07-22-08<sup>1</sup> **PRE-MEET**

Steward **Dennis Nevin** was on hand to set up the office, check phones and all equipment.

**Wednesday**

07-23-08<sup>1</sup> **RULING NO. 1 – MARTINEZ**

Jockey **CATALINO MARTINEZ**, who rode **SEE YA WAGER** in the sixth race at the Solano County Fair (Vallejo) on Monday, July 21, 2008, is suspended three (3) racing days (July 30, 31 and August 1, 2008) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course after the start and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Martinez appeared and reviewed his efforts in Monday's sixth race at Vallejo. Martinez agreed he let his horse alter course after the start causing #7 SURPRISE POWER and jockey Modesto Linares to check sharply. #7 goes on to beat Martinez' horse so no change was necessary.

07-23-08<sup>2</sup> **RICHARD LEWIS**

Director of Racing **Richard Lewis** was in and discussed coordination of the races. All systems are reported operational according to Mr. Lewis.

07-23-08<sup>3</sup> **THIRD RACE DELAY**

The starting gate had some mechanical difficulties that needed repair to prepare for this turf race. To complicate matters driver Butch Zollinger had a difficult time backing the gate into position. Original post was scheduled for 1:47 p.m. and the race was off at 2:03 p.m. No further problems occurred with the other two turf races.

**Thursday**07-24-08<sup>1</sup> **JUAN JOSE ROMO, JR. HEARING** (Case 08GG089)

Trainer **JUAN ROMO** failed to appear to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules 1878, 1530, 1588 (j), 1592 and 1894. Romo called as the hearing was ready to commence to ask for permission to testify by phone – request denied. Mr. Romo, being the principal in this matter, was required to appear personally and will be suspended pending further hearing.

07-24-08<sup>2</sup> **INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – DISQUALIFICATION – Second Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry to review an incident near the 4 ½ furlong marker in which #2 REASONER fell, unseating rider Jorge Ayarza. After review, it was determined #3 KADY DE SOI, ridden by **Barrington Harvey**, came in causing #2 to clip heels and fall. #3 was disqualified from ninth to unplaced for interference. Jockey Harvey will review his effort in the morning with the stewards. An accident report will be attached. Both jockey Ayarza and horse REASONER appeared uninjured.

07-24-08<sup>3</sup> **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – Seventh Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry to review bumping between second and third place finishers #5 FLEET FELINE (Kyle Kaenel) and #4 GETAWAII (Abraham Arreola). After tape review and talking with the riders, it was determined that #4 stepped out as #5 stepped in, causing the bumping to be a 50/50 proposition. No change was ordered.

07-24-08<sup>4</sup> **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – Eighth Race**

Jockey **Pablo Castillo**, aboard ninth place finisher #2 MORAL DELEMMA, lodged a claim of foul against fourth place finisher #3 THAINTY and jockey Joe Castro for alleged interference in the 3/8 turn. After review and talking with the riders, it was determined that room existed for #2 to the inside of #3 and no foul occurred. No Change.

**Friday**07-25-08<sup>1</sup> **RULING NO. 2 – ROMO, JR.**

Owner/Trainer **JUAN JOSE ROMO, JR.**, having failed to appear for a scheduled hearing before the Board of Stewards at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on or before Thursday, July 24, 2008, to answer a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1878 (Workouts), #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations), #1588 (j) (Horse Ineligible to Start in a Race), #1592 (Ineligible Horse to be Disqualified) and #1894 (Duties of Trainer), is hereby suspended pending a hearing before the Board of Stewards for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Juan Jose Romo, Jr. are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspended and Fine), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after due deliberation. (Refer: 07-24-08<sup>1</sup>)

07-25-08<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 3 – HARVEY** (Refer: 07-24-08<sup>2</sup>)

Jockey **BARRINGTON HARVEY**, who rode **KADY DE SOI** in the second race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on Thursday, July 24, 2008, is suspended ten (10) racing days (August 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 13, 2008) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course after the start and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from ninth to unplaced; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Harvey appeared and argued his case. Harvey felt the blame lay with his mount that was hard to handle. The stewards felt Mr. Harvey could have made a more substantial effort with another horse and rider in jeopardy.

Jockey **Kyle Kaenel** was in to review his ride in yesterday's seventh race and cautioned to keep a straighter course in the stretch.

07-25-08<sup>4</sup> **BAKER STARS**

Steward **Grant Baker** was a guest on the handicapping workshop to help promote the public's understanding of stewards' and officials' responsibilities.

07-25-08<sup>5</sup> **INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE – First Race**

The mule #5 BAR JF ROSEANNA bucked about half way through this 400 yard dash, unseating rider Javier Gomez. The inquiry sign was posted to confirm no other mules were involved. #5 acted of her own accord and no change was necessary. Both rider and mule appeared unscathed. An accident report will be attached to the minutes.

07-25-08<sup>6</sup> **8<sup>TH</sup> RACE DEBACLE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

At approximately four minutes to post, rider **Barrington Harvey** relayed a message through the outriders that he did not wish to ride his mount, #1 SKIPPING OUT JOE. #1 was sent back to the paddock and the balance of the horses were sent to the gate and the riders dismounted. Jockey Pedro Flores accepted the mount from trainer Terri Eaton and proper announcements were made to the public. The horses were loaded into the gate and as fate would have it, #1 'flipped' and got cast. Track Veterinarian Robert Connolly recommended scratching #1 which was accomplished and the race ran. Original post time 4:18 p.m.; off time 4:32 p.m., a fourteen minute delay. #6 HAINT CALLING failed to leave the gate in a timely fashion and the inquiry sign was lit. After review, it was determined that #6 dwelt in the gate of its own accord. No Change.

The above ruling was issued for failure to have proper works, necessitating a scratch from a six horse field.

Jockey **Luis Martinez** appeared to review his ride in yesterday's fourth race. Martinez was exonerated from blame as his horse stumbled at the start.

07-27-08<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 5 – HINES** (Case 08GG099)

Association Employee **JAMES R. HINES**, having failed to appear for a scheduled hearing before the Board of Stewards at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on Saturday, July 26, 2008, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489 (g) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), #1874 (2, 3, 4) (Disorderly Conduct), #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing) is hereby suspended pending a hearing before the Board of Stewards for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of James R. Hines are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

Association employee **James R. Hines** failed to appear to answer charges of violation of 1489(g) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), 1874 (Disorderly Conduct), 1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocations) and 1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing). Reports are that Hines is in a hospital under treatment. The above ruling will ensure a paper trail is kept.
