fillies). In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

LATC RULING #038

Jockey IRAD ORTIZ, JR., who was scheduled to ride WARM SUMMER in the third race on November 1, 2019 at Santa Anita Park, is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

OWNER FILM REVIEW

Owner KALEEM SHAH (Kaleem Shah Inc.) requested a film review of the Breeders' Cup Fillies Grade 1 - \$2,000,000 race. He was accompanied by his son Arman Shah and Aran's brother-in-law Nick Streetsberg. Of particular interest were the actions of #1 DONNA VELOCE who finished second in this race. There was slight contact between #1 DONNA VELOCE and the winner of the race #4 BRITISH IDIOM (Javier Castellano). Film review showed both horses make slight contact going into the first turn while racing in tight quarters. The 'incident' was minor in nature and Mr. Shah thanked the Stewards for their time and explanation of the incident.

JOCKEYS' ROOM MEETING

As was the case yesterday the Stewards met with the jockey's colony prior to today's 10:07a.m. post-time. The Stewards spoke about details of the race riding yesterday which was in most instances good. Of significant concern to the Stewards was the two (2) separate occurrences where jockeys were late to mount their horses in the walking ring and contributed to safety concerns with large crowds in the paddock.

RUBEN FUENTES FILM REVIEW

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES appeared in the Stewards Office to review his ride in the fourth race on Friday, November 1. This seven (7) furlong event was the \$200,000 Guaranteed 'Golden State Juvenile'. In The opening furlong #2 CALI DUDE, with Jockey Fuentes aboard, drifts out putting significant pressure on #4 DAPPER (Geovanni Franco) who finished eighth. Little correctible action was taken by Jockey Fuentes. The Stewards felt this horse was racing somewhat 'green' and there was enough mitigation with that to issue a warning for this ride. Our decision was unanimous.

11/03/19²

WILLIAM BUICK RULING

Jockey WILLIAM BUICK rode #5 DAAHYEH (GB) to a second-place finish in the grade 1 \$1,000,000 Guaranteed Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. This was his only mount on the day's card (8th race). He was late to get a 'leg up' on his horse. This led him to being out of order in the post parade. Most importantly it caused an unsafe situation in the walking ring outside the saddling barn. Our decision was unanimous.

LATC RULING #037

Jockey WILLIAM BUICK is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – failure to mount horse in a timely manner) for the eighth race on November 1, 2019, at Santa Anita Park.

RICHARD KINGSCOTE RULING

The following ruling involves circumstances very similar to the ruling above. Jockey RICHARD KINGSCOTE couldn't seem to find his one (1) mount on the day's card until all the other jockeys had mounted their horses and left the walking ring. Jockey Kingscote finished fifth aboard on #8 DR. SIMPSON (FR) in the Grade 2 \$1,000,000 Guaranteed Juvenile Turf Sprint.

LATC RULING #39

Jockey RICHARD KINGSCOTE is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – failure to mount horse in a timely manner) for the fifth race on November 1, 2019, at Santa Anita Park.

T. R. BELL II RULING

Trainer T. R. (RAY) BELL II requested permission to administer his horse Lasix after entries had been drawn in the racing office. The Stewards granted permission and issued the following ruling. The decision to grant permission and the decision to issue the fine that is memorialized below and was unanimous.

LATC RULING #040

Trainer THOMAS RAY BELL II is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication – late registration of MANRESA in the second race) on November 3, 2019, at Santa Anita Park.

JORGE VELEZ RULINGS

Del Mar based Attorney Bing Bush contacted CHRB employee Sharyn Jolly (Administrative Hearings) requesting to drop the appeals of DMTD Ruling #011 (Four-day suspension) and DMTD Ruling #031 (Five Day suspension) issued at Del Mar last summer. The Stewards all agreed to issue the following two (2) rulings.

LATC RULING #041

Having received notice from the California Horse Racing Board that the appeal of DMTD ruling #011 (July 24, 2019) has been withdrawn, the original ruling is reinstated. Apprentice Jockey JORGE VELEZ is suspended for FOUR (4) racing days (November 14, 15, 16 & 17, 2019).

LATC RULING #042

Having received notice from the California Horse Racing Board that the appeal of DMTD ruling #031 (August 9, 2019) has been withdrawn, the original ruling is reinstated. Apprentice Jockey JORGE VELEZ is suspended for FIVE (5) racing days (November 22, 23, 24, 28 & 29, 2019).

FLAVIEN PRAT FILM REVIEW

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #14 HIT THE ROAD, who finished in a dead heat for seventh but was disqualified and placed fourteen (REF: 11/1/19⁵) in the Grade 1 \$1,000,000 Guaranteed Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf which was contested at one (1) mile.

A film review of this race shows #14 HIT THE ROAD shift out for racing room inside the ¼ mile marker. The shift was in front of original fourteenth (last) place finisher #15 DEVIANT (Drayden Van Dyke). At this juncture #15 DEVIANT clips the heels of #14 HIT THE ROAD causing #15 to stumble badly, nearly unseating Jockey Van Dyke. For what we determined to be careless riding, the following ruling was issued, in a unanimous decision.

LATC RULING #043

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT, who rode HIT THE ROAD in the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on November 1, 2019, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 9, 10, & 14, 2019), for altering course without sufficient clearance entering the stretch, resulting in disqualification from seventh (DH) to fourteenth (last). This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

RAFAEL BEJARANO FILM REVIEW

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO appeared in the Stewards office to review his ride in yesterday's first race which was the \$100,000 Ken Maddy Stakes (Grade 3). In this six-furlong race Jockey Bejarano used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times in the final one hundred (100) yards. Jockey Bejarano narrowly finished third in a photo finish. The majority voted for the following ruling. Stewards Baker felt Bejarano's use of the crop gained his horse 'black type' grading, over fourth place rival #2 DON'T SELL (Mario Gutierrez) and voted for a higher fine.

LATC RULING #044

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the first race at Santa Anita Park on November 2, 2019.

JOEL ROSARIO FILM REVIEW

Jockey JOEL ROSARIO appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #2 OLLIE'S CANDY who finished fourth in yesterday's tenth race which was the Grade II \$2,000,000 Breeders' Cup Distaff which was contested at 1 1/8 miles on the main track. Entering the first turn, film review shows #2 OLLIE'S CANDY drift out forcing eventual eighth place finisher #3 STREET BAND (Sophie Doyle) off what was once her straight course. #7 SECRET SPICE (John Velasquez), who finished third was also bothered slightly. In a unanimous decision Jockey Rosario, who said he plans to ride at Santa Anita next meet, was issued a warning.

Santa Anita Valet Rafael Castaneda appeared in the Stewards office this morning to represent Jockey GABRIEL SAEZ, who rode here yesterday but returned to the east coast where he ply's his trade. The race of interest was the Grand 1 \$1,000,000 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. Jockey Saez was aboard seventh place finisher #4 MR. MONEY. At the ¼ pole location MR. MONEY shifts out and bothers sixth place finisher #7 COAL FRONT (Javier Castellano) who steady's his horse when blocked. Jockey Saez then appears to overcorrect and shifts inward blocking eventual fourth place finisher #10 SNAPPER SINCLAIR (Ricardo Santana Jr.). Following Film

review with Mr. Castaneda the Stewards, in a majority decision, issued a warning for this ride. Steward Baker voted for a three (3) day suspension.

ALONDRA MALDONADO/ HERIBERTO FIGUEROA INFORMAL MEETING

Exercise Rider Alondra Maldonado appeared in the Stewards' office on today's closing day of the meet at Santa Anita. She was accompanied by Jockey Heriberto Figueroa. Ms. Maldonado was involved in an accident during morning training hours earlier this Breeders' Cup week. A horse she was on 'ran off' with her going the wrong way while the main track was quite crowded. Lead morning Outrider John Cortez assisted Ms. Maldonado by capturing what was essentially a runaway horse. Unfortunately, Outrider Cortez and Exercise Rider Maldonado both were unseated from their horses when Ms. Maldonado's horse ducked off the track at the corporation yard gap. Ms. Maldonado was attended to by human ambulance personnel. Outrider Cortez got back up on his horse and worked the rest of the morning after being examined.

Santa Anita management has told Ms. Maldonado and us that they don't want her to exercise horses here at Santa Anita. She appeared to have recovered from the incident. We referred her to our neighboring office which is that of Santa Anita Director of Racing Steve Lym regarding further details about working here.

EARLY POST TIME

We all set our clocks back one (1) hour last night for daylight savings time. Due to the lack of daylight later in the afternoon, today's nine (9) race card commenced at 11:30 a.m. The last race of the meet (Race 9) on today's 'fall back' closing day card was 3:47p.m.

NINTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the ninth race which was contested at six (6) furlongs on the main track. Of particular interest were the actions of fourth place finisher #10 BULLY FOR ERIC (Efrain Hernandez), second place finisher #1 TEMPLE KNIGHTS (Assael Espinoza) and fifth place finisher #8 HOSS CARTRIGHT (Tyler Baze). Film review shows #10 BULLY FOR ERIC drift out approaching the 1/8-mile marker. This action forces second place finisher #1 TEMPLE KNIGHTS off of what was previously his straight path. At this point Jockey Tyler Baze, who is racing outside of the aforementioned two (2) rivals is forced to 'check' his mount off of heels.

The Stewards' received a patrol judge report, spoke to the jockeys involved and reviewed all replay angles. In a majority decision (Baker dissent – DQ - #10 4th to 5th) the majority felt the incident didn't rise to the level of a disqualification and allowed the original placings to stand.
