05-21-15²**TRAINER KEITH CRAIGMYLE RULING #83****RULING#83**

Trainer KEITH CRAIGMYLE is hereby fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty For Late Declaration) for failure to have the horse **SUMMERS DIGNITY** on the grounds necessitating a late scratch in the fourth race on Sunday May 17, 2015; A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run).

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Craigmyle was contacted and failed to offer a valid reason for failing secure transportation for his horse.

05-21-15³**FIRST RACE DELAY**

The first race with a scheduled post time of 1:15 p.m. was delayed ten minutes because the ambulance crew were not on the grounds. One of the paramedics arrived near post time and with track physician Dr. Seftel accompanying him the riders were remounted and the race was run without incident. Golden Gate Management notified the ambulance company, Turf Rescue representative to appear before the Stewards... more to follow.

Groom Alfredo H. Lopez, Jr. came to the office this morning regarding his noncompliance with ruling number 48 issued here on March 13, 2015. In ruling 48 he was fined \$100.00 and ordered to abide by the terms of a contract with the Winners Foundation. A review of his license printout revealed the fine was overdue and the license was expired. In addition to these issues, this Board received a letter of Mr. Lopez, Jr.'s noncompliance with the Winners Foundation and he appeared to be under the influence this morning. Mr. Lopez, Jr. was tested by the investigative staff and reportedly blew an alcohol level of 1.9 and 2.1... more to follow.

05-23-15³**NEW RIDING CROP RULE MEETING**

A meeting was held with the jockeys today in the jockeys' room to inform and discuss implementation of the changes made to the riding crop rule. The rule is set to go into effect on July 1st. Copies of the rule were handed out and the Stewards went over the rule with the riders so all parties had a clear understanding of the rule. In addition to this Board, Stewards William Meyers and Grant Baker, who are working today at Golden Gate, were also in attendance. Mr. Meyers and Mr. Baker are scheduled to work the upcoming Pleasanton meeting where the rule will become effective.

05-23-15⁴**INQUIRY – 3rd RACE**

Following the running of the 3rd race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of observed interference near the sixteenth marker between #1 DIZZY TIZZY (1st place – jockey Abel Cedillo) and #6 LEXIE ARLEEN (2nd place – jockey Ricardo Gonzalez). After talking with the riders and reviewing the recordings of the race, #1 was disqualified from 1st to 2nd.

The recordings show #1 drift out into the path of #6 forcing that rival off its path while losing ground and an opportunity of a better placing. The decision was unanimous.

Purse \$10,000 for California Bred or California Sired three year olds and upward, claiming \$5,000 at one mile and one sixteenth. The race was called off with two entries.

05-24-15²**JOCKEY ABEL CEDILLO RULING No. 84****RULING#84**

Jockey **ABEL CEDILLO** who rode **DIZZY TIZZY** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday May 23, 2015 is hereby suspended three (3) racing days (May 31, June 4 and 5, 2015) failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to second. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Cedillo met with the Stewards, reviewed the race, and acknowledged being late to make the necessary course correction after his mount drifted out.

The inquiry sign was posted following the running of the ninth race for a review of the start of #3 CLASSY LADY LIZ (Jockey Frank Alvarado) which left the gate riderless.

After talking to the Starter and reviewing the recorded views of the incident it was determined there were no mechanical failures or malfunction of the starting gate; therefore, #3 was a starter.

The recordings show #3 dislodges its' rider after becoming fractious in gate as the starter hits the button for the start.
