RULING NO. 21

In the matter of

Owner/Trainer **JERRY McARTHUR:**

In accordance with a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, owner/trainer JERRY McARTHUR, who started the horse **GO ON ORANGE**, first place finisher in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields in Albany, California on January 17, 2005, is fined the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)* and suspended sixty (60) days (September 15, 2006 through November 13, 2006) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances - Acepromazine - Class II).

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of JERRY McARTHUR are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), he is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

*Rule 1532 - Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.
