#### **RAMIREZ RULING**

##### RULING NO.01

Jockey MARCIAL RAMIREZ who was scheduled to ride "LORETTA JONES" in the second race on July 20, 2014 at the California State Fair (Sacramento) is hereby fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The above ruling was issued after Ramirez appeared with friend and interpreter Edgar Pulido to explain missing a mount last Sunday on the mule "LORETTA JONES." Ramirez said the person giving him a ride got lost on the way to the State Fair. The Stewards received no phone call and today was our first contact with Mr. Ramirez. Unfortunately, no other rider was available and "LORETTA JONES" had to be scratched.

#### **ALVARADO RULING**

##### RULING NO.02

Jockey FRANK ALVARADO who rode "SOFT SHOULDERS" in the eighth race at the California State Fair (Sacramento) on July 20, 2014 is suspended three (3) racing days (August 1, 2 & 3, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course at the start and causing interference resulting in a disqualification from eighth to ninth place. A violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

The above ruling was issued after Alvarado appeared and reviewed the start of last Sunday's 8<sup>th</sup> race at Cal-Expo. Alvarado's mount comes in shortly after the start and causes #1 "DD DANCER" (jockey- Cristobal Herrera) to clip heels and stumble almost unseating the rider.

#### **RICARDO GONZALEZ WARNING**

Jockey Ricardo Gonzalez reviewed the stretch run of last Sunday's final (10<sup>th</sup>) race of the meet. Gonzalez rode #6 "CONUNDRUM PASS" and drifted a little in the stretch causing slight inconvenience to a rival. A warning was issued.

7-25-14<sup>5</sup>

#### **TRAFFIC HEAVY – HORSES LATE FOR LASIX – LATE DECLARATION – 3<sup>RD</sup> RACE**

Two horses scheduled to race in today's third race were on the same van from Golden Gate Fields. #2 "LITTLE JACK" (Tr. Tim McCanna) and #4 "CALIFO CAT" (Tr. Armando Lage) were scheduled to receive Lasix treatment by 12:15pm. The van arrived late and practicing Veterinarian Kim Kuhlman treated the horses immediately to try and save them from being scratched. Unfortunately the treatment took place at 12:46pm which is 31 minutes late. Both horses were subsequently scratched after consultation with California Horse Racing Board Veterinarian Don

Dooley and talking to both trainers involved resulting in a three horse field. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1954 (Parimutuel Pools) place and show wagering were cancelled.

**McCANNA & LAGE RULINGS (ref. 7/25/14<sup>5</sup>)**

**RULING NO.03**

Trainer **TIM McCANNA** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration), for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (e) (Authorized Bleeder Medication – Failure to Treat in Timely Manner), necessitating the late declaration of LITTLE JACK from the third race on July 25, 2014.

**RULING NO.04**

Trainer **ARMANDO LAGE** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration), for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (e) (Authorized Bleeder Medication – Failure to Treat in Timely Manner), necessitating the late declaration of CALIFO CAT from the third race on July 25, 2014.

The above rulings were issued when both horses arrived late. Both trainers were cautioned to make better arrangements with transportation.

**JOE BROOK HEARING (CASE 14GG0036)**

A hearing was conducted today concerning a urine sample taken from the horse "CONDIMENT" which ran in the second race on March 23, 2014 at Golden Gate Fields.

The Brook trainee reportedly had Carbazochrome in its post race test according to University of California Davis Laboratories.

Testimony confirmed that "CONDIMENT" had received a treatment of "Kentucky Red" which contains Carbazochrome from Veterinarian Kim Kuhlmann on March 21<sup>st</sup> some 54 hours before post time. Although it is doubtful this treatment could cause the positive test, no other evidence or testimony was presented which would account for the test results.

### **AYALA FITNESS HEARING**

A hearing was conducted today to review the possibility of restoring Anthony Ayala to good standing.

Mr. Ayala is a jockey by trade and has been suspended more than once for drug violations.

The hearing was conducted for Ayala to present evidence to show conformance with Pacific Racing Association ruling #16 which reads in part "It is recommended that Anthony M. Ayala not be re-licensed until a fitness hearing determines he has completed a substance abuse program acceptable to the Board of Stewards and he demonstrates a history of sobriety and abstention of drugs."

Present at the hearing were Ayala on his own behalf, Investigator D.A. Tadlock presenting and the Board of Stewards. Christine Niccoli, Certified Court Reporter recorded the proceedings. Nora Lee from Winners Foundation also testified.

Ayala presented a document showing completion of a substance abuse program at Terros, Inc. in Phoenix. Arizona. The document was verified by Bob Fletcher of Winners Foundation through Nora Lee.

Investigator Tadlock presented evidence that Mr. Ayala submitted to a urine test that was presumptive negative in the field test.

During the hearing, results from Quest Diagnostics Laboratory were received which confirmed the presence of Methamphetamine in the aforementioned sample. The sample was obtained on March 23, 2014.

Mr. Ayala denied use and is requesting a split sample. More to follow.

### **PREFERENCE DATE SYSTEM**

A meeting was held with Racing Secretary Bob Moreno, Thoroughbred Owners of California representative Richard Scheidt and California Thoroughbred Trainers representative Charles Dougherty concerning the way the preference date system has been handled.

Mr. Moreno has implemented a policy that all horses had equal dates starting the first day of entries for this meet if the foal certificates were in the office. Mr. Moreno's condition book states "All horses whose foal certificates are registered with the Racing Secretary on the first day of entries for the Alameda County Fair, will receive an entry date for that day."

The condition book wording will be adhered to from today on. Notice will be put on the overnight.

### **2<sup>ND</sup> RACE – JOCKEY UNSEATED AFTER WIRE (MULES)**

#6 "IMA FAST KID" bucked and unseated jockey Luis Godoy after finishing 4<sup>th</sup> in this 350 yard mule event. An accident report is attached to the minutes.

**3<sup>RD</sup> RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION**

The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident involving #5 "GRAY ELIXIR" (jockey – Catalino Martinez) who finished second and #7 "VODKATARIAT" (jockey- Juan Hernandez) who finished fourth beaten a nose for third.

After talking to the riders and reviewing tapes #5 was unanimously disqualified and placed 4<sup>th</sup> for interference. #5 comes out under left handed urging, bumping and impeding #7 at the top of the stretch.

The groom had told Stauffer he gave the contents to the horse before leaving Golden Gate Fields this morning. Kasmerski was contacted and the horse was scratched. More to follow.

**FAIR DIRECTOR AND FRIENDS VISIT**

Fair Director Teejay Lowe came to visit the Stewards and show a few friends the view and our operating procedure.

7-26-14<sup>9</sup>

**7<sup>th</sup> RACE INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the stretch run of this one mile turf race when the jockey on #3 "MAHOGANY RUN," Hugo Herrera, took up slightly between horses in deep stretch finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>. The winner #1 "RUSH IN" (Jockey – Russell Baze) was on the inside and #9 "AMP AND ADRENALINE" (Jockey – Frank Alvarado) (2<sup>nd</sup>) was on the outside of #3. After review and talking to the riders no change was ordered in an unanimous vote. Tapes show that room existed at all times for #3 who appeared reluctant to go through the hole. Note: Trainer Melanie McDonald had also called, wishing the judges to review the reason behind #3 taking up briefly in the stretch.

**8<sup>th</sup> RACE – INQUIRY – HORSE INJURY**

The inquiry sign was posted when #3 "ROCARBAR" (jockey- Alejandro Gomez) went wrong near the 1/2 mile pole. Jockey Alejandro Gomez was unseated at that point and #3 continued to the 1/4 pole. After review it was determined no other horses were involved. No change. An accident report is attached.

Rule #1843 (a) and (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level (2.5 ug/ml) and prohibited substance: Procaine in excess of permitted level [Class 3]).

### RULING NO.07

Acting on an order of remand dated July 18, 2014 from the California Horse Racing Board, Trainer **ELMER JANUARY**, who started the horse **KNIGHT OUGHT**, fifth place finisher in the third race at the Fresno District Fair on October 12, 2013 is suspended thirty (30) days August 2 thru August 31, 2014 and fined five thousand dollars (\$5000.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of C.H.R.B. Rule #1843 (a) and (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level (2.5ug/ml) and prohibited substance: Procaine in excess of permitted level [Class 3]).

The above rulings were issued to memorialize two penalties forwarded to this Board of Stewards after being approved by the members of the California Horse Racing Board.

### AMANDA LOCKETT WARNED

Owner Amanda Lockett appeared informally with Safety Steward Vic Stauffer and Investigator D.A. Tadlock to address ponies being left unattended in a trailer at Pleasanton for a couple of hours. According to Tadlock, State Veterinarian Don Dooley felt the horses were not in danger since the doors of the trailer were left open and the trailer was parked in the shade. Therefore, no complaint was filed.

Ms. Lockett was questioned and chastised at length by this Board and Safety Steward Stauffer. Ms. Lockett apologized for the length of time she had left the ponies in the trailer.

### MARTINEZ RULING

### RULING NO.08

Jockey **CATALINO MARTINEZ** who rode "GRAY ELIXIR" in the third race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on July 26, 2014 is suspended three (3) racing days (August 3, 6 & 7, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in a disqualification from second to fourth place. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

The above ruling was issued after Martinez appeared and reviewed his ride in the 3<sup>rd</sup> race yesterday. Martinez realized he could have avoided the interference with a better effort to straighten his mount coming into the stretch and accepted the penalty without argument.

### QUARTERHORSE/MULE TIMER

So far at this meet all Quarter horse and mule races have been hand timed. Director of Racing Richard Lewis has had the electrician chasing the problem with the automatic timer on a daily basis. The source of the problem has yet to be reported or fixed.

The inquiry sign was posted to review the actions of heavy favorite #1 "NIVOURS ROMANCE" (jockey- Hugo Herrera) (1<sup>st</sup>) in the stretch drive. #4 "AIMEE OAKLEY" (jockey – Pedro Flores) (4<sup>th</sup>) appears to be carried out throughout the stretch drive. After review and talking to the riders #1 was disqualified from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> for interference to #4. Tapes show #1 race wide forcing #4 out throughout the stretch drive. The decision to qualify was unanimous.

7-27-14<sup>6</sup> **JOCKEY CHANGE – OVERWEIGHT – 6<sup>th</sup> RACE**

Trainer Monty Meier requested a jockey change when he was made aware his named rider Carlos Silva could not get close to the 115lb weight assigned to his filly "TIZ PARTNERS" in the Luther Burbank Handicap. Agents and jockeys were included in a mutual decision to allow a change to Jockey Ricky Gonzalez in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1683 (Maximum Overweight).
