**BRANDENBURG HEARING CASE# 09PM015**

A formal hearing was conducted this morning to hear the alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1842 (Veterinarian Report), #1843.5 (c)(g) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances Permitted after Entry in a Race) and #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) against Dr. Kristie Brandenburg.

In attendance was Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein to record the proceedings, Senior Special Investigator Phil Miyazaki, Respondent Dr. Brandenburg and the full Board of Stewards, Randy Winick, Tom Ward and Kim Sawyer, who filled in for Luis Jauregui (excused due to involvement in investigation).

The record was opened, the principals were sworn in, testimony was heard and the evidence was entered into the record. The charges involved Dr. Brandenburg filing erroneous confidential reports for her pre-race treatment of eleven mules at Fairplex Park on September 17, 2009 in the first and second races, who ultimately had to be scratched, which led to the cancellation of both races.

Investigator Miyazaki presented the case, stating the chain of events that took place along with documented interviews of all principal participants involved. Dr. Brandenburg testified that this mistake did happen and that it was her fault due to several factors, such as her lack of knowledge concerning what time confidential reports are due, and that she was very tired and up late the night before filling out said reports. Dr. Brandenburg also stated that she was mistaken about writing Vetalog instead of Vitamins on her report, and that the times of administering Bute were incorrect.

The Stewards closed the hearing and will take all testimony and evidence into consideration in making their decision, which will be forthcoming in the near future.
