**RULING NO. 15**

Acting on a report from Truesdail Laboratory, an official laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #R1124, taken from the horse SALTY M.D., fifth place finisher in the fourth race at the San Joaquin County Fair on June 24, 2005, tested positive for albuterol (Class III) in excess of the permitted level, it is ordered that SALTY M.D. be disqualified from all purse monies earned in that race in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$312.00) earned or awarded to owners Buddy Lee Racing Stable (Bill Bainum), Robert Lawler and Vince Watson, be returned to the paymaster of purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> - Kona Run
- 2<sup>nd</sup> - High Alert
- 3<sup>rd</sup> - Fantastic Wager
- 4<sup>th</sup> - Cisco's Kit
- 5<sup>th</sup> - Captain Stats

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.
