After considering the patrol judges' report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video of the race, the stewards made the original order of finish official.

The video shows #3 MINNEWAWA moves out, bumps #4 CANALASSO near the ½ mile pole, then the latter returns the favor.

12-08-12<sup>3</sup> **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Alejandro Gomez met with the Board of Stewards regarding his ride in the second race on December 7, 2012.

Mr. Gomez was chastised for not controlling his mount leaving the starting gate.

By majority decision Mr. Gomez was issued a warning. Steward Nevin was of the opinion a suspension was warranted.

12-08-12<sup>4</sup> **FILLY PULLED UP – Fifth Race**

#9 MY NETANYA (Inoel Beato) went wrong near the 3/8 pole and was pulled up by jockey Beato.

Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer reported the three year old filly suffered a soft tissue injury to the left foreleg and was given a ride home in the horse ambulance.

12-08-12<sup>5</sup> **INQUIRY / OBJECTION – DISQUALIFICATION – Sixth Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the sixth race for a review of the stretch run. Also, jockey Dennis Carr (#7 - DO WHAT U DARE) fifth, lodged a claim of foul against #10 LUKE'S LEGACY (Kerwin John) third, alleging interference in the stretch.

After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #10 LUKE'S LEGACY from third to fifth, for drifting in under a right handed whip and taking the path of #7 DO WHAT U DARE, forcing the latter to take up, lose ground and the opportunity of a better placing.

12-09-12<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 24 – JOHN**

Jockey **KERWIN JOHN**, who rode **LUKE'S LEGACY** in the sixth race on Saturday, December 8, 2012 at Golden Gate Fields is suspended three (3) racing days (December 16, 26, and 28, 2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from third to fifth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. John and the stewards reviewed the video of the sixth race from December 8, 2012.

Mr. John acknowledged he erred by allowing his mount to drift in under right handed whipping, but stated he was unaware he was impeding another horse.

12-09-12<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 25 – PERRY**

In the matter of:  
 Owner **SUSAN PERRY**

Unlicensed owner SUSAN PERRY having made arrangements to satisfy all outstanding final obligations to Hobson’s Saddlery, Gordon Feed Company, Noceti Farms and Alvin Bresciani is deemed eligible for re-licensing and LAQL ruling #10, dated January 17, 2003, suspending Ms. Perry for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is hereby set aside.

The above ruling was issued by majority decision as Ms. Perry provided documentation that she signed agreements with Hobson’s Saddlery, Gordon Feed Company, Noceti Farms and Alvin Bresciani to satisfy her outstanding debts. Steward Nevin dissented, believing Ms. Perry should have appeared for a hearing or paid off these debts that go back to 2003.
