**RULING NO. 35**

In the matter of  
Antonio Rodriguez Soto:

In accordance with a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, trainer ANTONIO RODRIGUEZ SOTO, who started the horse TRI NNI , eighth place finisher in the seventh race at San Mateo County Fair on Wednesday, August 9, 2006, is fined the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)\* and placed on probation for the term of one year from the date of this ruling pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules 1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and 1843.6 (d) 1 (Total Carbon Dioxide Testing - Total Carbon Dioxide in excess of permitted level - Class III).

Furthermore, in accordance with the stipulated agreement the payment of the three thousand dollar fine shall be stayed provided that Mr. Soto has no further violations of California Horse Racing Board rule 1887 regarding Class I, II or III medications during the term of probation.

\*Rule 1532 - Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.
