### **RULING NO. 90**

Acting upon a report from Truesdail Laboratories, the official laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #N9077, taken from the horse SULTRY EYES, winner of the tenth race at the California State Fair and Exposition in Sacramento, California on August 28, 2003, tested positive for the drug substance clenbuterol (Class III) in excess of the permitted level, it is ordered that SULTRY EYES be disqualified from all purse monies earned in the race in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule 1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that purse monies earned by the owner of SULTRY EYES, Porfirio Carrasco, be returned to the Paymaster at Golden Gate Fields Race Track for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule 1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> - MOLLY'S GEM
- 2<sup>nd</sup> - ROYALLY YOURS
- 3<sup>rd</sup> - WAYS TO WIN
- 4<sup>th</sup> - CEE'S A FLIRT
- 5<sup>th</sup> - I'M A LUCKY GAL
- 6<sup>th</sup> - I'LL SURVIVE

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule 1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not effect the pari-mutuel payoffs.
