**Friday**08-17-12<sup>1</sup>**CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$8,700. For California bred or California sired three year olds and upward, claiming price \$4,000 at one mile. The race was called off with two entries.

08-17-12<sup>2</sup>**RULING NO. 12 – SANCHEZ**

Apprentice Jockey **JUAN E. SANCHEZ**, who rode **PLATINUM RULES** in the fourth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on Sunday, August 12, 2012, is suspended seven (7) racing days (August 26, 31, September 1, 2, 3, 5 and 7, 2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fifth to seventh; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Sanchez met with the stewards, reviewed the race and acknowledged guilt. A seven day suspension was issued due to Mr. Sanchez receiving two prior suspension rulings during the Santa Rosa meeting.

08-19-12<sup>2</sup>**JOCKEY CRISTOBAL HERRERA FILM REVIEW** (8<sup>th</sup> race – 08/18/12)

Mr. Herrera accompanied by trainer Rene Amescua, who acted as his interpreter, reviewed the eighth race from yesterday's races. Mr. Herrera pulled his mount, #9 BIG ROCK CANDI, up while racing in last place near the  $\frac{3}{4}$  pole.

Mr. Herrera was invited in to review the race, give his analysis and explanation for his actions.

Mr. Herrera's explanation that the horse was showing signs of repeating its actions of bolting as it had done in its only other start, although not apparent on the film, was accepted with a warning being issued. Mr. Herrera was told not to place himself in situations such as this in the future by not accepting mounts that he has concerns for his safety or the safety of the horse.
