07-27-11¹ **NEW STEWARDS' AIDE**

Director of Racing Richard Lewis introduced us to our new stewards' aide Elizabeth Mellema. The stewards went over the duties of the stewards' aide both during the morning (stewards' office) and in the afternoon (winner's circle).

07-27-11² **HECTOR ROMERO** (Refer: 07-23-11⁴)

Jockey Hector Romero was removed from his two (2) mounts (second and fifth races) on today's card. The stewards had conversation with Romero's agent, Rogelio Olguin (in stewards' office), CHRB Executive Director Kirk Breed and jockey Romero himself. Mr. Breed and Mr. Romero were spoken to telephonically. This Board of Stewards has been informed by CHRB headquarters there are issues with the probation that jockey Romero is currently on until July 2012. More to follow.

07-27-11³ **RULING NO. 1 – WILKINSON**

In the matter of:

Owner / Trainer **JAMES W. WILKINSON**

Owner/Trainer JAMES W. WILKINSON, having now resolved the

outstanding financial obligation to Kim Leonard, is hereby restored to good standing and California State Fair ruling #12, dated July 24, 2011 suspending Mr. Wilkinson for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear), is set aside.

The stewards were notified by California Horse Racing Board headquarters that owner/trainer James Wilkinson had satisfied his debt to owner Kim Leonard (Case 11SW0037). Wilkinson is a standardbred owner/trainer who races at Cal Expo Harness. The ruling above re-instates the license privileges of James Wilkinson.

07-27-11³ **RACHEL GOODGAME FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Rachel Goodgame** appeared in the stewards' office to review her ride aboard #6 YOUONLYLIVEONCE, who finished sixth in the seventh race on Sunday, July 24 at the California State Fair (Sacramento). Film review shows YOUONLYLIVEONCE break in sharply, specifically bothering #2 OFF TO OPERATE (Juan Hernandez, 4th) and #3 GOLDEN GLACIER (Billy Lewis, 9th). Replays indicate YOUONLYLIVEONCE break inward and jockey Goodgame makes a slight degree of effort to straighten her mount. The stewards told jockey Goodgame she needs to make a strong effort in the future. Warning issued.

07-27-11⁴ **LAST RACE DELAY**

Shortly before the horses loaded in the starting gate for the eighth race jockey Barrington Harvey became unseated from his mount, #2 LADY'S COMET. This horse was eventually scratched after running off over a half mile. The starting gate needed to be backed off the infield turf course in order for the declared horse to leave the track. This incident led to approximately a six (6) minute delay to the start of this race. This horse was placed on the starter's list by starter Todd Stephens. Barrington Harvey was not injured.

07-28-11¹ **JAMES WOOTEN HEARING** (Case No.: 11GG0181)

Jockey **James Wooten** appeared for a formal hearing in the stewards' office today to answer to a charge of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1484 (Evidence of Unfitness of License). This case was presented to the stewards by CHRIB Investigator Carol Nolan. These proceedings were recorded by Diane Freeman, C.S.R. (Niccoli Reporting). The complaint reads as follows:

"On February 18, 2011 the Oregon Racing Commission issued a 'Final Order License

Reinstatement' to James W. Wooten, Jr.

Stewards in the State of Oregon recommended that jockey James Wooten application for license be denied on November 13, 2010. In less than a week's time jockey Wooten appealed that order.

An appeal hearing was held in February 2011. In their final order the Oregon Racing Commission issued a fifteen (15) page decision that stated his 'application for license reinstatement is denied' and 'that he cannot apply to have his licensure reinstated until after October 27, 2015.' "

James Wooten represented himself and did not present any documents at today's hearing. During questioning he stated he has inquired about licensing possibilities in Arizona. However, Arizona officials told him to take care of his 'Oregon problem' before approaching them for a license in the future. In the fifteen (15) page Oregon Racing Commission Final Order, fourteen (14) separate arrests of James Wooten are listed. These arrests took place in the states of California, Oregon, Washington and Georgia. These arrests took place between 1993 and 2007. Mr. Wooten disputed some of the accuracy of these events. The entire 'Oregon Final Order' was marked as an exhibit and entered onto the record. The hearing was closed and now the stewards will deliberate on this matter. More to come.

07-28-11² **INQUIRY – Second Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the running of this three hundred fifty (350) yard quarter horse race. At the midway point of this race third place finisher, #6 SEPARATE FANTASIES (Luis Lira) drifts out into the path of second place finisher #8 BARBARO EL TEXANO (April Boag) forcing that rival to alter course. Due to the fact that #8 BARBARO EL TEXANO finished ahead of #6 SEPARATE FANTASIES, no change was made in the order of finish. Jockey Luis Lira was ordered to film review with the stewards.

07-29-11¹ **JESUS VELAZQUEZ FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice jockey Jesus Velazquez appeared in the stewards' office with jockey agent/interpreter Fernando Navarro to review his ride aboard #5 TIKIS MOMENT in yesterday's (July 28) first race. In this race #5 TIKIS MOMENT drifts into the path of #6 RIVER PIRATE (David Essman) at the 1/16th pole. During film review the stewards felt Velazquez was careless in this race and put rival #6 RIVER PIRATE close to heel clipping stage. Apprentice Velazquez agreed with the stewards' assessment of this race in that it was a sub-par ride. In a unanimous decision the stewards issued the following ruling:

Apprentice Jockey **JESUS VELAZQUEZ**, who rode **TIKIS MOMENT** in the first race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on Thursday, July 28, 2011, is suspended three (3) racing days (August 5, 6 and 7, 2011) for altering course without sufficient clearance; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The terms of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

07-29-11² **LUIS LIRA FILM REVIEW** (Refer 07-28-11²)

Jockey Luis Lira appeared in the stewards' office with his interpreter, veterinarian assistant Pedro Martinez. Jockey Lira rode third place finisher #6 SEPARATE FANTASIES in the second race yesterday (350 yards). #8 BARBARO EL TEXANO (April Boag) was forced off his straight course in this race by #6 SEPARATE FANTASIES who drifted out in the final one hundred fifty (150) yards of this race. Jockey Lira is coming off a three (3) day suspension earlier this month at the California State Fair. (Ref: CSF Ruling #1) He was told he must have his mounts run a straighter course. The majority of stewards voted to issue a warning in this matter (Baker dissented – 5 day suspension).

07-29-11³ **INQUIRY / OBJECTION – Second Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after the running of the second race. Also jockey David Essman (#4 OFRANK, 2nd) lodged an objection against first place finisher #1 CRUISING BY (Barrington Harvey). At the ¼ pole #4 OFRANK has #1 CRUISING BY held in to his inside. Approaching the 1/16th pole race leader #3 LA JEST A FLASH (Chris Russell) drifts out slightly. #1 CRUISING BY then proceeds to angle outward and there was a length margin between these two horses at the finish line. The stewards spoke with both jockeys Essman and Harvey before reaching a decision. The majority of the stewards felt this incident did not warrant a disqualification. Steward Meyers dissented. Jockey Barrington Harvey was ordered to film review.

07-29-11⁴ **LETTER OF EXPLANATION** (Refer 07-08-11⁶)

Attached to this week's minutes is a letter of explanation concerning a tote problem that took place on July 8, 2011 at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton). This letter was provided by Tom Kelso who is a Field Service Manager for Sportech (Tote Company).

07-29-11⁵ **INQUIRY – Seventh Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign immediately following this race after #7 BAKER'S BEACH (Inoel Beato) broke very tardily as she was at least twenty (20) lengths behind the entire field. Race replays show #7 BAKER'S BEACH rears just as starter Todd Stephens dispatched the field. The horse then turns its head sideways losing any chance in this race. The stewards spoke with starter Stephens and discussed CHR rule 1696 (The Start) which allows stewards the option of declaring a horse a non-starter.

The stewards unanimously determined BAKER'S BEACH caused her own problems and voted to declare her a 'starter'. No change.

Van Driver Don Lockwood visited the stewards today. Mr. Lockwood told the stewards he has had problems recently with competition from people hauling horses who are not properly licensed with the California Horse Racing Board as vendors. Safety Steward Paul Nicolo was contacted and will assist in monitoring alleged violations of this sort. Making sure that arrival/departure slips are properly filled out at all California racetracks will assist officials make sure things are done properly.

07-30-11² **BARRINGTON HARVEY FILM REVIEW** (Refer 07-29-11³)

Jockey Barrington Harvey appeared in the stewards' office to view his ride aboard #1 CRUISING BY in yesterday's first race. Jockey Harvey was involved in a stewards' inquiry yesterday, July 29th. Jockey Harvey was 'locked in' behind the leader #3 LA JEST A FLASH (Chris Russell) in mid-stretch. Jockey Harvey then forces his way out making contact with second place finisher, #4 OFRANK (David Essman). Jockey Essman also lodged an objection in this race.

The stewards told jockey Harvey this was a sub-par ride. The stewards unanimously voted to issue jockey Harvey a warning and told him they would be memorialized in these minutes.

07-30-11³ **HECTOR ROMERO VISIT** (Refer 07-27-11²)

Hector Romero visited the stewards' office shortly after noon today. Jockey Romero is currently suspended for non-compliance of his conditional jockey license. The stewards also spoke with Armando Calero from the Winners Foundation who met with Hector Romero earlier this morning at Golden Gate Fields. More to follow.

07-30-11⁴ **INQUIRY – Second Race – DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign immediately following the running of the second race. #6 COLT FURY FIVE (Juan E. Sanchez) clipped heels at the start unseating jockey Juan E. Sanchez. Race replays show fourth placing finisher, #7 PROUDD PRUF (Barrington Harvey) breaks in sharply, laying into the body of #6 COLT FURY FIVE. At the point of contact #6 COLT FURY FIVE clips heels and falls. In a unanimous decision #7 PROUDD PRUF was disqualified and placed unplaced. Jockey Barrington Harvey was ordered to film review.

07-30-11⁵ **INQUIRY – Sixth Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the running of this one mile turf race

after viewing two (2) incidents in the stretch. In the first incident fourth place finisher #8 HARD HEARTED LADY (Aaron Gryder) drifts out and bumps second place finisher #3 INTRIGUING VISION (Juan Hernandez). In the second incident fifth place finisher #10 COLLATING LADY (Kevin Krigger) drifts out approaching the finish line making contact with fourth place finisher #8 HARD HEARTED LADY. Both of the horses that were interfered with in this race beat their rivals.

In a unanimous decision, no change was made in the order of finish. Jockey Aaron Gryder was ordered to film review with the stewards.

07-31-11¹ **HECTOR ROMERO** (Refer 07-30-11³)

Jockey Hector Romero faxed the stewards a document today listing AA (Alcoholic Anonymous) meetings he has attended this week. The stewards contacted Armando Calero (Winners Foundation) and then called California Horse Racing Board Executive Director Kirk Breed. Jockey Romero's eligibility to ride has now been restored.

07-31-11² **AARON GRYDER FILM REVIEW** (Refer 07-30-11⁵)

Jockey Aaron Gryder appeared in the stewards' office to review his ride in yesterday's (July 30) sixth race. Jockey Gryder was aboard fourth place finisher #8 HARD HEARTED LADY who was involved in an incident at the 1/8th pole. As jockey Gryder reaches up to urge his horse left handed, his mount shifts quickly to the outside bumping #3 INTRIGUING VISION (Juan Hernandez). Race replays show jockey Gryder straightens his horse as soon as possible. The stewards did not feel the actions of Gryder warranted a penalty.

07-31-11³ **BARRINGTON HARVEY FILM REVIEW** (Refer 07-30-11⁴)

Jockey Barrington Harvey showed up in the stewards' office at 12:25 p.m. for film review of his ride aboard #7 PROUDD PRUF (Barrington Harvey) who finished fourth in yesterday's (July 30) second race. Film review shows #7 PROUDD PRUF breaks into the path of #6 COLT FURY LIVE (Juan E. Sanchez) causing that rival to clip heels and fall. The stewards felt jockey Harvey could have done a better job averting this accident. Jockey Harvey disagreed

stating he did not think he was to blame for this incident. This hearing was held just before the stewards' afternoon duties (12:30 p.m.). A decision of this hearing will be documented in next week's stewards' minutes. Decision to follow.

07-31-11⁴ **INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign immediately following the running of the three hundred fifty (350) yard quarter horse race. Race replays show first place finisher #3 FT SPECIAL CARTEL (Luis Langarica) breaks alertly before starting to direct out fifty (50) yards after the start. This horse was whipped continuously by jockey Langarica and continued to drift out to the far outside of the racetrack. Fourth place finisher #5 BF HEAD GAME (Luis Lira) steadied forty (40) yards before the finish line when his path was taken by #3 FT SPECIAL CARTEL. In a unanimous vote #3 FT SPECIAL CARTEL was disqualified and placed fourth. Jockey Luis Langarica was ordered to film review with the stewards.

07-31-11⁵ **JOCKEY OBJECTION – Fourth Race – NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the sixth race jockey Chris Russell, who finished sixth aboard #3 PIMIENTO NEGRO lodged an objection against second place finisher #8 BEERTALK (Catalino Martinez) who finished second in this race. Film review shows a 'bad formation' of several horses entering the 3/8th (far) turn. At the 3/8th #3 PIMIENTO NEGRO and jockey Chris Russell 'steady' due to lacking of racing room. After speaking with both riders involved the stewards voted unanimously to disallow this jockey claim of foul. No Change.
