RULING NO. 35

Acting upon a report from Truesdail Laboratories, an official laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample M60619, taken from the horse MOTEL STAFF, winner of the seventh race at Bay Meadows Race Course on Saturday, June 15, 2002, tested positive for the prohibited substance, Pseudoephedrine / Norpseudoephedrine (Class III), it is ordered that MOTEL STAFF be disqualified from all purse monies earned in the race in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$17,820) earned by owner Carl Wilson be returned to the paymaster of purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to Be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

3 rd - HALLO BERT	8 th - CRAZY LARRYS

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the parimutuel payoffs.
