RULING NO. 22

In the matter of:
Trainer Lloyd Mason

Upon acceptance of a stipulated agreement between Lloyd Mason and the California Horse Racing Board, trainer **LLOYD MASON**, who started the horse **SLEEPY JONES**, winner of the second race at Golden Gate Fields on June 3, 2005, is fined the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Clenbuterol in excess of permitted level [Class I I I]).

*Rule 1532 - Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.
