Acting upon a report from the University of California, Davis Laboratories, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #R15234, obtained from the horse "A to the Z", The second place finisher in the fifth race on January 29, 2005, at Santa Anita Park, contained the prohibited drug Clenbuterol, a class three substance, it is therefore ordered that "A to the Z" be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the owner of "A to the Z", Andy or Paula Capestro, jockey Victor Espinoza and trainer Paula Capestro return purse monies to the paymaster of purses at Santa Anita Race Track for redistribution in accordance with California Horse Racing Rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

Revised order of finish: 2nd – Silver Tree
3rd – Continental Red
4th – Icy Atlantic
5th – Union Place

All records shall be changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board, Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) The pari-mutuel payoffs for this race are not affected.
