Owner/Trainer **RICHARD DEAN GREENMAN** having failed to abide by the terms of a signed payment agreement is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) pending satisfaction of an outstanding financial obligation to San Francisco Equine in the amount of \$2597.92.

The above ruling was issued after the Stewards received written notification from San Francisco Equine that Greenman has fallen two months in arrears on the agreement he signed back in November of last year. The Stewards have attempted to contact Greenman over the last two weeks to no avail.

The above rulings were issued after the Stewards received written notification from the Winners Foundation that Garnica and Lopez failed to live up to the terms of their contract with that organization. Should one or both come back into compliance we will restore their license privileges.

10-31-14²**CLAIM VOIDED**

A claim deposited by trainer Joe Steiner for the horse RULED BY KISSES in today's first race was voided by the Stewards after Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin placed the horse on the vet's list for being unsound in the right front. The horse was returned to the barn of Jerry Hollendorfer.

10-31-14³**OBJECTION – SIXTH RACE – NO CHANGE**

Severino The Stewards illuminated the objection sign at the request of jockey Maicol (6th, MINNALOUSHE) who claimed foul against the place horse, #3 BLACK MISCHIEF ridden by Juan Sanchez. Severino alleged interference near the 1/8. After a thorough review the Stewards disallowed the claim of foul.

Tapes showed MINNALOUSHE was racing behind and between BLACK MISCHIEF on the outside and #8 JENNY'S V (3rd Hugo Herrera) on the inside as the field approached the 1/8. JENNY'S V drifted out slightly and Severino steadied slightly but the incident was minor and did not cost MINNALOUSHE a better placing. BLACK MISCHIEF maintained a straight course through the lane and was held blameless. Jockey Herrera will review tapes of the race with the Stewards in the morning.

Saturday11-01-14¹**RAYMOND RULING****NO.11**

Trainer **DALE T. RAYMOND** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for failure to have the horse **SIDEPOCKET LOU** treated with lasix in a timely fashion necessitating a late scratch in the first race on Thursday, October 30, 2014; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Raymond contacted the Stewards and Explained that he got a late start leaving the grounds at Pleasanton and hit traffic on the way here making him arrive after the four hour deadline for Lasix had elapsed.

Sunday11-02-14¹ **LATE SCRATCH – EIGHTH RACE – REFUND**

#9 OUT OF THE SUN, trained by Rene Amescua, was scratched on the recommendation of track veterinarian Sarah Sporer, D.V.M. after the horse flipped in the starting gate and was injured. On Vet's List. The refund amounted to \$12,219.04.

11-02-14² **STEWARDS INQUIRY – EIGHTH RACE – NO CHANGE**

The Stewards lit the inquiry lamp to evaluate the stretch run of #8 PERCY FAWCETT (5th – Cristobal Herrera) after that horse clipped heels near the 1/8. After a thorough review the Stewards affirmed the order of finish as posted on the tote board.

Tapes showed that Herrera allowed his mount to run up on the heels of #5 RACE-TRACKRUMMY (6th - Isaias Enriquez) near the 1/8. Herrera steered PERCY FAWCETT to the outside for racing room. In doing so PERCY FAWCETT clipped the heels of RACETRACKRUMMY and then continued outward to make contact with #4 COUGAR COUNTRY (3rd – Russell Baze). Since COUGAR COUNTRY outfinished RACETRACKRUMMY there was no need for a disqualification. The Stewards also determined that RACETRACKRUMMY was unaffected by the incident even though he finished behind PERCY FAWCETT. Herrera will view the tapes of the race with the Stewards on the next race day.
