08-07-08² **LATE GATE SCRATCHES and NO SHOW WAGERING – Fourth Race**

#3 BOY THATS THE KEY (James Wooten) flipped in the gate and was scratched. The other five horses were unloaded in order to give sufficient time for announcements and refunds. The horses were re-loaded and #2 SECRETSUMMERSTORM (Edgar

Montehermosa) flipped in the gate, necessitating another late scratch, reducing the field to four. Show wagering was cancelled and announcements were made to inform the public. After a total of ten minutes of delay, the race was off at 4:08 p.m. without further incident.

08-08-08² **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Francisco Rubio** was cautioned to set up better for the sharp turns here at Ferndale. Rubio was fortunate to get counsel from stewards Nicolo and Dreyer, who are both retired veterans of the jockey colony.

08-08-08³ **RIDER REFUSAL – Fifth Race**

As the horses approached the starting gate, outrider Mike Angelini radioed that the jockey of #1 **SUMATRA'S HOPE** was refusing to ride. The stewards observed jockey **Jorge Ayarza** jump off his mount near the paddock and run toward the jockey's quarters, leaving the outrider holding a riderless horse. The outrider was instructed to have track veterinarian Henry Cook check the horse while a substitute rider was being attained. Trainer **Ray Thomas** accepted Pablo Castillo as replacement and Dr. Cook okayed the soundness of SUMATRA'S HOPE. Announcements were made, time was taken for patrons to adjust their wagers and the race was off approximately ten minutes late. #1 SUMATRA'S HOPE went on to win under jockey Castillo. **Ayarza** was ordered to the stewards' office in the morning.

08-09-08¹ **ENTRIES FOR MONDAY**

Six races garnered a total of forty-three (43) for Monday. Two mule, two Arabian and two thoroughbred races make up the card.

08-09-08² **RULING NO. 1 – AYARZA**

Jockey **JORGE AYARZA**, who was scheduled to ride SUMATRA'S HOPE, Friday, August 8, 2008 at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale), is hereby fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The above ruling was issued after Ayarza appeared and explained he didn't like the way the horse felt. He stated that he was on his way to the gate to see the vet when he saw trainer Ray Thomas and told him the horse wasn't right. Thomas said the horse was good and he could find someone else to ride. That's why Ayarza jumped off. Ayarza did not follow proper procedure so the normal \$100.00 fine was doubled.

08-09-08³ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – Third Race**

The stewards' posted the inquiry sign to review an incident shortly after the start of this five furlong Arabian Stake in which #1 CHILLI (Sergio Ruiz) clips heels with #2 LELY ROTERRA (Rachel Goodgame), virtually eliminating #1 from the race. After review it was determined that #3 TM MARIE LAVEAU ridden by Danny Boag was hard to place, coming in and forcing #2 into the path of #1. #3 was disqualified from third to sixth for the interference. Boag was held blameless.

08-09-08⁴ **ACCIDENT – INQUIRY – OBJECTION – Eighth Race**

#3 THE RY GUY, ridden by **Javier Gomez**, raced wide into the first turn of this 6 ½ furlong race. Gomez was unable to control his mount and bailed off mid-turn. THE RY GUY continued around the track riderless and attempted to jump the outside rail at the 3/8 pole unsuccessfully. THE RY GUY severely injured both front legs and was humanely euthanized. Gomez appeared uninjured.

In a separate incident jockey **James Wooten**, who finished third aboard #7 BABY BETO, lodged a claim of foul against first and second place finishers, #4 ICED CHAMPAGNE (Rachael Goodgame) and #2 MOCITO (Danny Boag). Wooten alleged interference by the two rivals the first time through the stretch. After review, the stewards could find no reason for a disqualification although tight quarters did exist momentarily. No change was ordered.

Jockey **APRIL BOAG**, who rode **BLINKIE** (mule) in the second race at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale) on Thursday, August 14, 2008, is suspended three (3) racing programs (August 22 afternoon and evening program and August 23, 2008) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in mid-stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of her mount

from fifth to last; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Boag appeared and reviewed yesterday's second race. She agreed she made a poor effort and accepted the above ruling. Boag is primarily a mule rider and since Sacramento (Cal Expo) is the only racing in California, the stewards felt the double program on Friday should count as two days for this infraction.

08-15-08³ **RACING SECRETARY ELLA 'DEE DEE' ROBINSON**

While finalizing the draw, Racing Secretary **Dee Dee Robinson** got into a confrontation with trainer **Ruby Thomas**. The investigators were called in and observed Robinson appearing intoxicated. A breathalyzer test was performed and Robinson blew a .19 BAC. She was given time to pack her belongings and sent back to her room. She indicated to the investigators and stewards that an immediate adjudication of her situation was her desire. Hopefully, Ms. Robinson will be well enough in the morning to have her hearing.

08-15-08⁴ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – Sixth Race**

Jockey Pablo Castillo aboard #8 PATS PRIDE (3rd) lodged a claim of foul against second place finisher #5 R LUMBER and jockey Juan Avila for alleged interference in the clubhouse turn. Furthermore, Ella Robinson is ordered to undergo a rehabilitation program as recommended by the Winners Foundation.

Furthermore, as a condition for continued license Ella Robinson must sign a test agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges Of ELLA ROBINSON are suspended and pursuant to California

Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after a hearing was held this morning. Robinson waived her rights and admitted to drinking while on duty. She accepted the above ruling effective immediately. It is a sad ending to a great job of filling races with a limited amount of equines available.

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was amended to assure a 3-day suspension. This Board was informed that Sacramento failed to fill two (2) cards for Friday, August 22, 2008.
