RULING NO. 21

Acting on a stipulated agreement that urine sample, #R75184, taken from the horse **SLEEPY JONES**, winner of the second race at Golden Gate Fields on June 3, 2005, tested positive for clenbuteral (Class III) in excess of the permitted level, it is ordered that SLEEPY JONES be disqualified from all purse monies earned in that race in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$5,775.00) earned or awarded to owner David Currie, trainer Lloyd Mason and jockey Macario Rodriguez be returned to the paymaster of purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 1st - TURKO SPIRIT
- 2nd - ENJOY THE SHOW
- 3rd - TOTALITARIAN
- 4th - APOPTOTIC
- 5th - JOHNS ABSTRACTION

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.
