Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of July 6, 2010 through July 11, 2010.

**TUESDAY**

07/06/2010 (1) DUTY STEWARD

Albert Christiansen will be present for morning activities and shall author the week's minutes.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Friday's program. Two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races make up the card.

**WEDNESDAY**

07/07/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

Two scratches and two rider changes completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Saturday's program. Two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races complete the card.

**THURSDAY**

07/08/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

One rider change completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Sunday's program. Two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races comprise the card.

**FRIDAY**

07/09/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

One scratch completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The third race in the book for maidens two years old, going 300 yards, was used open with one Cal-Bred.

(3) JOCKEY REVIEWS DISQUALIFICATION

Jockey Alex Bautista appeared to review last Saturday's first race disqualification of his mount with the Stewards. After a thorough review the Stewards were of the opinion Mr. Bautista's mount overreacted and shied from the horse outside of him. No penalty would be appropriate.

(4) NO SHOW

Owner Roberto Lua, who was suspended on May 8, 2010, for failure to appear to address a complaint involving his arrest for being under the influence of cocaine, again failed to appear. Mr. Lua asked investigators for this hearing and because of ignoring this event, he will remain suspended.

(5) NINTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION & NO CHANGE

After the finish of the ninth race (Quarter Horse – 350 yards) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review two separate incidents. The first incident involved the winner #3 "How Goes It" (jockey Alex Bautista) and #4 "AB Another Runner" (jockey Francisco Rubio) the fifth place horse. After talking to jockey Rubio, who stated #3 was clear of him while crossing his path, and reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to make no change in this incident. Replays show #3 was clear of #4 while crossing in front of the latter, about halfway through the race.

The second incident involved the fourth place finisher #6 "Flaming Out" (jockey Santiago Mendez) and the last place horse #7 "See Worthy" (jockey Juan Andrade). After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #6 and place him behind #7 for interference nearing the wire. Replays show #6 lock up on the bit, veer out and take #7 out of the race.

Jockey Joel Cruz appeared to review last night's second race with the Stewards. The rider was cautioned to make a better effort in correcting an errant mount.

(3) ACEVES RULING

RULING #70

JOCKEY RODRIGO ACEVES IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON SATURDAY, JULY 10, 2010.

This ruling was issued after jockey Aceves missed his first mount of the evening. The rider explained he has been on vacation and the plane for his return was delayed.

(4) SIXTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

After the finish of the sixth race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident at the start. Involved were the winner #1 "Ocean Drive" (jockey Adrian Loza) and the fifth place finisher #2 "Perrazzi" (jockey Joel Cruz). After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #1 from first and place him fifth, behind #2 for interference at the start. Replays show #1 break out sharply at the start, bump #2, costing the latter more than the neck he got beat for fourth place.
