08-01-07<sup>4</sup> **ACCIDENT - INQUIRY - NO CHANGE - First Race**

Following the running of the first race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of an accident near the 4½ furlong pole involving #3 ITAALIC, ridden by Angel Felix.

After reviewing the tapes of the race the order of finish, as posted, was declared official.

The tape shows #3 veer sharply to the left and unseat jockey Angel Felix. No other horses were involved and both rider and horse appeared to be uninjured.

08-01-07<sup>5</sup> **TRAINER OBJECTION - NO CHANGE - Sixth Race**

Following the running of the sixth race, Armando Lage, trainer of #1 VERNAL EQUINOX (3<sup>rd</sup>, Catalino Martinez), lodged a claim of foul against #3 CRAFTY POWER (2<sup>nd</sup>, Luis Contreras) for alleged interference through the stretch.

After reviewing the recorded views the race was declared official.

The objection was dismissed after the tapes failed to support the alleged interference.

08-01-07<sup>6</sup> **INQUIRY / OBJECTION - NO CHANGE - Ninth Race**

Following the running of the ninth race, the inquiry sign was posted for a stewards' review of contact between #8 CANDI'S TOAST (3<sup>rd</sup>, David Lopez) and #10 HAPPY ONE (1<sup>st</sup>, Luis Contreras) near the 1/16 pole. Jockey David Lopez also lodged a claim of foul against the winner.

There also was contact between #3 PARADISE COVE (2<sup>nd</sup>, Jose Martinez-Campos) and #6 CASTLE DERMOT (4<sup>th</sup>, Chad Schvaneveldt) from the 1/8 pole to the wire and again just past the wire, which was reviewed.

The tapes show in both incidents that each horse contributed to their respective incidents of contact, therefore no change was made to the order of finish.

An area of safety concern came into play at the wire, or just past the wire, as the rider of #5, on the outside, continued to ride and allow his mount to drift inward and place several horses in tight quarters. Mr. Martinez-Campos was invited to review the race with the stewards.

Apprentice Jockey **PEDRO FLORES**, who rode **SILENT TOUCH** in the seventh race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on July 21, 2007, is suspended three (3) racing days (August 8, 9 and 10, 2007) for misuse of the whip (whipping the horse on the flank), a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips).

The above listed ruling was issued after Mr. Flores appeared, waived his right to a formal hearing

and pled guilty. The preceding plea was entered into the record after Mr. Flores was informed what the possible sanction would be and elected to forgo a hearing. Days were issued due to the fact that Mr. Flores has had multiple offenses..

08-02-07<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 15 - MARTINEZ-CAMPOS** (Refer 08-01-07<sup>6</sup>)

Apprentice Jockey **JOSE MARTINEZ-CAMPOS**, who rode PARADISE COVE in the ninth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on August 1, 2007, is hereby suspended three (3) racing days (August 9, 10 and 11, 2007) for failing to maintain a straight course and causing interference at or past the finish – a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Martinez-Campos accompanied by valet Joe Hernandez, acting as Mr. Martinez-Campos’ interpreter, met with this Board, reviewed the race and failed to provide an excusable reason that would absolve him of sanctions.

08-02-07<sup>5</sup> **RULING NO. 16 - LOPEZ**

Jockey **ADALBERTO LOPEZ** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for failure to make weight in the tenth race on Wednesday, August 1, 2007 – a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1683 (Maximum Overweight).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Lopez met with the stewards and pled guilty.

Jockey **AGUSTIN VALLEJO**, who has a habit of not showing up to ride his mounts (see references 7-12-07<sup>5</sup>, 7-15-07<sup>3</sup>, 7-26-07<sup>3</sup> and 7-30-07<sup>3</sup>), appeared as directed to explain why he failed to fulfill his riding assignment in the second race on July 30, 2007.

After a brief discussion with Mr. Vallejo, who spoke through a friend acting as an interpreter, the request was made for Mr. Vallejo to submit a urine test and he refused.

After considering his refusal and admissions made by Mr. Vallejo he was taken off his mounts.

08-03-07<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION - Third Race**

Following the running of the third race, the inquiry sign was lit for a review of two separate incidents. The first incident was at the start involving #6 MANDY'S TURN (9<sup>th</sup>, Robert Anderson) and #7 BLINKIE (2<sup>nd</sup>, Sergio Ruiz).

The second incident was near the 1/8 pole involving #8 BABY SISTER (1<sup>st</sup>, Carlos Villalobos), #7 BLINKIE and #4 BAR JF SPEED-N-TICKET (4<sup>th</sup>, Anthony Ayala).

After reviewing the race and speaking with the riders involved, no change was made regarding the incident at the start. For the second incident, #8 was disqualified from first and placed fifth.

The tape shows, at the start, #6 shift out as #7 shifts in resulting in #6 catching the heels of #7 and stumble. Both mules contributed to the incident therefore, no change was made.

In the second incident, the tape shows #8 drift toward the rail, forcing #7 off its path and into the path of #4, forcing the rider of #4 to check and alter course. In the stewards' unanimous opinion, the placing of #4 was effected therefore, #8 was placed behind #4.

08-04-07<sup>3</sup> **VILLALOBOS FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Carlos Villalobos** came in to review yesterday's third race, a race in which his mount was disqualified from first and placed fifth.

After reviewing the race, Mr. Villalobos was commended for the effort he exhibited while trying to keep his mount on a straight path. No sanction warranted.

08-04-07<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY - OBJECTION - DISQUALIFICATION - First Race**

The inquiry sign was posted for a review of an accident at the start of the first race involving #2 GENIE-JONES (Fell, Otto Arriaga) and a second incident involving #1 BAR JF FLYIN J (1<sup>st</sup>, Robert Boyce), #3 HOLLYWOOD BABE (2<sup>nd</sup>, Sergio Ruiz) and #4 RTR LOST IN THE FOG (4<sup>th</sup>, Elliott Demesme).

Jockeys on #3 and #4 also lodged objections against #1 for interference near the 1/8 pole.

After review of the recorded views of the race and talking to the jockeys involved, #1 was disqualified from first and placed fourth.

No other mules were involved with the accident involving #2. The tape shows the mule lose its stride soon after the start, stumble and fall.

As to the second incident, the tape shows #1 lug out into the path of #3 and #4, forcing the riders of those mules to check to avoid the heels of #1 and chances at better placings.

08-04-07<sup>5</sup> **INQUIRY - NO CHANGE - Second Race**

Following the running of the second race the inquiry was lit once again for a review of the start, involving #6 TRIPLE B JAZZ (last place, Barrington Harvey), #5 THREEXADEAL (4<sup>th</sup>, Carlos Villalobos) and #3 TERESITA GO HIGH (2<sup>nd</sup>, Robert Boyce).

After reviewing the race the numbers posted were made official.

The tapes show #6 breaks inward at the start and severely impede #5 and #3. #6 finished last therefore, no change was necessary.

08-04-07<sup>6</sup> **INQUIRY - NO CHANGE - Fifth Race**

Yet another inquiry was held following the running of the fifth race for a review of observed interference on the 3/8 turn involving #8 TAKE WARNING (7<sup>th</sup>, Barrington Harvey), #3

RIVERRUNS THRUIT (2<sup>nd</sup>, Frank Alvarado) and #1 SANGER SHADOW (6<sup>th</sup>, Pedro Flores).

After reviewing the tapes of the race the numbers as posted were declared official.

The tapes show #8 angles in on the turn, cross over and cause serious interference to number #3 and #1. Both those rivals finished in front of #8 therefore, no disqualification was necessary.

08-04-07<sup>7</sup> **LATE DECLARATION REQUEST - Ninth Race**

Prior to the running of the feature race of the day, the Joseph T. Grace Handicap (9<sup>th</sup> race), trainer **NEIL DRYSDALE** phoned the stewards requesting to declare his horse, RED FORT, out of the race. Scratch time for stakes races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1630 is no later than one hour before post time. Mr. Drysdale cited safety concerns that were raised and voiced to him by his rider Russell Baze after Mr. Baze rode a horse over the turf course in the sixth race. Mr. Baze did contact the stewards following the running of the sixth race and voiced his concerns. A review of the race was conducted by the stewards and that review failed to support Mr. Baze's contention. The result of that review was relayed to Mr. Drysdale however, he was steadfast in his request and the horse was declared.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of PABLO CASTILLO are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Castillo continually failed to appear before the stewards and to ride his mounts.

08-05-07<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 18 - DRYSDALE** (refer: 08-04-077)

Trainer **NEIL DRYSDALE** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run) necessitating the late declaration of RED FORT from the ninth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on August 4, 2007.

The preceding ruling was issued after the stewards contacted Mr. Drysdale and he waived his right to a hearing.

08-05-07<sup>5</sup> **RULING NO. 19 - HARVEY**

Jockey **BARRINGTON HARVEY**, who rode **TAKE WARNING** in the fifth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on August 4, 2007, is suspended three racing days (August 12, 13 and 15, 2007) for altering course without sufficient clearance and causing interference - a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules - careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Harvey reviewed the race in question and failed to convince the stewards that he gave a maximum effort to avoid causing interference.

Jockey **MODESTO LINARES** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for misuse of the whip (whipping the horse on the flank) on Sunday, August 5, 2007 - a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Linares acknowledged letting his temper get the best of him.

08-06-07<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 21 - DINGESS**

Trainer **HERMAN DINGESS, JR.** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run) necessitating the late declaration of LAST CONQUEST from the ninth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on August 6, 2007.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Dingess decided not to ship his horse from Pleasanton prior to being excused from the ninth race. Mr. Dingess cited surface concern with the turf course as the reason for not shipping his horse.

08-06-07<sup>5</sup> **ACCIDENT - INQUIRY - NO CHANGE - Second Race**

The inquiry sign was posted after the running of the second race for a stewards' review of an accident near the 1/8 pole involving #2 NO JOSHIN, ridden by jockey Jesus Arriaga.

After reviewing the recorded views of the race the numbers posted were made official.

The tapes show #2 duck sharply to the right, unseat jockey Arriaga and continue outward, forcing #4 STRAW FLY SURPRISE (3<sup>rd</sup>) into #5 A SHARPER BON (4<sup>th</sup>).

Jockey Arriaga was placed in the ambulance and transported to Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital. The horse appeared to be uninjured and was caught by the outrider without further incident.

08-06-07<sup>6</sup> **SHORT DELAY - Fourth Race**

Jockey **FRANK ALVARADO** was replaced by jockey Sergio Ruiz on #2 OUTSIDE DINING after Mr. Alvarado was injured when OUTSIDE DINING became fractious and broke through the gate. There was approximately a minute delay for the horse to make it back to the starting gate after being re-saddled. Mr. Alvarado's injuries appeared to be minor.
