**RULING NO.20**

In the matter of:

Trainer **JAMEY THOMAS**

In accordance with a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, trainer JAMEY THOMAS, who started the horses VILAMOURA, sixth place finisher in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on August 26, 2006, and AT A BOY LUTHER, third place finisher in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on August 27, 2006, is fined the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00), suspended fifteen (15) days, May 21, 2007 through June 4, 2007, and placed on probation for one year from the date of this ruling, pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violations of California Horse Racing Board rules 1843.1(b) (Prohibited Drug Substances) and 1843.6 (d, 1, 2) (Total Carbon Dioxide Testing - high TCO<sub>2</sub> - Class III).

Furthermore, in accordance with the stipulated agreement, the fine shall be stayed provided Mr. Thomas has no further violations of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 regarding Class I, II or III medications during the term of probation.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of JAMEY THOMAS are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.
