Mr. Van Dyke stated that in the seventh race he lost his mane hold, balance, lost an iron, kicked the other one out and the outrider pulled him up. The second time, he said he again lost his balance, fell back on the horse's mouth, gathered himself and finished the race. Mr. Van Dyke has won twenty races and has not had any issues until now. He did state this was the first time he had ridden in the rain; he wore gloves in the seventh and took them off for the ninth.

03/06/14¹**CONTRERAS FORMAL HEARING - CASE #14SA021 (ref-01-30-14³)**

The original complaint was filed by the CHRB for a possible violation of rule 1489 (a) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License-moral turpitude). The hearing was documented by Court Reporter MICHELLE DERIEG while Supervising Investigator RICK AMIEVA represented the CHRB. Mr. CONTRERAS provided documentation that his conviction in 1990 was set aside and vacated. Anthony Contreras supplied a copy of the Petition under Penal Code sec, 1203.4 signed by Judge Schwartz in Pasadena on October 12, 2005, in LASC Case No. GAOO3584. Mr. Contreras is still required to disclose the conviction in response to any direct question contained in any questionnaire or application for public office or for licensure by any state or local agency. Mr. Amieva stated the CHRB is seeking a suspension of his license until it expires. All evidence was ordered into the record. Decision to follow.
