RULING NO. 54

Exercise Rider **BARITON L. COLEMAN** is suspended for sixty (60) days, December 18, 2005 through February 15, 2006 pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule 1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) and placed on probation for the term of his license (12-31-07) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489(h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) for engaging in the use of and testing positive for cocaine on or about October 20, 2005.

Prior to re-instatement of his license privileges Mr. Coleman must submit to an evaluation and recommendation by the Winners Foundation and show proof of completion of a rehabilitation program acceptable to a Board of Stewards. Terms of probation shall include adherence to a testing agreement and demonstration of a continuing program of sobriety. Any violation of the terms of probation will be cause for further action against Mr. Coleman's license privileges.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **BARI TON L. COLEMAN** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.
