TUESDAY

06/29/2010 (1) DUTY STEWARD

The Cal-Bred race offered for California-bred maidens, two years old, claiming price \$12,500, failed to fill.

Scratches for Saturday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in the Also-Eligibles in the first and fourth races being scratched.

There were no entries taken for Sunday, July 4 since that day will remain dark in observance of the Independence Day holiday.

RULING #69

JOCKEY SANTIAGO MENDEZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON SUNDAY, JUNE 27, 2010.

(3) MEETING IN STEWARDS OFFICE

Mutual interests were discussed. In attendance were Equine Medical Director Dr. Rick Arthur, Dr. Gary Beck, Dr. Thomas A. Hackathorn, Director of Racing Ron Church, Steward James Dreyer, Steward Albert Christiansen, and Steward Ruben Moreno.

(4) SEVENTH RACE – LATE SCRATCH – RIDER INJURY

During the post parade for the seventh race #4 "Two Blessings" rider jockey Genaro Tapia injured his hand. Jockey Tapia dismounted and returned to the Jockey's Room and was transported to the hospital after being checked by the E.M.T.'s. (See attached accident report.)

No rider was found to ride #4 "Two Blessings," necessitating a late scratch by the Stewards.

SATURDAY

07/03/2010

(1) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Juan Andrade was in to review his ride from the previous evening in the ninth race where he allowed his mount #2 "Combustible" to drift out at the 1/8 pole. Jockey Andrade agreed he could have done a better job and would be more careful in the future. No sanction was given.

(2) FIRST RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

After the running of the first race (Thoroughbred – 4½ furlongs) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident at the ½ mile pole involving #5 "Just Charmed" (jockey Alex Bautista) and #4 "Dancer Man" (jockey Eulices Gomez). #5 "Just Charmed," the original second place finisher, was racing on the outside and veered in, causing #4 "Dancer Man" to clip heels. After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the film replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #5 "Just Charmed" and place him behind #4 "Dancer Man."

(3) THIRD RACE – ACCIDENT

At or about the 5/16th pole during the third race, #2 "Hard Read" fell and dislodged jockey Otto Arriaga with both mount and jockey falling hard to the track surface. "Hard Read" then rolled over jockey Arriaga. While both horse and rider were still down on the track surface, #5 "Sailable" ran over them, causing "Sailable" to stumble and dislodge his rider, jockey Adolfo Rodriguez who also fell hard to the track surface. #5 "Sailable," while riderless, continued his course around the track. #2 "Hard Read" laid on the track and was euthanized by the track veterinarian. Both jockeys continued to lay on the track where thrown and were immediately treated on the scene by the E.M.T.'s and transported to different hospitals. (See attached reports.)

(4) FOURTH RACE – POST RACE INJURY

#2 "Runaway Genes" with jockey Alex Bautista aboard appeared to break down on the backside. "Runaway Genes" was vanned off after the race. The rider returned to the Jockey's Room without incident, and "Runaway Genes" pulled up lame.
