RULING NO. 16

Acting on a report from Equine Analytical Chemistry Laboratory at the University of California, Davis, an official laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #R75030, taken from the horse GO ON ORANGE, first place finisher in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on January 17, 2005, tested positive for acepromazine (Class II) in excess of the permitted level, it is ordered that GO ON ORANGE be disqualified from all purse monies earned in that race in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$6,050.00) earned or awarded to owner Barbara Heads, trainer Jerry McArthur and jockey Francisco Duran be returned to the paymaster of purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 1st - Shotgun Proposal
- 2nd - Huka's Diamond
- 3rd - Fuse Quick
- 4th - Tangled Up In Blue
- 5th - Turkish Prize

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.
