Apprentice Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE, who rode DESERT MADAM in the first race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on November 14, 2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 21, 22, and 23, 2014) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.
