8-17-13<sup>3</sup>**STEWARDS MEET WITH JOCKEYS**

The Stewards met with the riders today to go over our expectations and guidelines for the meet. The meeting also afforded the opportunity to discuss any issues or concerns that the riders may have regarding issues that possibly arose over the summer.

8-17-13<sup>4</sup>**INQUIRY – 9<sup>th</sup> RACE – NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the ninth race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of observed interference near the three sixteenth marker between #2 INDIAN MONKEY (5<sup>th</sup> place – Jockey C.A. Ordaz) and #4 FRENCH CHOCOLATE (4<sup>th</sup> place – Jockey Kerwin John).

After reviewing all the recorded views the numbers posted were made official. The recordings show #2 drift out and make contact with #4 which tipped the rear end of #2 inward causing #2 to shift out further and add to the contact. There was no need for any change in the placings as #4 finished in front of #2.

8-18-13<sup>3</sup>**RACE REVIEW – JOCKEY C.A. ORDAZ**

Jockey C.A. Ordaz, accompanied by Jockey Eswan Flores who interpreted for Mr. Ordaz, reviewed yesterday's ninth race with the Stewards. After listening to his analysis of the incident and reviewing the recordings a warning was issued.

8-28-13<sup>4</sup>**INQUIRY – 6<sup>th</sup> RACE – NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the sixth race the inquiry sign was lit for a review of observed interference with the winner #8 TIZ PARTNERS (Jockey – Marcia Stortz) and #2 PAREAU (6<sup>th</sup> place – Jockey Juan Hernandez) near the sixteenth pole marker. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views the numbers posted were made official.

The recordings show #8 TIZ PARTNERS drift toward the inside rail and into the path of #2 PAREAU who was dropping back, while tiring, and caused the rider of #2 to check briefly to avoid heels.

It was the unanimous opinion of the Stewards the placing of #2 was not affected. Therefore, no change was made.
