**Report for the Week of Thursday, October 10, 2019 through Monday, October 14, 2019.****TUESDAY**10/8/19<sup>1</sup>**SCRATCH DAY**

Scratches and changes for Thursday, October 10, 2019 took place in the racing office this morning. Steward Luis Jauregui was on duty in the Stewards' office. One jockey change, one (1) gelding change and one (1) corrected weight were all activated at the 10:00 am deadline.

**WEDNESDAY**10/9/19<sup>1</sup>**ENTRY DAY**

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday, October 12. Nine (9) races were filled by Racing Secretary Steve Lym. Sixty-nine (69) horses are scheduled to start. Steward Luis Jauregui was on duty in the Stewards' office.

**THURSDAY**10/10/19<sup>1</sup>**JOCKEY DRAYDEN VAN DYKE FILM REVIEW**

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE appeared in the Stewards office to review his ride aboard #1 HARIBOUX (GB) who finished fifth in the \$100,000 Guaranteed Zuma Beach Stakes which was contested at one (1) mile on the turf course. Film review today shows #1 HARIBOUX (GB), who finished fifth drift in at the 1/8<sup>th</sup> pole and make contact with eventual third place finisher #4 BILLY BATTS (Tiago Pereira). The Stewards felt Jockey Van Dyke was focusing on showing his riding crop to his mount when he failed to keep a straight course. The Stewards in a unanimous decision ruled that this ride was not penalty worthy and a warning was issued.

**ANDREW STRONACH COMPLAINT (19DM0038)**

Horse Transporter Don Lockwood filed a complaint against Owner ANDREW STRONACH for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). The complaint was originally scheduled to be heard October 3, 2019 but was postponed at the request of Candice Warwick, who was representing Andrew Stronach. The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

*Don Lockwood stated he is owed \$24,365.00 from owner Andrew Stronach for transporting multiple loads of horses between the dates of 3/17/18 to 12/10/18.*

The Stewards spoke with Don Lockwood this morning. He informed us that this bill has been paid in full. This complaint has now been withdrawn and taken off our calendar.

**ERIC NELSON ARROYO RULING**

Jockey Agent NELSON ARROYO named his jockey on a Peter Miller trainee, at the draw on October 6. Trainer Miller did not want to employ the jockey (Heriberto Figueroa) that Agent Arroyo named on at the draw. This subsequently led to a jockey change. For improperly handling his jockey agent business Agent Arroyo was assessed the penalty listed in the ruling below. Our decision was unanimous.

**LATC RULING #011**

Jockey Agent ERICK 'NELSON' ARROYO is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – failure to conduct business in a proper manner) on October 6, 2019, at Santa Anita Park.

**JESUS NUNEZ RULING**

Trainer JESUS NUNEZ was not present to saddle SUEZAAANA in the fifth race at Santa Anita on October 6. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #012**

Trainer JESUS NUNEZ, who failed to saddle SUEZAAANA in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 6, 2019 is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer).

**EDWIN MALDONADO RULING**

The Stewards observed Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO use his riding crop for four (4) consecutive times in the stretch while aboard #5 BULLETPROOF ONE, who finished second in the \$100,000 Guaranteed Speakeasy Stakes on Sunday, October 6. Following this race Jockey Maldonado called the Stewards from the jockeys' room and 'pled guilty' to the riding crop violation memorialized in the ruling below.

**LATC RULING #013**

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on October 6, 2019.

**MABLE ROBERTS RULING (CASE #19LT0026)**

Veterinarian Ronald Magrini filed a complaint against Owner MABLE ROBERTS for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Dr. Magrini alleges that Ms. Roberts owes him \$710.68 for past due veterinarian treatments. For failing appear at a hearing that was scheduled yesterday, October 10 the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #014**

Owner MABLE ROBERTS, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – Robert J. Magrini, VMD - \$710.68) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of MABLE ROBERTS are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine). Furthermore MABLE ROBERTS is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**MICHAEL MACHOWSKY/MICHAEL MACHOWSKY RACING STABLES COMPLAINT (CASE # 19DM0040)**

Owner Shelly Stull (dba Bellavantage Farms) filed a complaint against owner Michael Machowsky/Michael Machowsky Racing Stables for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). The cover page of the forty-four (44) page complaint, written by Shelly Stull and subsequently prepared by CHRB Investigator Angelica Merz, reads as follows:

*Michael Machowsky, a licensee of the CHRB, boarded his thoroughbred racehorse ON THE ROCKS, at my farm between 7-18-2018 and 6-11-2019. He was charged \$2,200 per month to which he agreed. I have prepared and sent him invoices regarding the boarding bill. As of 8-24-2019 he owes me \$16,206.63 for unpaid board bills. Attached is a ledger showing the boarding costs and any payments made. I tried to settle this informally but he has not agreed to make payments or pay the bill.*

Present at today's hearing was respondent MICHAEL MACHOWSKY and Dana Machowsky, who is Mr. Machowsky's wife. Also present were Ms. Stull, along with her bookkeeper Cindy Bell. This case revolved around a former racehorse who was being trained to be a hunter/jumper horse at Ms. Stull's Bellavantage Farms. After about thirty (30) minutes of testimony and questioning this informal hearing was brought to a halt. Both parties had no issues with having this matter heard by an outside judge. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, dismissed this complaint without prejudice.

**JUDGES' STAND VISITORS**

Newly appointed CHRB Board Members WENDY MITCHELL and OSCAR GONZALEZ paid a visit to the Stewards' stand this afternoon. They were accompanied by CHRB Staff Services Manager/Public Information Officer Mike Marten. The Stewards explained some of the afternoon responsibilities that we have and talked about the technology we use in our location on the sixth level of the grandstand.

**FIRST RACE INQUIRY/JOCKEY’S OBJECTION**

A Stewards’ Inquiry and a Jockey Objection were conducted into the stretch drive of today’s first race. Jockey Ruben Fuentes #5 GOVENOR CINCH (second place) claimed foul against #2 BRICKYARD RIDE (Jorge Velez – first place). This event was contested at six (6) furlongs on the main track. In this race #2 BRICKYARD RIDE (Jorge Velez) was leading the field entering the stretch. At the 1/16<sup>th</sup> mile marker, #2 BRICKYARD RIDE then drifts inward under right handed urging. Second place finisher #5 GOVENOR CINCH (Ruben Fuentes) was closing well along the inside when Jockey Fuentes hesitates when an opening tightens. The Stewards’ conducted a film review following the incident. The Stewards spoke to both jockeys involved and received a Patrol Judge report.

The majority felt both horses shifted and when this occurred #5 GOVENOR CINCH was clear of the heels of #2 BRICKYARD RIDE and allowed the original placings to stand. Steward Baker dissented voting for #2 BRICKYARD RIDE to be placed second.

Karen Klawitter, who represents the veterinarian group Southern California Equine Foundation, filed a complaint that was scheduled to be heard today. The complaint alleges violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) stating that Trainer LIBRADO BAROCIO owes \$1,008.00 for services provided. The Stewards were informed that Trainer Barocio has paid this bill and this case has now been dismissed.

**RUBEN FUENTES FILM REVIEW**

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES appeared in the Stewards’ office to review his ride aboard #5 COOL YOUR JETS, who finished fourth in a one (1) mile turf event. This was race 3 yesterday October 11. Three (3) separate occurrences were reviewed.

- A. While entering the far (3/8<sup>th</sup> turn) #5 COOL YOUR JETS angles inward entering the turn causing sixth place finisher #7 SUMMER FUN (Geovanni Franco) racing between horses, to steady his mount.
- B. At the 1/8<sup>th</sup> pole #5 COOL YOUR JETS drifts in and bumps third place finisher #2 JETOVATOR.
- C. After the bumping incident, Jockey Fuentes violates CHRB Rule #1688 by using his riding crop four (4) consecutive times, without giving his horse a chance to respond. For the first two (2) incidents (A & B) Jockey Fuentes was issued separate warnings. For the riding crop incident (C) the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #015**

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the third race at Santa Anita Park on October 11, 2019.

**JOSE ARTURO MARE VIOLATION NOTICE**

Exercise Rider JOSE ARTURO MARES appeared in the Stewards’ office today for an informal hearing on the morning of October 10. Outrider Cindy Ellet asked Santa Anita Security to issue a ‘Violation Notice’ for Mr. Mares. The violation notice reads as follows:

*Per Outrider Cynthia Ellet citation issued to the above name for being disobedient with verbal abuse.*

Ms. Ellet gave her testimony over the telephone. She told the Stewards that on October 10 she yelled at Mr. Mares to ‘get off the rail’ while he was galloping his horse due to the allegation that two (2) other horses were conducting a workout along the rail. According to Ms. Ellet, Exercise Rider Mares responded by verbally abusing her. Mr. Mares disagreed with the exact details of the morning’s incident but agreed he could have handled things better. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #016**

Exercise Rider J. Arturo Mares, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – disrespect towards an outrider), on October 10, 2019, at Santa Anita Park.

**STEVE KNAPP COMPLAINT (CASE #19LT0010)**

Trainer STEVE KNAPP appeared in our office today for a formal hearing that was chaired by Steward Kim Sawyer. CHRB Investigator Angelica Merz presented the thirty-three (33) page complaint at this hearing. Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribe the proceedings.

The cover page of the complaint reads as follows:

The official blood sample #OM15491 taken on August 25, 2019, was reported by Ben Moeller of the MADDY EACL at U.C. Davis to contain Phenylbutazone (430ng/ML). This sample was obtained from the horse 'EMTECH' which ran in the 1<sup>st</sup> race at Del Mar finishing 2<sup>nd</sup>. The trainer of record is Steve Knapp. A split sample analysis was declined. This violation is a Class 4 drug with a penalty category Class C.

Trainer Knapp was charged with violation of CHRB Rule #1843(a)(b) & (d), Rule #1843.1 Prohibited Drug Substances and Rule #1887(a) Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse. Mr. Knapp represented himself at today's hearing. He stated that he didn't know why his trainee contained levels of Phenylbutazone in the test sample. Decision to follow.

**FIRST RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards determined that a Stewards' review should be conducted into the running of the first race. Of particular interest were the actions of the fourth place finisher #3 MALIBU STAR (Evin Roman) and fifth place finisher #4 CALL ME DADDY (Abel Cedillo). Entering the far (3/8ths) turn # 4 CALL ME DADDY is in fifth (last) position and Jockey Cedillo is using his riding crop in an uncocked position. #4 CALL ME DADDY initiates contact with #3 MALIBU STAR. Jockey Cedillo becomes 'unbalanced' in the saddle following this incident that in the Stewards opinion was a result of his own actions. The Steward finished their brief review as they felt there was no reason to post the inquiry sign.

**KELLY CASTANEDA COMPLAINT (19LT0012)**

Nolton Pattio, VMD, who was the CHRB Veterinarian at the Los Alamitos Thoroughbred meet on September 8, 2019, filed a complaint against Trainer KELLY CASTANADA for alleged violation of CHRB rule #1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn). Trainer Castaneda appeared to day along with his wife Cande Murillo. This hearing was originally scheduled for October 18, 2019. The complaint reads as follows:

*FOUR GAELS arrived late to receiving barn for the 5<sup>th</sup> race; the horse was due to arrive at the Receiving bar at 2:20 p.m.; following 2 pages at 2:28 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. the horse finally arrived at 2:34 p.m.*

Trainer Castaneda told the Stewards that his groom had a difficult time putting a bridle on this eight (8) year old gelding at his barn. He also said he thought about scratching the horse. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #17**

Trainer KELLY CASTANEDA, who started the horse FOUR GAELS in the fifth race at Los Alamitos Race Course on September 8, 2019, is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn – late to the receiving barn).

**STEVE KNAPP RULING (REF: 10/13/19<sup>2</sup>)**

The Stewards issued the following ruling in a majority decision. Steward Sawyer dissented (\$1,000 fine). The STEVE KNAPP trained 'EMTECH' had a bute level of 5.10 ug/ml after he raced on September 6, 2018. The violation in the following ruling was reported after the horse 'EMTECH' raced at Del Mar on August 25, 2019.

**LATC RULING #018**

Trainer STEVE KNAPP, who started the horse EMTECH, second place finisher in the first race at Del Mar Race Track on August 25, 2019, is fined ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00)\*, for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a)(d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances), pursuant to #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse), for violation of #1843.1 (Prohibited Drug Substances – Phenylbutazone (Class 4) in excess of permitted level – second offense in 365 days).

**ABEL CEDILLO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey ABEL CEDILLO appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #2 JOEYS ACE who finish seventh in the second race yesterday October 13. A 'head on' view of the start show Jockey Cedillo slap his horse on the shoulder three (3) or four (4) times leaving the starting gate. This action forced the eventual first place finisher #1 BIG RUNNER (Ruben Fuentes) down into the gap area between the temporary rail at the starting gate and the main inside rail of the turf course. This is a turf race distance (5 ½ furlongs) that is new this meet at Santa Anita. The Stewards called Vice President of Racing Steve Lym following this race suggesting the Starting Gate should be place further out from the inside rail in future 5 ½ furlong turf events. Management came out to the starting gate for race 6 which was a race contested at the same distance and the gate was place further out which appeared to improve the quality of dispatch.

Getting back to Jockey Cedillo, his effort in the race as borderline careless as there was a very late effort to straighten his mount. However, the Stewards' are giving Jockey Cedillo, who was in or office on October 3 for a film review, received the benefit of the doubt in this race as the starting gate could have set in a better location in the opinion of the Stewards. Warning issued.

**SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY**

Following the running of the seventh race the Stewards posted the Inquiry Sign. This race was contested at 5 ½ furlongs on the infield turf course. Approaching the 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile marker second place finisher #1 STORMING LADY (Victor Espinoza), who is racing in last position along the rail, shifts out from behind horses and makes contact with fifth place finisher #4 SMOOVIE (Abel Cedillo). #4 SMOOVIE is then forced out into fourth place finisher #2 STYLISHLY (Drayden Van Dyke). After speaking with the jockey, Patrol Judge and conducting a film review the Stewards allowed the original placings to stand. Our decision was unanimous. Jockey Victor Espinoza was ordered to Film Review with the Stewards.
