**EATON RULING**

**#20**

Trainer **TERRI EATON**, who started the horse **MYSTIC MAY**, ninth place finisher in the tenth race at the Big Fresno Fair on October 11, 2013, is fined the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone – in excess of permitted level 3.0 ug/ml [Class 4]).

The above ruling was released following last week's informal hearing. Eaton stated that her horse was stressed prior to the race which, in her opinion, was the reason the horse didn't metabolize the medication properly. While her theory may hold merit in some quarters the Stewards could not use it to absolve her from culpability for a high reading.

02-01-14<sup>2</sup>**STEWARDS INQUIRY – FIRST RACE – NO CHANGE**

The Stewards lit the inquiry lamp to examine contact between the first two finishers at the top of the stretch. After a thorough review the Stewards affirmed the original order of finish. Tapes showed that the place horse, #2 FRENCH TART, ridden by Leslie Mawing bumped the hind quarters of the winner, #1 AFSANA, with Frank Alvarado in the irons, as the two came out of the far turn and entered the stretch.

Mawing attempted to make room between the two leaders where no room existed and bumped Alvarado's horse. AFSANA went on to win the race in spite of the contact so no placings were affected but Mawing will review the tapes of the race with the Stewards in the morning to explain his actions.

02-02-14<sup>2</sup>**FILM REVIEW – RULING NO.21**

Jockey Leslie Mawing appeared to review his ride in yesterday's first race. Mawing stated there was enough room between the two leaders when he started to move. The Stewards could not verify Mawing's contention by viewing the race tapes. What was observable however was that Mawing interfered with a rival at the top of the stretch and the following ruling was issued:

**NO.21**

Jockey **LESLIE MAWING** who rode **FRENCH TART** in the first race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, February 1, 2014 is suspended five (5) racing days (February 9, 13, 14, 15 and 16, 2014) for causing interference entering the stretch; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules - Careless Riding).

#1 GOOD COMPANY, trained by Armando Lage was scratched by the Stewards on the recommendation of Dr. Sporer as the horses approached the starting gate when she observed the horse was off on the left front. On Vet's List. The refund totaled \$39,289.41.
