Having satisfied the outstanding financial obligation to San Francisco Equine the license privileges of Owner/Trainer Richard Dean Greenman are restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association ruling #8 dated October 30, 2014 suspending Mr. Greenman for violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) is hereby set aside.

The ruling listed above was issued after this Board received notification from San Francisco Equine that the debt owed by Mr. Greenman was paid in full.

11-07-14<sup>4</sup>**TERRY MARK JOHNSON HEARING**

A transcribed hearing was held today to address California Horse Racing Board complaint 14GG0094 filed against Terry Mark Johnson for alleged violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a), (b) and (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1843.1 a (Prohibited Drug Substances) and 1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). Mr. Johnson was cited after his horse "GIANNONATTI," who ran in the 8<sup>th</sup> race on August 23, 2014 at Golden Gate Fields, tested positive for Gabapentin, a Class III drug.

Present at the hearing, in addition to this Board of Stewards, were Mr. Johnson, Terra Johnson, Charles Dougherty Jr. (California Thoroughbred Trainers Representative) and CHRB Investigator Louis Quezada. Certified Shorthand Reporter Christine Niccoli recorded the hearing.

After receiving sworn testimony and receiving the case related documents the matter was submitted for decision.

11-07-14<sup>5</sup>**VOID CLAIM**

A claim submitted prior to the 5<sup>th</sup> race for #7 MAGIC CHANNEL was voided after the horse was declared unsound by track veterinarian Dr. Sporer during the warm up process. The horse was returned to the Jerry Hollendorfer stable.

11-07-14<sup>6</sup>**OWNER ROGER STEIN CALLS STEWARDS**

Mr. Stein phoned the Stewards this morning and requested an ownership change from him to his nephew Joshua Stein on the horse POCKET PRINCE that is scheduled to race in the 5<sup>th</sup> race today. Mr. Stein's license is currently under suspension. His request was denied and he was informed the horse would have to be scratched. Naturally, Mr. Stein voiced an objection to the horse being scratched.

Having now re-established compliance with the terms of Oak Tree at Pleasanton ruling #16, dated July 6, 2014 the license privileges of groom JULIO CESAR GARNICA are restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association ruling #9 dated October 30, 2014 summarily suspending Mr. Garnica is hereby set aside.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Garnica and Winners Foundation representative Armando Calero met with the Stewards. Mr. Garnica's license was restored to good standing after Mr. Calero reported everyone was on the same page regarding the conditions of the Winner's Foundation contract and that Mr. Garnica was now in compliance.

**DISQUALIFICATION RULING**

NO.14

Acting on a report from the University of California at Davis Maddy Laboratories, the official Laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that the post race urine sample #GG19884 taken from the horse **GIANNONATTI**, third place finisher in the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, August 23, 2014 contained the prohibited substance Gabapentin (Neurotin), it is hereby ordered that **GIANNONATTI** be disqualified from all purse monies earned and deemed unplaced in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$1440.00) earned or awarded to owner Laurie Johnson, trainer Terry Johnson and jockey Pedro Flores be returned to the Paymaster of Purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> – P TOWN BOO
- 4<sup>th</sup> – ZEFINA
- 5<sup>th</sup> – REIGNING RUBIES
- 6<sup>th</sup> – A CLEVER TEN
- 7<sup>th</sup> - DEPUTY MISS

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.

In accordance with CHRB rule #1843.3 (Penalties for Medication Violations) **GIANNONATTI** must pass a Board approved examination pursuant to rule # 1846 (Racing Soundness Examination) and, at the owner's expense, test negative for prohibited drug substances as defined in rule #1843.1 (Prohibited Drug Substances) before becoming eligible to be entered.

**JOCKEY SILVIO AMADOR – RULING NO.15**

Jockey **SILVIO AMADOR** is fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00)\* for reporting to the jockey's room late on Friday, November 7, 2014; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Amador met with the Stewards and provided a feeble excuse for failing to report on time.

**VOID CLAIM**

A claim submitted in the seventh race for #3 TIME TO GLOW was voided after the horse was placed on the Veterinarian's List for unsoundness. TIME TO GLOW was returned to the barn of Salvador Naranjo.

**8<sup>TH</sup> RACE - INQUIRY**

Following the running of the 8<sup>th</sup> race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of interference near the 3/16<sup>th</sup> marker involving #9 CENTRAL HEAT (1<sup>st</sup> place – jockey Russell Baze), #2 ESPERANZA LATINA (3<sup>rd</sup> place – jockey Kyle Frey) and #4 LOVEINTHESHADOWS (4<sup>th</sup> place – jockey Juan Hernandez).

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views no change was made to the posted order of finish. The recordings show the rider of #4 check his mount while in tight quarters and dropping back. The opinions of the Stewards varied as to the cause, but all were in agreement that #4 was not cost a better placing.

The claim that was submitted for #6 WHODOO PIRATE was voided after the horse was deemed unsound and placed on the Veterinarian's List. The horse was returned to the Jack Steiner barn.
