**Wednesday**

1-9-13<sup>1</sup> **ENTRIES AND DECLARATIONS**

Steward John Herbuveaux was in attendance today for declarations for Thursday, January 10<sup>th</sup> and entries for Saturday, January 12<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Herbuveaux will continue with those duties for the remainder of the week.

1-10-13<sup>1</sup> **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$13,000. For California bred or California sired fillies and mares four years old and upward, claiming \$10,000 at one mile. The race was called off with no entries.

1-10-13<sup>2</sup> **JOCKEYS FILM REVIEW**

Jockeys Dennis Carr and Inoel Beato were invited in to review the stretch run of Sunday's 8<sup>th</sup> race. Both riders were involved in an inquiry where they let their mounts drift into each other. After reviewing the race both riders were warned to make better efforts to maintain a straight course. Mr. Carr was also instructed to lodge a claim of foul if he feels his mount was fouled and not request a hold be placed on the race.

1-10-13<sup>4</sup> **JOCKEY OBJECTION – 4<sup>th</sup> Race**

Following the running of the fourth race jockey Eric Camacho, rider of the fourth place finisher #1 WHATS UP, lodged a claim of foul against 2<sup>nd</sup> place finisher #3 REIGNING RUBIES (Jockey Pedro Terrero) for alleged interference near the 1/8<sup>th</sup> pole.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views the numbers posted were made official.

The recordings show #1 WHATS UP contribute to the contact after drifting out and initiating contact with that rival.

1-10-13<sup>5</sup> **RULING NO. 08**

Jockey **RONALD RICHARD**, is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)\* for failure to ride MAGIC MIMSY in the sixth race on Friday, January 4, 2013; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Richard met with the stewards and failed to offer a valid reason for failing to fulfill his riding commitment.

1-11-13<sup>1</sup> **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse 9,000. For California bred or California sired maidens, fillies and mares four years old and upward. Claiming \$12,500 at one mile and one sixteenth. The race was called off with six entries.

1-11-13<sup>3</sup> **INQUIRY – 4<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The inquiry sign was posted following the running of the fourth race for a review of an incident on the 7/8s turn involving #1 SLIM PICKENS (4<sup>th</sup> place- jockey Kyle Frey), #4 SANDOR (5<sup>th</sup> place- jockey Pedro Flores) and #6 DUKE OF DOOM (2<sup>nd</sup> place- jockey

Russell Baze). After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views the numbers posted were declared official.

The recordings show the rider of #4 (Pedro Flores) check his mount while racing near the rear of the field and in tight quarters between #1 and #6. A factor that added to

the incident was slow early fractions with both horses #1 and #4 under tight restraints while being rank to place.

#4 was well beaten for a better placing and in the stewards opinion its placing was not affected. Therefore, no changes in placings were made. The decision was unanimous.

1-11-13<sup>4</sup>**5<sup>th</sup> Race – INQUIRY**

Following the running of the 5<sup>th</sup> race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of observed contact between the winner #1 CEES THE BET (jockey Alejandro Gomez) and #3 AERIAL MARK (3<sup>rd</sup> place – jockey Francisco Duran).

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recordings of the incident, no change was made to the order of finish as the recordings show both horses drifted off their paths and contributed to the contact.

1-12-13<sup>3</sup>**INQUIRY 4<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The inquiry sign was posted following the running of the 4<sup>th</sup> race for a review of two separate incidents. The first area of review was the start involving #4 WILDCAT MOON (2<sup>nd</sup> place- Kyle Frey), #3 ZEEWAT (1<sup>st</sup> place- jockey Russell Baze) and #2 CONDIMENT (6<sup>th</sup> place- jockey Julien Couton).

The second area reviewed also involved #3 ZEEWAT and #4 WILDCAT MOON with the addition of #5 TREE OF LIFE (3<sup>rd</sup> place- jockey Dennis Carr) at the head of the stretch.

Jockey Dennis Carr also lodged a claim of foul against #3 ZEEWAT and #4 WILDCAT MOON for alleged interference at that location.

After a thorough review the numbers posted were declared official.

The first incident: At the start, the recordings show #4 WILDCAT MOON break in sharply and make light contact with #2 CONDIMENT. #3 ZEEWAT was slow to start and was not affected.

As to the incident at the head of the stretch the recordings show the rider of #5 TREE OF LIFE steady momentarily after being out run for position.

In the unanimous opinion of the stewards neither incident rose to the level of affecting the placing of either horse.

1-12-13<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY 8<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The inquiry sign was lit once again following the running of the 8<sup>th</sup> race for a review of the actions of #4 TOSS THE DICE (6<sup>th</sup> place – jockey Kyle Frey) near the half mile marker. After reviewing all of the recordings of the incident the race was made official. The recordings show #4 TOSS THE DICE cause its own problems when it raced erratic down the backstretch and stumbled after shifting out onto the heels of #5 RED CREME.

Purse 20,000. For California bred or California sired fillies three years old, claiming \$20,000 at six furlongs. There were only two entries received and was called off.

1-13-13<sup>2</sup> **FILM REVIEW – JOCKEY'S KYLE FREY AND CHRISTIAN SANTIAGO REYES**

After reviewing the start of the fourth race jockey Kyle Frey was complimented on his timely efforts to try and straighten his mount after it broke sharply to the left at the start.

A warning was issued to Mr. Reyes to stay down on his mounts and continue to ride them to the finish. In yesterday's 6<sup>th</sup> race Mr. Reyes stood up well before the finish. Although in this instance his mount was not cost a placing, he was cautioned about the pitfalls of letting up on mounts prior to the finish. He was informed that if he fails to ride his mounts to the wire and gets beat for a placing a fine or days could be issued.

1-13-13<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 09 – DUSTIN ZIEROLD**

Owner DUSTIN ZIEROLD, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Friday, January 12, 2013, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance for a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of DUSTIN ZIEROLD are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Zierold failed to appear to address allegations of convictions of brandishing a firearm and discharged with willful neglect in Solano County Superior Court.

1-13-13<sup>5</sup>**RULING NO. 10 – PETER MILLER**

Trainer PETER MILLER is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)\* pursuant to CHRB rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of CHRB rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run) necessitating a late declaration for the horse McAllister Boys in the fourth race on Friday, January 11, 2013.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Miller was contacted, waived his rights to a hearing and accepted part of the blame. He was of the opinion part of the blame should be placed on his veterinarian for not filing a scratch card for the horse.

1-13-13<sup>6</sup>**INQUIRY- 1<sup>st</sup> RACE – NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the first race the inquiry sign was lit for a review of the finish involving #4 ELAINA'S PAPOU (1<sup>st</sup> place – jockey Dennis Carr) and #3 MISS RIVERA (3<sup>rd</sup> place – jockey Christian Santiago Reyes).

After reviewing the finish of the race and talking with the riders involved no change was made to the order of finish.

The recording shows the rider of #3 MISS RIVERA rise up in the saddle after that rival crossed over. Mr. Reyes stated the winner did not interfere with his horse when it crossed over. The decision was unanimous.

1-13-13<sup>7</sup>**INQUIRY – 7<sup>th</sup> RACE – DISQUALIFICATION**

The inquiry sign was posted once again after the running of the 7<sup>th</sup> race for a review of the stretch run of #9 LOOKN WILD (1<sup>st</sup> place – jockey Navin Mangalee) and #3 HE'S SO STYLISH (2<sup>nd</sup> place – jockey Russell Baze). Mr. Baze also lodged an objection against the winner for interference through the stretch.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the stretch run #9 LOOKN WILD was disqualified from 1<sup>st</sup> and placed 2<sup>nd</sup>.

The recordings show #9 LOOKN WILD drift out continually through the stretch forcing #3 HE'S SO STYLISH out off its path costing #3 HE'S SO STYLISH the opportunity of a better placing. The decision was unanimous.
