11-22-12² **FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice **Juan Sanchez** appeared to review last Sunday's second race where he put pressure on a rival racing along the rail at the 5/8. Sanchez was admonished to keep his mounts straight.

Jockey **Kyle Frey** viewed the tapes of Sunday's seventh race in which his mount was the subject of a jockey objection. Kyle's mount stepped in going into the clubhouse turn and a horse to the rear bore out around the turn. Frey contributed slightly to the incident but it was apparent that the other horse was not going to navigate the turn in any event.

11-22-12³ **RULING NO. 18 – AYALA** (Refer 11-16-12³ & 10-28-12⁴)

Jockey **ANTHONY M. AYALA** is hereby suspended one hundred and twenty (120) days, November 23, 2012 through March 22, 2013 and placed on probation through the term of his license (3-31-2014) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Use of marijuana and cocaine) and #1890 (Possession of Contraband – marijuana, needles and syringes).

Prior to reinstatement of his license privileges Mr. Ayala must sign a test agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, submit to an evaluation with the Winners Foundation and provide a clean test sample.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ANTHONY M. AYALA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued following last Friday's formal hearing. Evidence and testimony indicated that Ayala tested positive for cocaine and marijuana on two occasions and that needles and syringes were confiscated from his trailer on the grounds of the Big Fresno Fair along with approximately one pound of marijuana.

11-22-12⁴ **JOCKEY OBJECTION – First Race – NO CHANGE**

Jockey **Angel Sanchez**, aboard the place horse #1 FINEST ANGEL, lodged a claim of foul against the winner, #3 WRINKLE ROOM, ridden by Kerwin John. After a thorough review the stewards dismissed the claim of foul. Tapes showed that WRINKLE ROOM drifted in slightly as she was passing FINEST ANGEL but the incident was minor and Sanchez' mount was not cost a better placing.

11-23-12² **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Kerwin John** reviewed the tapes of yesterday's first race where his mount was the subject of a jockey objection. John was cautioned to be more diligent in keeping his mounts on a straight course or face possible sanctions if his drifting causes a rival to suffer interference.

11-23-12³ **LATE SCRATCH – First Race – REFUND**

#2 A REAL PIRATE, trained by Ellen Jackson, was scratched on the recommendation of Dr. Sporer as the field neared the starting gate after she reported the horse was off on the right rear. On Vet's list. The refund was \$7,126.80.

11-23-12⁴ **LATE SCRATCH – Fifth Race – REFUND**

#7 RAMONSKY, trained by Armando Pulido, was scratched after Dr. Sporer reported the mare flipped in the gate and injured herself. On Vet's list. The refund amounted to \$8,499.04.

Assistant starter **Victor Ordonez**, trying to get RAMONSKY out of the gate, was ejected from the front of the stall and received a bruise above his left knee. He was attended to by the ambulance crew at the gate which resulted in a ten minute delay.
